this volume is one of the most important works on ancient athens in the last fifty years the focus is on the early city from the end of the bronze age ca 1200 bce to the archaic period when athens became the largest city of the classical period only to be destroyed by the persians in 480 479 bce from a systematic study of all the excavation reports and surveys in central athens the author has synthesized a detailed diachronic overview of the city from the submycenaean period through the archaic it is a treasure trove of information for

archaeologists who work in this period of great value as well are the detailed maps included which present features of ancient settlements and cemeteries the repositories of the human physical record over eighty additional large scale interactive maps are available online to complement the book

in the twentieth century the political zionist movement and egyptian rulers completely uprooted the country s thriving jewish community a goal the pharaohs tried to realize as early as 3500 years ago mostly comprised of descendants of sephardim from the iberian peninsula the world s oldest jewish community totaled 85 000 members in 1948 no more than 100 to 200 jews live in egypt today this book tells the story of egypt s jewish history from biblical times to 1967 the year of one of the last major jewish emigration waves from egypt it highlights the first exodus in ca 1500 bce and the second exodus which was triggered by the foundation of the state of israel and three successive wars in 1948 1956 and 1967 throughout the narrative it becomes evident that the jewish community consistently was subject to the arbitrary will of egyptian rulers starting in 1948 members of this community were forced to leave the country without any of their belongings on short notice like other jews from the arab world egyptian jews were not zionists in the eurocentric ashkenazi sense their arrival in israel was met with prejudice and disdain even though they were discriminated against in matters of housing and education they still managed to integrate well into israeli society and are now members of the country s upper and middle class the evidence presented in this book is based on interviews with ninety six egyptian jews in israel and the united states

the brain of an echo locating bat is devoted in large part to analyzing sound and conducting behavior in a world of sounds and echoes this monograph is about analysis of sound in the brainstem of echolocating bats and concerns the relationship between brain structure and brain function echolocating bats are unique subjects for the study of such relationships like man echolocating bats emit sounds just for the purpose of listening to them simply by observing the bat s echolocation sounds we know what the bat listens to in nature we therefore have a good idea what the bat s auditory brain is designed to do but this alone does not make the bat unique the brain of the bat is by mammalian standards rather primitive the unique aspect is the combination of primitive characteristics and complex auditory processing within this small brain the auditory structures are hypertrophied and have an elegance of organization not seen in other mammals it is as if the auditory pathways had evolved while the rest of the brain remained evolutionary quiescent
