this resource uses primary documents and contextualizing essays to illuminate how america s presidents have responded to major tests of their leadership and approached their role and responsibilities in times of national crisis presidents hold the attention of the public like no other political actor in addition because of their unique role in the constitutional system presidents often take immediate unilateral action in the face of national emergencies exploring key events crises and disasters through the lens of presidential responsiveness this text reveals not only the larger historical context but also the authority of presidents in meeting the felt necessities of the time deepening readers understanding of those touchstone events comprehensive in temporal and topical scope the book covers crises and disasters from the presidency of george washington through donald trump s first two years in office important events covered include natural disasters wars assassinations terrorist attacks mass shootings economic crises riots tragedies and political scandals each event is explored through a primary document that reveals

key dimensions of the presidential response to the crisis or disaster in question and contextual headnotes and essays that provide additional insights into the political economic and cultural contexts in which that event occurred and to which the president responded

the obama administration is shaping up to be one of the most consequential in recent american history in this book a diverse group of presidential scholars step back from the partisan debate to consider the first two years of the obama presidency through the lens of the u s constitution's theory structure and powers they ask how barack obama understands and exercises the president's formal constitutional and informal powers and responsibilities of the president from foreign policy and public policy to his political leadership of the democratic party and the nation as a whole this timely first look at the obama presidency establishes a constitutional yardstick of interest to scholars of the presidency constitutional thought and american political thought

can presidents hope to be effective in policy making when congress is ruled by the other party political scientist richard conley brings to this crucial discussion a fresh perspective he argues persuasively that the conditions of divided government have changed in recent years and he applies a rigorous methodology that allows the testing of a number of important assumptions about party control of the legislative process and the role of the president conley demonstrates that recent administrations have faced a very different playing field than those in the earlier post war years because of such critical developments in electoral politics as decreasing presidential coattails and the lack of presidential popularity in opposition members districts moreover he identifies several changes in the institutional setting in congress that have affected both the legislative success rates of presidents programs and the strategies presidents pursue these institutional factors include more assertive legislative majorities changes in leadership structure and increased party cohesion in voting conley uses both case studies and sophisticated time series regression analyses to examine the floor success of presidential initiatives the strategies presidents use in working with the legislature and the use of veto power to achieve presidential aims scholars of the presidency and those interested in the larger american political process will find in this book both food for thought and a model of analytic sophistication

this work is the first systematic study of the presidency of the european commission drawing upon cases of attempted leadership by jacques delors the commission president from 1985-95 it examines the leadership capacity of the office holder this points to the inherently shared and contingent nature of commission president's leadership in a union where the leadership sources are widely dispersed while this is essentially an empirical study endo addresses some of the theoretical implications of its findings and resulting issues

benjamin harrison was an early proponent of american expansion in the pacific a key figure in such landmark legislation as the sherman anti trust act and the mckinley tariff and one of the gilded age s most eloquent speakers yet he remains one of our most neglected and least understood presidents in this first interpretive study of the harrison administration the authors illuminate our twenty third president s character and policies and rescue him from the long shadow of his charismatic secretary of state james g blaine an ohio native and indiana lawyer harrison opened the second century of the american presidency in a rapidly industrializing and expanding nation his inaugural address reflected the nation s optimism the masses of our people are better fed clothed and housed than their fathers were the facilities for popular education have been vastly enlarged and more generally diffused the virtues of courage and patriotism have given proof of their continued presence and increasing power in the hearts and over the lives of our people but the burdens and realities of his office soon imposed themselves upon harrison the biggest blow came at midterm with the republicans devastating losses in the 1890 congressional elections in an era of congressional dominance those losses eroded harrison s position as a legislative advocate at least for domestic issues his impact in foreign affairs was more lasting one of the highlights of this study is its revealing look at harrison s visionary foreign policy especially toward the pacific socolofsky and spetter convincingly demonstrate that although harrison s ambition to acquire the hawaiian islands was not realized during his presidency his foreign policy was a major step toward american control of hawaii and american expansion in the far east
