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in this highly illustrated book mary t boatwright examines five of the peoples incorporated into the roman world from the republican through the imperial periods northerners greeks egyptians jews and christians she explores over time the tension between assimilation and distinctiveness in the roman world as well as the changes effected in rome by its multicultural nature underlining the fundamental importance of diversity in rome s self identity the book explores roman tolerance of difference and community as the romans expanded and consolidated their power and incorporated other peoples into their empire the peoples of the roman world provides an accessible account of rome s social cultural religious and political history exploring the rich literary documentary and visual evidence for these peoples and rome s reactions to them

this collection tells the story of the rise of rome from its origins as a cluster of villages to the foundation of the roman empire by augustus chapters deal with subjects such as philosophy arts the conquests of rome roman emperors roman literature roman historians and much more

goodman presents a lucid and balanced picture of the roman world examining the roman empire from a variety of perspectives cultural political civic social and religious

includes an account of political and military developments and including sections on social

economic and cultural life this book presents a survey of the roman world at a time when the principate was established and the pax romana consolidated

the roman world is an investigative course designed to develop students historical knowledge skills and understanding of ancient rome it is divided into units that present different aspects of the roman world and pose key historical questions the unit topics include the rise of the roman republic family life gods and goddesses roman britain and the decline and fall of the empire each unit carefully balances explanation and investigation while overview and review sections introduce and consolidate key themes and concepts the book's content is drawn from a wide range of primary sources explanatory diagrams and maps the roman world is an excellent introduction and is suitable for use in ancient history or latin courses an accompanying teacher's resource book includes teaching objectives practical ideas for each unit and photocopiable resource sheets with lively classroom activities

the 57 documents in this sourcebook introduce readers to many of the major topics of roman history from the period of the twelve tables c 451 bc to the later roman empire each of the selections has been chosen for its historical significance and intrinsic interest and is introduced and annotated by the editor

a history of the roman world from ad 138 to 337 1958 looks at the last centuries of the roman empire from the rule of hadrian and his policy of consolidation of the roman empire halting its further expansion to the reign of constantine and the rise of christianity

this volume focuses on the changing relationship between warfare and the roman citizenry from the republic when war was at the heart of roman life through to the principate when it was confined to professional soldiers and to the late empire and the roman army's eventual failure

this volume presents eighteen papers by leading roman historians and archaeologists discussing trade in the roman empire during the period c 100 bc to ad 350 it focuses especially on the role of the roman state in shaping the institutional framework for trade within and outside the empire in taxing that trade and in intervening in the markets to ensure the supply of particular commodities especially for the city of rome and for the army as part of a novel interdisciplinary approach to the subject the chapters address its myriad facets on the basis of broadly different sources of

evidence historical papyrological and archaeological they are grouped into three sections covering institutional factors taxation legal structures market regulation financial institutions evidence for long distance trade within the empire in wood stone glass and pottery and trade beyond the frontiers with the east as far as china india arabia the red sea and the sahara rome s external trade with realms to the east emerges as being of particular significance but it is in the eastern part of the empire itself where the state appears to have adapted the mechanisms of taxation in collaboration with the elite holders of wealth to support its need for revenue on the other hand the price of that collaboration which was in effect a fiscal partnership ultimately led in the longer term in slightly different forms in the east and the west to a fundamental change in the political character of the empire

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
