this volume presents new research and critical debates in african book history and brings together a range of disciplinary perspectives by leading scholars in the subject it includes case studies from across africa ranging from third century manuscript traditions to twenty first century internet communications

this book investigates if and how agricultural market structures and farm constraints affect the development of dynamic food and cash crop sectors and whether these sectors can contribute to economic transformation and poverty reduction in africa the authors map the current cash and food crops supply chains in six african countries characterizing their markets structures and domestic competition policies at the farm level the book studies the constraints faced by small holders to increase productivity and break out of a vicious cycle in which low productivity exacerbates vulnerability to poverty in a series of micro case studies the project explores how cooperatives and institutions may help overcome these constraints this book will appeal to scholars and policy makers seeking instruments to promote increased

agriculture productivity resolve food security issues and promote agribusiness by diversifying exports and increasing trade and competitiveness

white southerners recognized that the perpetuation of segregation required whites of all ages to uphold a strict social order especially the young members of the next generation white children rested at the core of the system of segregation between 1890 and 1939 because their participation was crucial to ensuring the future of white supremacy their socialization in the segregated south offers an examination of white supremacy from the inside showcasing the culture's efforts to preserve itself by teaching its beliefs to the next generation in raising racists the socialization of white children in the jim crow south author kristina durocher reveals how white adults in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries continually reinforced race and gender roles to maintain white supremacy durocher examines the practices mores and traditions that trained white children to fear dehumanize and disdain their black neighbors raising racists combines an analysis of the remembered experiences of a racist society how that society influenced children and most important how racial violence and brutality shaped growing up in the early twentieth century south

this volume explores the usefulness of the asian model of agricultural development for africa where even before the recent world food crisis half the population lived on less than one dollar a day and a staggering one in three people and one third of all children were undernourished africa has abundant natural resources agriculture provides most of its jobs a third of national income and a larger portion of total export earnings however the levels of land and labor productivity rank among the worst in the world the book explains africa's productivity gap and proposes ways to close it by examining recent experience in africa and by drawing on lessons from asia

this book examines africa's current food system and future challenges for food security over the next 25 years africa is on the rise and by 2050 the continent will be home to a quarter of the world's population the analysis presented in this book clearly shows that the african food system needs to transform at a much faster pace to ensure that the people it serves are food secure this book begins with four contrasting case studies that focus on country specific challenges in egypt ethiopia senegal and zimbabwe this is followed by 15 thematic chapters organised in three sections on challenges threats and opportunities individual chapters address a wide range of topics including climate change water security farm sizes crop yields conservation trade offs food prices trade conflict and structural change the book concludes by discussing key pathways to improve africa's food system and food security for the decades ahead this book is essential reading for students scholars and practitioners who work on global food security sustainable food systems food health and nutrition and african

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
