reclaiming 42 centers on one of america s most respected cultural icons jackie robinson and the forgotten aspects of his cultural legacy since his retirement in 1956 and more strongly in the last twenty years america has primarily remembered robinson s legacy in an oversimplified way as the pioneering first black baseball player to integrate the major leagues the mainstream commemorative discourse regarding robinson s career has been created and directed largely by major league baseball mlb which sanitized and oversimplified his legacy into narratives of racial reconciliation that celebrate his integrity character and courage while excluding other aspects of his life such as his controversial political activity his public clashes with other prominent members of the black community and his criticism of mlb mlb s commemoration of robinson reflects a professional sport that is inclusive racially and culturally tolerant and largely postracial yet robinson s identity and therefore his memory has been relegated to the boundaries of a baseball diamond and to the context of a sport and it is within this oversimplified legacy that history has failed him the dominant version of robinson s legacy ignores his political voice during and after his baseball career and pays little attention to the repercussions that his integration had on many factions within the black community reclaiming 42 illuminates how public memory of robinson has undergone changes over the last sixty plus years and moves his story beyond robinson the baseball player opening a new broader interpretation of an otherwise seemingly convenient narrative to show how robinson s legacy ultimately should both challenge and inspire public memory

potentially life changing transformation and influence you don't have to shut down you can upshift

the free standing radios of the middle decades of the 20th century were invitingly rotund and proudly displayed nothing like today's skinny televisions hidden inside entertainment centers radios were the hub of the family's after dinner activities and children and adults gorged themselves on western adventure series like the lone ranger police dramas such as calling all cars and the varied offerings of the cavalcade of america shows often aired two or three times a week and many programs were broadcast for more than a decade comprising hundreds of episodes this book includes more than 300 program logs many appearing in print for the first time drawn from newspapers script files in broadcast museums records from nbc abc and cbs and the personal records of series directors each entry contains a short broadcast history that includes directors writers and actors and the broadcast dates and airtimes a comprehensive index rounds out the work

with personal interviews of players and owners and with over two decades of research in newspapers and archives bill marshall tells of the players the pennant races and the officials who shaped one of the most memorable eras in sports and american history at the end of world war ii soldiers returning from overseas hungered to resume their love affair with baseball spectators still identified with players whose salaries and off season employment as postmen plumbers farmers and insurance salesmen resembled their own it was a time when kids played baseball on sandlots and in pastures fans followed the game on the radio and tickets were affordable the outstanding play of joe dimaggio stan musial ted williams bob feller don newcombe warren spahn and many others dominated the field but perhaps no performance was more important than that of jackie robinson whose entrance into the game broke the color barrier won him the respect of millions of americans and helped set the stage for the civil rights movement baseball s pivotal era 1945 1951 also records the attempt to organize the pittsburgh pirates and the mexican league s success in luring players south of the border that led to a series of lawsuits that almost undermined baseball s reserve clause and antitrust exemption the result was spring training pay uniform contracts minimum salary levels player representation and a pension plan the very issues that would divide players and owners almost fifty years later during these years the game was led by a b happy chandler a hand shaking speech making singing kentucky politician most owners thought he would be easily manipulated unlike baseball s first commissioner the autocratic judge kennesaw mountain landis instead chandler s style led one owner to complain that he was the player s commissioner the fan s commissioner the press and radio commissioner everybody s commissioner but the men who pay him

abbott and costello were the most popular comedians of the 1940s with burlesque inspired routines that enthralled audiences on both radio and television oddly their films have not received the same level of attention from critics

and writers as those of other comedy teams this book is a scene by scene film by film guide to their movies making a compelling case for their inclusion at the very top of comic artists featuring new research and some surprising revelations the book introduces newcomers to the delights of this uproarious team and provides confirmed fans with the ultimate companion to their work also included is a foreword by john landis the celebrated director and abbott and costello devotee
