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the story fed up with the pressures and demands of her acting career the famous myra marlowe leases a house in the tiny new england hamlet of beaver haven and settles down to write her autobiography she is successful in turning aside the offers

this book is about the metanarrative and metafictional elements of j m coetzee s novels it draws together authorship readership ethics and formal analysis into one overarching argument about how narratives work the boundary between art and life on the basis of

coetzee's writing it reconsiders the concept of metalepsis challenges common understandings of self reflexive discourse and invites us to rethink our practice as critics and readers this study analyzes coetzee's novels in three chapters organized thematically around the author's relation with character reader and self author and character are discussed on the basis of *Slow Man* and coetzee's nobel lecture he and his man stories featuring the character elizabeth costello or the figuration elizabeth curren serve to elaborate the relation of author and reader the study ends on a reading of *Summertime Diary of a Bad Year* and *Dusklands* as coetzee's engagement with autobiographical writing analyzing the relation of author and self it will appeal to readers with an interest in literary and narrative theory as much as to coetzee scholars and advanced students

a magisterial history of french society between the end of the middle ages and the revolution by one of the world's leading authorities on early modern france using colorful examples and incorporating the latest scholarship william beik conveys the distinctiveness of early modern society and identifies the cultural practices that defined the lives of people at all levels of society painting a vivid picture of the realities of everyday life he reveals how society functioned and how the different classes interacted in addition to chapters on nobles peasants city people and the court the book sheds new light on the catholic church the army popular protest the culture of violence gendered relations and sociability this is a major new work that restores the *ancien régime* as a key epoch in its own right and not simply as the prelude to the coming revolution

originally published in the great depression this accessible volume was aimed not only at the academic economist but also the general reader the cycles of panic boom and bust are discussed and solutions provided as to how to get over the bust periods as efficiently as possible the commodities of wheat and gold are discussed in detail and comparisons made between uk and us budget surpluses and deficits

migration broadly defined as directional movement to take advantage of spatially distributed resources is a dramatic behaviour and an important component of many life histories that can contribute to the fundamental structuring of ecosystems in recent years our understanding of migration has advanced radically with respect to both new data and conceptual understanding it is now almost twenty years since publication of the first edition and an authoritative and up to date sequel that provides a taxonomically comprehensive overview of the latest research is therefore timely the emphasis throughout this advanced textbook is on the definition and description of migratory behaviour its ecological outcomes for individuals populations and communities and how these outcomes lead to natural selection acting on the behaviour to cause its evolution it takes a truly integrative approach showing how comparisons across a diversity of organisms and biological disciplines can illuminate migratory life cycles their evolution and the relation of migration to other movements migration the biology of life on the move focuses on migration as a behavioural phenomenon with important ecological consequences for organisms as diverse as aphids butterflies birds and whales it is suitable for senior undergraduate and graduate level students taking courses in behaviour spatial ecology movement ecology and conservation it will also be of interest and use to a broader audience of professional ecologists and behaviourists seeking an authoritative overview of this rapidly expanding field
