despite bringing prosperity industrialisation generally leads to increasing levels of pollution which has a detrimental impact on the environment in response legislation which seeks to control or prevent such impact has become common similarly climate change and energy security have become major drivers for the regulatory regimes that have emerged in the energy field given the global or regional scope of many environmental problems international cooperation is often necessary to ensure such legislation is effective the eu and the uk have contributed to the development of the environmental and energy law regimes currently in force spanning across international transnational and national levels at the same time practical responses to environmental and energy problems have largely been the focus of engineers scientists and other technical experts environmental energy law attempts to bridge the knowledge gap between legal developments designed to achieve environmental and or energy related objectives and the practical scientific and technical considerations applicable to the same environmental problems in particular it attempts to convey a broad range of topical issues in environmental and energy law from climate and energy regulation technology innovation and transfer to pollution control environmental governance and enforcement in addition the book outlines key sector specific legal regimes including water waste and air quality management focusing on issues or topics that are particularly relevant to both environmental and energy lawyers and engineering science and technology oriented professionals and students in this vein the book guides the reader on some basic practical applications of the law within scientific engineering and other practical settings the book will be useful to all those working or studying in the environmental or energy arena

including law students legal professionals engineering and science students and professionals by adopting a multi disciplinary approach to environmental and energy law the book embraces all readerships and helps to address the often thorny problem of communication between scientists engineers lawyers and policy makers

this book is devoted to complex questions of building and developing legal education in more than one language through two state languages french and dutch in belgium german and french in switzerland english and french in canada finnish and swedish in finland and or through the medium of minority or lesser used languages basque galician catalan welsh romanian some states have a long and well established tradition of bilingual legal education others have only recently started to develop a legal education system through non dominant languages finally in some other cases only partial bilingual legal education obtains rather than a fuller model the volume purports to examine best practices and to draw useful lessons from the experiences of other bilingual societies

we ve seen it before with asbestos related disease leukaemia clusters and lung cancer caused by cigarettes there tends to be a lag between the emergence of environmental risks and chemical injuries and their recognition and therapeutic treatment by medicine and the law law environmental illness and medical uncertainty examines how our society governs new health concerns as they emerge and the barriers that face new and uncertain theories seeking recognition in the law in this book tarryn phillips focuses her investigation on the struggle over the controversial condition multiple chemical sensitivities or mcs also known as environmental illness presenting nine case studies where workers sought compensation for mcs from their multinational employers she captures a nuanced portrait of their embittered unequal battles over the scientific legal and insurance paradigms for understanding toxic risk environmental illness and the regulation of industry it draws on three years of fieldwork in australia including interview data with lay people and sympathetic and sceptical experts participant observation in the courtroom and textual analysis of official reports the book gives a unique ethnographic insight into the governance of risk and uncertainty within a neoliberal economy medico scientific controversies and courtroom dramas it highlights how a skeptical approach towards emergent environmental concerns is encouraged within the current regime and decision makers face disincentives for taking a sympathetic approach compellingly written and easy to read it should appeal widely to interested lay people and students and scholars of science and technology studies medical anthropology sociology of health and illness and critical legal studies
