new chapter comparing treatment approaches to autism greater attention to erikson s theory of identity formation and how it pertains to gender issues new thoughts on cultural factors in piaget s theory biographical material on jane goodall howard thurman and albert einstein that illustrate developmental processes demonstrating how we might view the world differently at various stages of life theories of development is a must read for all students of psychology and education

cultural variability looking beyond age based changed to understand development and resolving fragmentation by starting with whole person functioning the framework also opens up new directions for research this book will be useful to developmentalists graduate students upper level undergraduates and others who seek an integrative understanding of the field as a whole and a systematic way of thinking about and investigating human action and development
