henry clay s career spanned a half century of a great formative period in american history the papers of henry clay span the crucial first half of the nineteenth century in american history few men in his time were so intimately concerned with the formation of national policy and few influenced so profoundly the growth of american political institutions this compilation of ten volumes includes clay s letters letters to clay his speeches and other documents identified as his personal composition publication of this book was assisted by a grant from the national historical publications and records commission

charismatic charming and one of the best orators of his era henry clay seemed to have it all he offered a comprehensive plan of change for america and he directed national affairs as speaker of the house as secretary of state to john quincy adams the man he put in office and as acknowledged leader of the whig party as the broker of the missouri compromise and the compromise of 1850 henry clay fought to keep a young nation united when westward expansion and slavery threatened to tear it apart yet despite his talent and achievements henry clay never became president three times he received electoral college votes twice more he sought his party s nomination yet each time he was defeated alongside fellow senatorial greats daniel webster and john c calhoun clay was in the mix almost every moment from 1824 to 1848 given his prominence

perhaps the years should be termed not the jacksonian era but rather the age of clay james c klotter uses new research and offers a more focused nuanced explanation of clay s programs and politics in order to answer to the question of why the man they called the great rejected never won the presidency but did win the accolades of history klotter s fresh outlook reveals that the best monument to henry clay is the fact that the united states remains one country one nation one example of a successful democracy still working still changing still reflecting his spirit the appeal of henry clay and his emphasis on compromise still resonate in a society seeking less partisanship and more efforts at conciliation

a story set before during and immediately after the jacksonian period and the critical years leading up to the civil war former speaker of the house senator secretary of state organizer of the whig political party henry clay had lost the race to the white house three times already and now was his chance to take the presidency for himself zachary taylor declines to run as the chief executive giving clay another shot with the use of the telegraph and help from newspaper editor horace greeley daniel webster and others the first presidential debate in 1848 between clay and martin van buren and lewis cass was set one of the most popular senators of all time the kentuckian henry clay goes into the debate with fire and vengeance to make up for his previous losses whoever comes out the winner of this historical occasion would go on and follow james polk to the presidency and attempt to delay the inevitable american civil war

considering baltimore and philadelphia as part of a larger mid atlantic borderland the politics of black citizenship shows that the antebellum effort to secure the rights of american citizenship was central to black politics it was an effort that sought to exploit the ambiguities of citizenship and negotiate the complex national state and local politics in which that concept was determined in the early nineteenth century baltimore and philadelphia contained the largest two free black populations in the country separated by a mere hundred miles the counties that lie between them also contained large and vibrant freeblack populations in this period in 1780 pennsylvania had begun the process of outlawing slavery while maryland would cling desperately to the institution until the civil war and so these were also cities separated by

the legal boundary between freedom and slavery despite the fact that slavery thrived in parts of the state of maryland in baltimore the free black population outnumbered the enslaved so that on the eve of the civil war there were ten times as many free blacks in the city of baltimore as there were slaves in this book andrew diemer examines the diverse tactics that free blacks employed in defense of their liberties including violence and the building of autonomous black institutions as well as african americans familiarity with the public policy and political struggles that helped shape those freedoms in the first place
