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the u s army before 1945 did not have and did not need a formal readiness reporting system after world war ii however it found itself committed to large scale deployments in europe and in the pacific commitments that with the cold war would continue for the next 45 years the demands of this war along with the wars in korea and vietnam made it vital that senior service leaders had accurate information on the readiness of units in the regular army the army national guard and the army reserve the methods for measuring readiness however soon became and then remained a matter of contention equally contentious was the use of data generated by readiness reporting systems both within the service and by others outside the service the end of the cold war did not end these disputes indeed the years between that victory and the start of the second iraq war in 2003 were a time of heightened concern over military readiness and how to assess it provided by publisher

ready or not made its mark in 2007 by boldly calling for a field wide response to the question what defines and bounds early care and education as a field of practice a dozen years later this question remains pivotal to the field s understanding of its present and its aspirations for the future in this updated and expanded edition goffin and washington reunite to examine the major issues that must still be addressed if children are to be given more and better opportunities this second edition will help everyone whose work impacts the ece workforce including those working directly with children to deepen their commitment to adaptive and systems work and to develop the leadership capacity needed to become change agents ready or not early childhood education needs to tackle its adaptive challenges

an exploration of the changing conceptions of the space shuttle program and a call for a new vision of spaceflight the thirty years of space shuttle flights saw contrary changes in american visions of space valerie neal who has spent much of her career examining the space shuttle program uses this iconic vehicle to question over four decades worth of thinking about and struggling with the meaning of human spaceflight she examines the ideas images and icons that emerged as nasa congress journalists and others sought to communicate rationales for or critiques of the space shuttle missions at times concurrently the space shuttle was billed as delivery truck and orbiting science lab near earth station and space explorer costly disaster and pinnacle of engineering success the book's multidisciplinary approach reveals these competing depictions to examine the meaning of the spaceflight enterprise given the end of the space shuttle flights in 2011 neal makes an appeal to reframe spaceflight once again to propel humanity forward neal may be the one person who knows the space shuttle program better than the astronauts who flew this iconic vehicle her book casts new light on the program exploring its cultural significance through a thoughtful analysis as one who lived this history i gained much from her broader perspective and deep insights kathryn d sullivan retired nasa astronaut and former administrator of the national oceanic and atmospheric administration a much needed look at how to create a cultural narrative for human spaceflight that resonates with millennials rather than

once again the soldiers officers and commanders tell the story in this third volume of kevin campbell s comprehensive work on the gettysburg campaign journey to armageddon the hardships comradery short rations and the dance with the enemy s bullets and shells are all here blistering sun drenching rains choking dust sticky mud played out horses and men and the high level often inharmoniousness communications between army commanders and their governments are presented in these pages fortunately not all is despair and doom included are the sometimes humorous interactions with the civilians met along their journey and the acrimony that frequently filled encounters between hungry soldiers and the administrators of the villages and towns they passed through the tales told by these hardy men about the events of their existence are significant elements within the story of the gettysburg campaign which author kevin campbell tells in a clear and concise prose most historians who write of the great crusade gloss over these events in favor of the more prominent proceedings in and around gettysburg these often ignored events and much more are incorporated into his complete treatment of the union and confederate armies on their journey to armageddon

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
