what statistical evidence shows us about our misguided educational policies uneducated guesses challenges everything our policymakers thought they knew about education and education reform from how to close the achievement gap in public schools to admission standards for top universities in this explosive book howard wainer uses statistical evidence to show why some of the most widely held beliefs in education today and the policies that have resulted are wrong he shows why colleges that make the sat optional for applicants end up with underperforming students and inflated national rankings and why the push to substitute achievement tests for aptitude tests makes no sense wainer challenges the thinking behind the enormous rise of advanced placement courses in high schools and demonstrates why assessing teachers based on how well their students perform on tests a central pillar of recent education reforms is woefully misguided he explains why college rankings are often lacking in hard evidence why essay questions on tests disadvantage women why the most grievous errors in education testing are not made by testing organizations and much more no one concerned about seeing our children achieve their full potential can afford to ignore this book with forceful storytelling wry insight and a wealth of real world examples uneducated guesses exposes today s educational policies to the light of empirical evidence and offers solutions for fairer and more viable future policies

this text provides an overview of bi and multilingualism as a worldwide phenomenon it features comprehensive discussions of many of the linguistic social political and educational issues found in an increasingly multilingual nation and world to this end the book takes the chicano latino community of southern california where spanish english bilingualism has over a century and a half of history and presents a detailed case study thereby situating the community in a much broader social context spanish is the second most widely spoken language in the u s after english yet for the most part its speakers form a language minority that essentially lacks the social political and educational support necessary to derive the many cognitive socioeconomic and educational benefits that proficient bilingualism can provide the issues facing spanish english bilinguals in the los angeles area are relevant to nearly every bi and multilingual community irrespective of nation language and or ethnicity

this edited volume adopts a new angle on the study of spanish in the united states one that transcends the use of spanish as an ethnic language and explores it as a language spreading across new domains education public spaces and social media it aims to position spanish in the united states in the wider frame of global multilingualism and in line with new perspectives of analysis such as superdiversity translanguaging

indexicality and multimodality all the 15 chapters analyze spanish use as an instance of social change in the sense that monolingual cultural reproduction changes and produces cultural transformation furthermore these chapters represent five macro regions of the united states the southwest the west the midwest the northeast and the southeast

this is the first book in english on horacio quiroga uruguay 1878 argentina 1937 a canonical author whose works are read by all advanced students of spanish in the us and many other countries the study examines quiroga s work through the theoretical lens of the heroic a lens elaborated in part by means of quiroga s own disquisitions on the subject and the complementary phenomenon of the monstrous this lens serves to elucidate many evidently obscure and self contradictory aspects of quiroga s work and its relation to the context in which he lived that context included the neo colonial social and economic milieu of argentina s fast changing immigrant charged increasingly materialistic society the growing influence of foreign cultural discourses particularly hollywood film the conflict between the genders in a society that embraced modernity but resisted changes in gender roles the weight of new scientific discourses especially darwinian evolution in social and political thought and the impact on pedagogical theory and practice of these multiple changing discourses this study discloses the extraordinary range of quiroga s work which includes erotic romance science fiction and fantasy psychological occult social satire a great variety of juvenile literature outdoor adventure and most familiar to readers in the united states gothic and naturalist horror the book concludes that quiroga s consistent imperative of the heroic is essential to reconciling these various evidently incompatible aspects of quiroga s poetics revealing its theoretical and ethical coherence
