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these essays include writings from cornel west michael omi audre lorde gloria anzaldua and michelle fine the essays address the multiplicity and scope of

oppressions ranging from ableism to racism and other less well known social aberrations

mignon r moore brings to light the family life of a group that has been largely invisible gay women of color in a book that challenges long standing ideas about racial identity family formation and motherhood drawing from interviews and surveys of one hundred black gay women in new york city invisible families explores the ways that race and class have influenced how these women understand their sexual orientation find partners and form families in particular the study looks at the ways in which the past experiences of women who came of age in the 1960s and 1970s shape their thinking and have structured their lives in communities that are not always accepting of their openly gay status overturning generalizations about lesbian families derived largely from research focused on white middle class feminists invisible families reveals experiences within black american and caribbean communities as it asks how people with multiple stigmatized identities imagine and construct an individual and collective sense of self

language and identities offers a broad survey of our current state of knowledge on the connections between variability in language use and the construction negotiation maintenance and performance of identities at different levels individual group regional and national it brings together over 20 specially commissioned chapters written by distinguished international scholars on a range of topics around the language identity nexus the collection deals sequentially with identities at various levels both social and personal using detailed empirical evidence the chapters illustrate how the multi layered dynamic nature of identities is realised through linguistic behaviour several chapters in the volume focus on contexts in which we might expect to observe a foregrounding of factors involved in the definition and delimitation of self and other for example cases in which identities may be disputed changing blurred peripheral or imposed such a focus on complex contexts allows clearer insight into the identity making and marking functions of language the collection approaches these topics from a range of perspectives with contributions from sociolinguists sociophoneticians linguistic anthropologists clinical linguists and forensic linguists

sexual information in america that limits a woman s general awareness of herself her body her sexuality and her life options understanding the challenges that lesbians and bisexuals experience when attempting to establish their true identities to assist your clients in overcoming these barriers suggesting support groups for clients who are having a difficult time becoming used to the ideas and feelings of some same gender attractions this insightful book knocks down the sociological and psychological barriers that keep women from realizing or acknowledging their real sexual orientation by dispelling societal and cultural myths about what it means to be a woman in the united states offering you invaluable advice on how to help clients effectively and happily live with their new identities lesbian epiphanies provides solutions to the challenges that women experience in establishing their other than heterosexual orientation in a heterosexist society

in october 2010 al qaida attempted to bomb two cargo planes flying out of the middle east they took credit for this failed attempt through an english magazine named inspire was inspire really the work of al qaida or was it s editor a canadian named beverly giesbrecht she had earlier hosted a reactionary al qaida website jihadunspun com out of vancouver canada in 2008 she was kidnapped in afghanistan while trying to infiltrate the taliban shortly after she was released in june 2009 she died disappeared in strange circumstances or was this an exit strategy and was inspire her new assignment using his personal familiarity with bev s first foray into the world of jihad jihadunspun com the author connects bev to inspire magazine and by extension to the cargo plane bombing plot what emerges is a sinister picture of western intelligence agencies floating their own secret jihad groups for a variety of criminal undertakings and the anatomy of a false flag operation gone wrong

moving beyond borders is the first book length history of black health care workers in canada delving into the experiences of thirty five postwar era nurses who were born in canada or who immigrated from the caribbean either through britain or directly to canada karen flynn examines the shaping of these

women's stories from their childhoods through to their roles as professionals and community activists flynn interweaves oral histories with archival sources to show how these women's lives were shaped by their experiences of migration professional training and family life theoretical analyses from postcolonial gender and diasporic black studies serve to highlight the multiple subjectivities operating within these women's lives by presenting a collective biography of identity formation moving beyond borders reveals the extraordinary complexity of black women's history

even if we don't realise it most of us are now familiar with the idea of emotional labour that service with a smile which everyone from cabin crew to restaurant or call centre staff is expected to give irrespective of what they actually feel or think this book considers the complex ways in which this need to show or hide particular emotions translates into job roles specifically those of leaders or managers where the relationships are lasting rather than transient two way rather than uni directional and have complex ongoing goals rather than straight forward one off ones the book contends that these differences contribute unique characteristics to the nature of the emotional labour required and expounds and explores this new genus within the emotional labour species the main theme of this book is the explication and exploration of emotional labour in the context of leadership and management as such it focuses both on how our understanding of emotional labour in this context enriches the original construct and where it deviates from it by exploring these issues at the level of situated practices and the real world real time experiences of leaders the book seeks to make an innovative and nuanced contribution to our understanding of the emotional element within leadership work
