this book outlines the history of squatting in sweden and analyzes the conditions under which squatting has intensified and declined in the country between 1968 and 2017 with close attention to the relationship between civil society and the state in the swedish context and the manner in which this relationship together with attendant political media and movement based discourses shapes the possibilities that exist for collective action the author draws on two key concepts those of the narrative of consensus and discourse to present an analysis of squatting as a form of contentious politics and the successful story of civil society development as decisive for its emergence and development in the country a study of the way in which confrontational actors question both the property relations inherent in capitalism and the authority of the welfare state and its institutions contentious politics and the welfare state will appeal to social scientists with interests in urban studies political sociology squatting social movements and the relationship between the welfare state and contentious social actors

this volume covers the middle time period of the syrian uprising roughly from 2012 when syria s peaceful protest began to mutate into a violent insurgency and civil war until roughly 2018 when the conflict took on features of a frozen conflict the middle period was important as one of key junctures or turning points when the struggle could have reached rather different

outcomes non violent protest failed to drive democratization and turned into violent insurrection but revolution from below also failed as did regime counter insurgency leaving protracted civil war the default outcome second the consequences of civil war became evident with six themes failing statehood coexisted with regime resilience rebel governance emerged as a viable challenge to the regime social forces were sharply polarized external actors exacerbated internal divisions a predatory war economy emerged and intense violence led to massive displacement of the population taking an innovative and interdisciplinary approach that seeks to capture the full complexity of the phenomenon this book contributes significantly to our understanding of the syrian conflict therefore it will be of interest to academics students journalists and policy makers interested in the syrian civil war

the asian pacific is now one of the most important regions in the global system where the interplay of integrative economic geo political and sociocultural processes provide increasing scope for regional leadership to be exercised particularly by china and japan this book studies the relationship between the people s republic of china and japan as the basis of the construction and maintenance of economic and security arrangements in this region it explains how these arrangements have been challenged by the occasionally testy ties between these two major asian powers and explores their dynamic interactions in promoting their own agenda and ambitions and obstructing that of the other s in contending for leadership of east asia in so doing it highlights the complex interdependence and competitiveness of china and japan with careful observation from the united states this book provides practical guidance for foreign policymaking in china japan and the united states and makes theoretical inferences for the study of sino japanese relations regional integration and international relations generally

written with media students in mind this accessible book provides both students and researchers with a new perspective on how to research engagement not as a metric but as a marker of power relations this book navigates the reader through a tighter analytical notion of engagement within an understanding of media culture and democracy dahlgren and hill offer a new definition of engagement as an energising internal force and as such a powerful means to further human agency from this definition the book builds a generative theory of engagement as a nexus of relations we make and break with media on a daily basis with examples from political activism news and disinformation and the global pandemic dahlgren and hill identify five parameters of engagement in order to understand the relations we have with media across changing public and mediated spheres this new perspective offers students and researchers pathways for investigating the meaning of media engagement as a resource for living it will be particularly useful for undergraduate courses on media audiences and publics political communication and democracy media and cultural theory journalism and for media communication and sociology studies more broadly

in the global north the commoditization of creativity and knowledge under the banner of a creative economy is being posed as the post industrial answer to dependency on labour and natural resources not only does it promise a more stable and sustainable future but an economy focused on intellectual property is more environmentally friendly so it is suggested contested powers argues that the fixes being offered by this model are bluffs development as witnessed in latin american energy politics and governance remains hindered by a global division of labour and nature that puts the capacity for technological advancement in private hands the authors call for a multi layered understanding of sovereignty arguing that it holds the key to undermining rigid accounts of the relationship between carbon and democracy energy and development and energy and political expression furthermore a critical focus on energy politics is crucial to wider debates on development and sustainability contested powers is essential reading for those wondering how energy resources are converted into political power and why we still value the energy we take from our surroundings more than the means of its extraction
