This year's themes were both associated with the fact that the technology of intelligent agents and multi agent systems is beginning to migrate from research labs to software engineering centers as agents are deployed in applications such as electronic commerce and start to take over responsibilities for their human users. Techniques for controlling their autonomy become crucial as well the availability of tools that facilitate the design and implementation of agent systems becomes an important factor in how rapidly the technology will achieve widespread use.
