a history of the activism that made public spaces in american cities more accessible to women from the closing years of the nineteenth century women received subtle and not so subtle messages that they shouldn t be in public or if they were that they were not safe breaking the gender code tells the story of both this danger narrative and the resistance to it historian georgina hickey investigates challenges to the code of urban gender segregation in the twentieth century focusing on organized advocacy to make the public spaces of american cities accessible to women she traces waves of activism from the progressive era with its calls for public restrooms safe and accessible transportation and public accommodations through and beyond second wave feminism and its focus on the creation of alternative women only spaces and extensive anti violence efforts in doing so hickey explores how gender segregation intertwined with other systems of social control as well as how class race and sexuality shaped activists agendas and women s experiences of urban space drawing connections between the vulnerability of women in public spaces real and presumed and contemporary debates surrounding rape culture bathroom bills and domestic violence hickey unveils both the strikingly successful and the incomplete initiatives of activists who worked to open up public space to women

it s no secret that superhero comics have historically included problematic depictions of women racial and sexual minorities and

others who do not fit the standard straight white male model of a hero rather than focus on these negative depictions Langsdale wants to take a more positive approach by looking at recent comics that can be called feminist with female heroes and creators of all genders that tell new types of stories within the genre although these books have usually been marginalized and have suffered premature cancellation she argues that this marginalization has enabled innovative stories to be told in ways that not only advance the genre but also interact with contemporary social justice concerns incorporating intersectionality and feminist theory Langsdale analyzes complete stories focused on various heroes Spider Woman America Chavez the Unstoppable Wasp and Ironheart by exploring different elements of these characters e.g. Spider Woman's pregnancy America's identity as a queer mestiza and the Wasp's creation of a female-run STEM facility she examines what makes these texts feminist and how they interact with larger issues of inclusion and social justice in ways that more traditional superhero narratives don't and probably can't she also examines how these characters' appearances in other media have played a part in their development by focusing on marginalized runs of comics Langsdale demonstrates how even these can make powerful statements about feminism and the world

written for a general audience this book taps into and reorients the narrative of the 1966 ut tower shooting the first mass campus shooting to a person and side of this crime that have been too long overlooked kathy leissner whitman who was married to the tower shooter this book explores kathy s experience with domestic violence at the hands of the shooter charles whitman and her murder as well as the murder of kathy s mother in law the night before his rampage scott coe uses kathy s letters which have not been available until now to her husband and family to craft a biography that provides a rare glimpse of how one woman expressed and sought to change her life with a coercive and sometimes violent partner during a time when domestic abuse and mass shooting were not part of our vocabulary she traces kathy s life focusing on the years she spent with whitman from their whirlwind courtship in her first year at ut through her graduation and beginnings of a career as a teacher despite domestic turmoil

up to the last weeks before her death at age 23 in doing so scott coe challenges assumptions about kathy and charles that have been baked into this story and more broadly about how intimate partners should respond to domestic violence kathy s story is framed by an introduction and conclusion that place this tragedy in the context of the largely invisible epidemic of domestic abuse in the united states and the link between mass shootings and violence against women in the home

doing honest work in college stands on three principles do the work you say you do give others credit and present your research fairly these are straightforward concepts but the abundance of questionable online sources and temptation of a quick copy paste can cause confusion as to what s considered citing and what s considered cheating this guide starts out by clearly defining plagiarism and other forms of academic dishonesty and then gives students the tools they need to avoid those pitfalls this edition addresses the acceptable use of mobile devices on tests the proper approach to sources such as podcasts or social media posts and the limitations of citation management software

everything she knew in mexico claudia recounts the terror of migrating alone with her toddler and the incredible challenges she faced advocating for her daughter s health in the united states when she arrived in texas claudia discovered that being undocumented would mean more than just an immigration status it would be a way of living of mothering and of being discarded by even those institutions we count on to care elizabeth farfán santos spent five years with claudia as she listened to claudia s experiences she recalled her own mother s story another life molded by migration the us mexico border and the quest for a healthy future on either side witnessing claudia s struggles with doctors and teachers we see how the education and medical systems enforce undocumented status and perpetuate disability at one point in the midst of advocating for her daughter claudia suddenly finds herself struck by debilitating pain claudia is lifted up by her comadres sent to the doctor and reminded why she must care for herself a braided narrative that speaks to the power of stories for creating connection this book reveals what remains undocumented in the motherhood of mexican women who find themselves making impossible decisions and multiple sacrifices as they build a future for their families

a rich long term ethnography of women seafood traders in mexico the shrimp ladies locally known as changueras in southern sinaloa mexico sell seafood in open air markets forming an extralegal but key part of the economy built around this pink gold over time they struggled to evolve from marginalized peddlers to local icons depicted in popular culture even as they continue to work at an open air street market pink gold documents the shrimp traders resilience and resourcefulness from their early conflicts with the city state and federal authorities and forming a union to carving out a physical space for a seafood market and even engaging in conflicts with the mexican military drawing from her two decades of fieldwork maria l cruz torres explores the inspiring narrative of this overlooked group of women involving grassroots politics trans border and familial networking debt and informal economic practices personal sacrifices and simple courage she argues that amid intense economic competition their success relies on group solidarity that creates interlocking networks of mutual trust or confianza that in turn enable them to cross social and political boundaries that would typically be closed to them ultimately pink gold offers fresh insights into issues of gender and labor urban public space the street economy commodities and globalization

a personal provocative and boundary breaking volume on the power relations that racialized gendered and sexualized researchers grapple with while conducting activist research fugitive anthropology is a transnational intergenerational engagement that extends feminist theory activist research methodologies and the discipline of anthropology in new directions contributors examine the tensions that arise from conducting politically engaged collaborative research alongside communities in struggle in particular theorizing from the experiences of racialized women queer trans and gender nonconforming researchers across distinct geographies essays contend with the matrices of colonial imperial and patriarchal violence that afflict the researchers and communities with which they seek political alignment articulating an ethnographic practice grounded in black and indigenous political struggles and committed to collective liberation the volume reflects on what it means to navigate violent relations of power systemic inequities and current onslaughts shaping field research and us academia ultimately fugitive anthropology argues that a feminist ethos one that embraces embodied knowledges and fugitive sensibilities forges liberatory spaces that break from dominant masculinist frames of the political and challenge colonial regimes within and beyond the neoliberal university

this deeply researched collection offers a comprehensive introduction to the eighteenth century trade in street literature ballads chapbooks and popular prints in england and scotland offering detailed studies of a selection of the printers types of publication and places of publication that constituted the cheap and popular print trade during the period these essays delve into ballads slip songs story books pictures and more to push back against neat divisions between low and high culture or popular and high literature the breadth and depth of the contributions give a much fuller and more nuanced picture of what was being widely published and read during this period than has previously been available it will be of great value to scholars and students of eighteenth century popular culture and literature print history and the book trade ballad and folk studies children s literature and social history

this companion is divided into six sections that provide an introduction to and critical history of the field discussions of key texts and a critical debate on major topics such as the nation race gender and migration in the final section contributors examine the material dissemination of caribbean literature and point towards the new directions that caribbean literature and criticism are taking

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
