the story of the living theatre is also the story of the emergence of a new york avant garde in the 1950s and the resulting counterculture of the 1960s the company was a kind of theatrical tribe creating and staging plays collectively living communally and cultivating an atmosphere of sexual openness and adventure and what a cast of characters passes through these pages tennessee williams frank o hara anais nin james agee allen ginsberg and the beats jackson pollock and the abstract expressionists dorothy day john ashbery peggy guggenheim merce cunningham john cage alan hovhaness and maya deren among many others tytell has captured the mood and the artistic and political challenges of one of the most dynamic eras in american cultural history and the living theatre should be read by everyone who shares a passion for the arts and knows the sacrifices that passion at times demands

as cofounder of the internationally known highly controversial radical political troupe the living theater author judith malina is one of the leading female countercultural figures of the 50s 60s 70s and beyond in full moon stages personal notes from 50 years of the living theatre she creates an intimate memoir in a unique format with a collection of personal notes written on every full moon for 50 years from 1964 to 2014 these never before

published entries reveal malina's most private thoughts and inform the reader on what the living theatre was performing as they wound their way from new york city to italy france belgium germany and brazil in a nomadic series of notable performances of such underground classics as *The Brig*, *The Connection* and *Paradise Now*. malina is relentless in her commitment to the full moon schedule writing regardless of her current life circumstance. notes issue forth from hotels trains even prison offering a light on the consequences of holding true to her code of the theatrical expression of her pacifist anarchist principles.

Living Theatre: A History conveys the excitement and variety of theatre throughout time as well as the dynamic way in which our interpretation of theatre history is informed by contemporary scholarship. rather than presenting readers with a mere catalog of historical facts and figures, it sets each period in context through an exploration of the social, political and economic conditions of the day, creating a vivid study of the developments in theatre during that time.

counterculture while commonly used to describe youth oriented movements during the 1960s refers to any attempt to challenge or change conventional values and practices or the dominant lifestyles of the day this fascinating three volume set explores these movements in america from colonial times to the present in colorful detail american countercultures is the first reference work to examine the impact of countercultural movements on american social history it highlights the writings recordings and visual works produced by these movements to educate inspire and incite action in all eras of the nation s history a z entries provide a wealth of information on personalities places events concepts beliefs groups and practices the set includes numerous illustrations a topic finder primary source documents a bibliography and a filmography and an index

scholarly work on the impact of an active audience on theatrical and dance performance is a relatively new phenomenon one that until now has manifested itself largely in the form of scattered dialogue on the subject audience participation essays on inclusion in performance serves as a corrective to this while the passive audience has long been acknowledged in works on response theory and audience studies for its contribution to the performance event performance styles that use the audience as an active contributing creative force have been appended to the studies as merely variations on a theme this anthology brings together essays on direct audience participation in the work of fourteen widely varied theatrical and dance artists covering performance genres of the past and present popular entertainment and high art its comprehensiveness and uniqueness make it an important contribution to the literature on theater and its many forms and facets

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
