this comprehensive history of african american fraternities and sororities celebrates the spirit of black excellence in higher education that has produced american leaders in politics sports arts and culture such as kamala harris colin kaepernick michael jordan thurgood marshall and toni morrison and is sure to be a treasured resource for generations to come america s black fraternities and sororities are a unique and vital part of 20th century african american history providing young black achievers with opportunities to support each other while they serve their communities and the nation from pioneering work in the suffragette movement to extraordinary strides during the civil rights era to life changing inner city mentoring programs members of these organizations share a proud tradition of brotherhood sisterhood and service today america s nine black fraternities and sororities are millions of members strong with chapters at hbcus ivy league schools and colleges across the nation including stanford university howard university and the university of chicago

the rich history and social significance of the divine nine african american greek letter organizations is explored in this comprehensive anthology in the long tradition of african american benevolent and secret societies intercollegiate african american fraternities and sororities have strong traditions of fostering brotherhood and sisterhood among their members exerting considerable influence in the african american community and being in the forefront of civic action community service and philanthropy dr martin luther king jr toni morrison arthur ashe and sarah vaughn are just a few of the trailblazing members of these organizations african american fraternities and sororities places the history of these organizations in context linking them to other movements and organizations that predated them and tying their history to the civil rights movement it explores various cultural aspects of the organizations such as auxiliary groups branding calls and stepping and highlights the unique role of african american sororities

the rarely heard stories of the brave african american women at the forefront of the civil rights movement sisters in the struggle tells the stories and documents the contributions of african american women to the most important social reform in the united states in the twentieth century only recently have historians and other researchers begun to recognize black women s central role in the battle for racial and gender equality these essays describe the early ideological development of ella baker who helped found the student nonviolent coordinating committee in 1960 fannie lou hamer s use of personal anguish to mold her public persona and septima clark s creation of a network of citizenship schools to teach poor black southerners to read and write to help them register to vote we learn of black women s activism in the mississippi freedom

reveals the historical and political significance of the divine nine the black greek letter organizations in 1905 henry arthur callis began his studies at cornell university despite their academic pedigrees callis and his fellow african american students were ostracized by the majority white student body and so in 1906 callis and some of his peers started the first intercollegiate black greek letter organization bglo alpha phi alpha since their founding bglos have not only served to solidify bonds among many african american college students they have also imbued them with a sense of purpose and a commitment to racial uplift the endeavor to help black americans reach socio economic equality a pledge with purpose explores the arc of these unique important and relevant social institutions gregory s parks and matthew w hughey uncover how bglos were

shaped by and labored to transform the changing social political and cultural landscape of black america from the era of the harlem renaissance to the civil rights movement alpha phi alpha boasts such members as thurgood marshall civil rights lawyer and us supreme court justice and dr charles wesley noted historian and college president delta sigma theta members include bethune cookman college founder mary mcleod bethune and women s rights activist dorothy height huey p newton co founder of the black panther party who left an indelible mark on the civil rights movement was a member of phi beta sigma while dr mae jemison a celebrated engineer and astronaut belonged to alpha kappa alpha through such individuals parks and hughey demonstrate the ways that bglo members have long been at the forefront of innovation activism and scholarship in its examination of the history of these important organizations a pledge with purpose serves as a critical reflection of both the collective african american racial struggle and the various strategies of black americans in their great and unfinished march toward freedom and equality

during the twentieth century black greek letter organizations bglos united college students dedicated to excellence fostered kinship and uplifted african americans members of these organizations include remarkable and influential individuals such as martin luther king jr congresswoman barbara jordan novelist toni morrison and wall street pioneer reginald f lewis despite the profound influence of these groups many now question the continuing relevance of bglos arguing that their golden age has passed partly because of their perceived link to hip hop culture black fraternities and sororities have been unfairly reduced to a media stereotype a world of hazing without any real substance the general public knows very little about bglos and surprisingly the members themselves often do not have a thorough understanding of their history and culture or of the issues currently facing their organizations to foster a greater engagement with the history and contributions of bglos black greek letter organizations in the twenty first century our fight has just begun brings together an impressive group of authors to explore the contributions and continuing possibilities of bglos and their members editor gregory s parks and the contributing authors provide historical context for the development of bglos exploring their service activities as well as their relationships with other prominent african american institutions the book examines bglos responses to a number of contemporary issues including non black membership homosexuality within bglos and the perception of bglos as educated gangs as illustrated by the organized response of bglo members to the racial injustice they observed in jena louisiana these organizations still have a vital mission both internally and externally bglos struggle to forge a relevant identity for the new century internally these groups wrestle with many issues including hazing homophobia petty intergroup competition and the difficulty of bridging the divide between college and alumni members externally bglos face the challenge of rededicating

themselves to their communities and leading an aggressive campaign against modern forms of racism sexism and other types of fear driven behavior by embracing the history of these organizations and exploring their continuing viability and relevance black greek letter organizations in the twenty first century demonstrates that bglos can create a positive and enduring future and that their most important work lies ahead

the story of lambda gamma omega chapter of alpha kappa alpha inc from its inception through its thirty eight year history the story is told based upon twelve administrations of leadership

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this book is the chronological history of one of alpha kappa alpha sorority's graduate chapters phi eta omega of scotch plains new jersey from its chartering in 1999 through 2013 ten inactive members sorors of alpha kappa alpha sorority inc rekindling a desire to be of service to others assembled at a sorors home in plainfield new jersey in the early winter of 1998 soon this small group grew to fourteen and ultimately to seventeen women these seventeen inactive sorors became an official interest group of the sorority later that year with the mission to promote harmony and friendship among members to develop and implement programs to enhance the self esteem of youth and to assist others wherever needed in their communities these women full of energy and enthusiasm ventured into unknown waters becoming the first greek letter organization to affiliate with the new jersey orators the scotch plains union county interest group helped foster the development of confidence and public speaking skills in youth ages seven to seventeen tag a weekly tutorial program was also established since its chartering on june 6 1999 phi eta omega chapter continues to institute and participate in other altruistic programs the angel network collection of coats and other winter clothing during local coat drives donation of suits for dress barns dress for success financial support to two kenyan students in africa donation of duffel bags filled with pajamas clothing books and other sundries to union county division of child protection and

permanency and the replacement of the headstone of caesar a revolutionary warfreed slave at scotch plains baptist church in scotch plains new jersey

sick and tired of being sick and tired moves beyond the depiction of african americans as mere recipients of aid or as victims of neglect and highlights the ways black health activists created public health programs and influenced public policy at every opportunity smith also sheds new light on the infamous tuskegee syphilis experiment by situating it within the context of black public health activity reminding us that public health work had oppressive as well as progressive consequences

at the turn of the twentieth century black fraternities and sororities also known as black greek letter organizations bglos were an integral part of what w e b du bois called the talented tenth this was the top ten percent of the black community that would serve as a cadre of educated upper class motivated individuals who acquired the professional credentials skills and capital to assist the race to attain socioeconomic parity today however bglos struggle to find their place and direction in a world drastically different from the one that witnessed their genesis in recent years there has been a growing body of scholarship on bglos this collection of essays seeks to push those who think about bglos to engage in more critically and empirically based analysis this book also seeks to move bglo members and those who work with them beyond conclusions based on hunches conventional wisdom intuition and personal experience in addition to a rich range of scholars this volume includes a kind of call and response feature between scholars and prominent members of the bglo community

since the beginning in 1943 the mission of the gamma sigma omega chapter of alpha kappa alpha sorority has been to cultivate scholastic and ethical standards to promote unity and friendship among college women and to be of service to all mankind timeless service in gamma sigma omega chapter chronicles the history of the women who sojourned in the life of one chapter of the first black female greek letter organization and the events that impacted their journey in savannah georgia from 1943 to 2012 emma jean hawkins conyers former president of the gso chapter begins with the story of adeline graham a white philanthropist who bequeathed funds to the chapter for use in establishing an orphanage for negro children and reveals how the chapter responded to the challenge as she continues the chapter s history through the years conyers shares notable details on members awards community projects and events that helped to preserve a legacy that endures to this day timeless service in gamma sigma omega chapter captures the spirit of unity sisterhood and service that still drives the sorority to fulfill the mission after commencing nearly seven decades ago

when members of black fraternal organizations and non members alike finish black greek 101 they will have a foundation for understanding some of the most interesting organizations that have influenced not only campus culture but american culture as a whole jacket

this exhaustive analysis of historically black colleges and universities hbcus throughout history discusses the institutions and the major events individuals and organizations that have contributed to their existence the oldest hbcu cheyney university of pennsylvania was founded in 1837 by quaker philanthropist richard humphreys as the institute for colored youth by 1902 at least 85 such schools had been established and in subsequent years the total grew to 105 today approximately 16 percent of america s black college students are enrolled in hbcus historically black colleges and universities an encyclopedia brings the stories of these schools together in a comprehensive volume that explores the origin and history of each historically black college and university in the united states major founders and contributors to hbcus including whites free blacks churches and states are discussed and distinguished alumni are profiled specific examples of the impact of hbcus and their alumni on american culture and the social and political history of the united states are also examined in addition to looking at the hbcus themselves the book analyzes historical events and legislation of the past 174 years that impacted the founding funding and growth of these history making schools

long before it became the slogan of the presidential campaign for barack obama dorothy ferebee 1898 1980 lived by the motto yes we can an african american obstetrician and civil rights activist from washington dc she was descended from lawyers journalists politicians and a judge at a time when african americans faced jim crow segregation desperate poverty and lynch mobs she advised presidents on civil rights and assisted foreign governments on public health issues though articulate visionary talented and skillful at managing her publicity she was also tragically flawed ferebee was president of the alpha kappa alpha black service sorority and later became the president of the powerful national council of negro women in the nascent civil rights era she stood up to gun toting plantation owners to bring health care to sharecroppers through her mississippi health project during the great depression a household name in black america for forty years ferebee was also the media darling of the thriving black press ironically her fame and relevance faded as african americans achieved the political power for which she had fought in she can bring us home diane kiesel tells ferebee s extraordinary story of struggle and personal sacrifice to a new generation
