in the search for matthean theology scholars overwhelmingly approach the gospel of matthew as the the most jewish gospel studies of its sitz im leben focus on its relationship to judaism whether arguing from the perspective that matthew wrote from a cloistered jewish community or as the leader of a gentile rebellion against such a jewish community while this is undoubtedly an important and necessary discussion for understanding the gospel it often assumes too much about the relationship between judaism and hellenism via martin hengel robert s kinney argues for a hybridized perspective in which matthew's attention to jewish sources and ideas is not denied but in which echoes of greek and roman sources can be observed focusing on identifying matthew's use of rhetoric and its possible echoes of greco roman philosophical disciple gathering teachers

three hundred years after his death matthew henry 1662 1714 remains arguably the best known expositor of the bible in english due largely to his massive six volume exposition of the old and new testaments however henry's famous commentary is by no means the only expression of his engagement with the scriptures his many sermons and works on christian piety including the still popular method for prayer are saturated with his peculiarly practical approach to the bible to mark the tercentenary of henry's death matthew a collins and paul middleton have brought together notable historians theologians and biblical scholars to celebrate his life and legacy representing the first serious examination of henry's body of work and approach to the bible matthew henry the bible prayer and piety opens a scholarly

conversation about the place of matthew henry in the eighteenth century nonconformist movement his contribution to the interpretation of the bible and his continued legacy in evangelical piety

this commentary demonstrates gundry s conviction that matthew relied on the gospel of mark and the document q furthermore gundry argues for a combination of historical data and theological embellishments in passages such as those that present the birth of jesus the sermon on the mount and peter s walking on the water

there are five marked quotations from psalms in the gospel of matthew these are 1 ps 91 1 12 in matt 4 6 2 ps 78 2 in matt 13 35 3 ps 8 3 in matt 21 16 4 ps 118 22 23 in matt 21 42 and 5 ps 110 1 in matt 22 44 piotr herok argues that the investigated texts are related to each other not only by the presence of the introductory formulas making clear that a given citation comes from scripture but also through mutual thematic convergence concerning in various degrees king david the temple and the theme of jesus identity thanks to the new literary context in which the quotations are embedded matthew reinterprets them significantly while giving them a new dimension clearly distinguishing them from the rest of the psalm quotations found in his work this aims at presenting jesus as not only the son of david but first of all the son of god

although recent discussions on matthew have emphasized the document s setting within judaism these studies have not analyzed how the jewish figure of john the baptist functions within this setting brian dennert steps into this gap arguing that matthew presents jesus to be the continuation and culmination of john s ministry in order to strengthen the claims of matthew s group and to vilify the opponents of his group by doing this he encourages jews yet to align with matthew s group particularly those who esteem the baptist and to gravitate away from its opponents the author examines texts roughly contemporaneous with matthew which reveal respect given to john the baptist at the time of matthew s composition the examination of matthew shows that the first evangelist more closely connects the baptist to jesus while highlighting his rejection by jewish authorities

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
