

Bold Spirit Helga Estbys Forgotten Walk Across

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in 1896 a norwegian immigrant and mother of eight children named helga estby was behind on taxes and the mortgage when she learned that a mysterious sponsor would pay 10 000 to a woman who walked across america hoping to win the wager and save her family s farm helga and her teenaged daughter clara armed with little more than a compass red pepper spray a revolver and clara s curling iron set out on foot from

eastern washington their route would pass through 14 states but they were not allowed to carry more than five dollars each as they visited indian reservations western boomtowns remote ranches and local civic leaders they confronted snowstorms hunger thieves and mountain lions with equal aplomb their treacherous and inspirational journey to new york challenged contemporary notions of femininity and captured the public imagination but their trip had such devastating consequences that the estby women s achievement was blanketed in silence until nearly a century later linda lawrence hunt encountered their extraordinary story

helga estby left spokane washington and walked to nyc on a 10 000 challenge this remarkable story of hardship and suffering was long lost and only recently discovered by the author on christmas eve 1896 the new york world reported her arrival what followed was an american tragedy

while known as the home of father s day spokane benefited from its share of trailblazing women in 1886 mother joseph a pioneering architect constructed the first sacred heart hospital after fire destroyed thirty six blocks in 1889 anna stratton browne and her friends raised 10 000 to build a home for needy children that operated for six decades and in early 1908 may hutton became president of the spokane equal suffrage league persevering until 1910 when washington voters gave women the vote historian nancy driscoll engle commemorates the unforgettable contributions of spokane s women

spokane washington s first female physician mary archard latham moved to the community with her three sons leaving her husband behind in ohio in 1888 she sought a better climate for her health and worked tirelessly for the health of all of spokane s citizens but particularly women and children and especially the poor she helped found the spokane humane society and the spokane public library and she was beloved and respected in the community then in 1903 one of her sons died and she seemingly became unhinged she would be seen wandering the streets wailing and inconsolable and her behavior became extremely erratic in 1905 she was accused arrested and convicted of arson then sentenced to four years of hard labor in the state penitentiary she escaped into the forests of idaho where she hid from a massive manhunt for a week before being captured and sent to prison in walla walla she eventually returned to spokane a broken yet determined woman and died in 1917 despite the tragic and violent events that characterized her later years today dr mary a latham is honored in spokane for the good she did in the first part of her life mercy and madness captures the captivating outrageous and sometimes sorrowful life of dr mary archard latham in her own

words

on his seventieth birthday in 1909 a slim man with a shock of white hair a walrus mustache and a spring in his step faced west from Park Row in Manhattan and started walking by the time Edward Payson Weston was finished he was in San Francisco having trekked 3 895 miles in 104 days Weston's first epic walk across America transcended sport he was everyman in a stirring battle against the elements and exhaustion tramping along at the pace of someone decades younger having long been America's greatest pedestrian he was attempting the most ambitious and physically taxing walk of his career he walked most of the way alone when the car that he hired to follow him kept breaking down and he often had to rest without adequate food or shelter that Weston made it is one of the truly great but forgotten sports feats of all time thanks in large part to his daily dispatches of his travails from blizzards to intense heat rutted roads bad shoes and illness Weston's trek became a wonder of the ages and attracted international headlines to the sport called pedestrianism aided by long buried archival information colorful biographical details and Weston's diary entries *Walk of Ages* is more than a book about a man going for a walk it is an epic tale of beating the odds and a penetrating look at a vanished time in America

a gravestone a mention in local archives stories still handed down around oyster bay the outline of a woman begins to emerge and with her the world she inhabited so rich in tradition and shaken by violent change katie kettle gale was born into a salish community in puget sound in the 1850s just as settlers were migrating into what would become washington state with her people forced out of their traditional hunting and fishing

grounds into ill provisioned island camps and reservations katie gale sought her fortune in oyster bay in that early outpost of multiculturalism where native americans and immigrants from the eastern united states europe and asia vied for economic social political and legal power a woman like gale could make her way as llyn de danaan mines the historical record we begin to see gale a strong willed native woman who cofounded a successful oyster business then won the legal rights from her euro american husband a man with whom she had raised children but who ultimately made her life unbearable steeped in sadness with a lost home and a broken marriage children dying in their teens and tuberculosis claiming her at forty three katie gale s story is also one of remarkable pluck a tale of hard work and ingenuity gritty initiative and bad luck that is ultimately essentially american

c c cash and carry pyle made several fortunes representing professional football and tennis players before losing everything and disappearing into history s dustbin this work reevaluates pyle s fast life and times while analyzing his extraordinary and enduring legacy in 1925 pyle rocked the sports world by inducing red grange to abandon the leafy confines of the university of illinois for pro football in essence thumbing his nose at protesting academics who insisted the move would irreparably harm both the college game and grange s career the book continues through all of pyle s successes and more than a few of his failures including his signing of controversial french tennis star suzanne lenglen and his near bankruptcy following losses incurred staging the short lived annual union derby as newspaper columnists dubbed the notorious 3 470 mile transcontinental footrace first held in 1928
