describes the fundamental ethical dilemmas embedded in the psychologist's array of roles: assessor, treater, and researcher. This title offers readers information on such complex issues as the duty to protect multiple relationships, privacy, privileged communication, and the treatment of minors and clients with HIV/AIDS.

This volume works to explore a transferable theory of a specific social psychological infrastructure based on the work of Dr. Daniel Bar-Tal that develops from cultures immersed in intractable conflicts. The book's approach to this issue is different from approaches that are predominant in social psychology. This is because an important inspiration of many scholars that contributed to the book is their everyday experience of living in a region where intractable conflict shapes the lives of everybody who lives there. On the basis of this experience and on the basis of extensive research, an elaborate theory of intractable conflict was developed that deals with the origin of such conflicts, the mechanisms that maintain them, and the processes that may contribute to their peaceful solution. In light of recent research and developments, this volume demonstrates, analyzes, and reviews the theory of a social psychological infrastructure formed in societies with intractable conflicts. It explores the contents of these elements of the infrastructure, the processes through which they are acquired and maintained, their functions, the societal mechanisms that contribute to their institutionalization, as well as their role in the crystallization of social identity and development of a culture of conflict. By demonstrating that it can be applied to various kinds of intractable conflicts in various places of the world, the volume argues that the theory is transferable and universal. Moreover, the volume aims to exhibit new connections and integrations between Bar-Tal's theories and other prominent

theoretical frameworks in social and political psychology presenting both a comprehensive overview of works that have been influenced by bar tal's theories and research as well as a wide gate to future studies that will connect bar tal's work to recent theoretical developments in related domains understanding the social psychology of intractable conflicts celebrating the legacy of daniel bar tal is an important text for all those interested in developing a sustainable peaceful world

it was just over 12 years ago that we first sat down together to talk about psychological traps in the relative calm of late afternoons feet draped casually over the seedy furnishings of the tufts psychology department we entertained each other with personal anecdotes about old cars times spent lost on hold and the shakespearean concerns of rosenkrantz and guildenstern lord and lady macbeth and other notables eventually informed by our many illustrations and the excitement that their repeated telling engendered in the two of us we began to move more formally into trap analysis how do you know a trap when you see one what are the shared characteristics of all psychological traps regardless of origin scope or complexity what are the key conceptual elements in any effort to differentiate among the traps of the world what factors make us more or less apt to fall prey to entrapment these were some of the questions that arose during these initial meetings a series of weekly meetings stretched over the ensuing years interrupted temporarily by various exigencies and led eventually to a research program that grew to involve a number of students and faculty colleagues at the time of course we did not regard our work as a research program rather even as our experiments proceeded to answer two burning questions at a time they managed to raise three or four new issues that we had not anticipated before

moreover as the landscape of psychological practice continues to evolve new challenges and considerations arise the integration of technology in therapy the growing emphasis on cultural competence and the increasing recognition of diversity highlight the need for psychologists to continually reassess their adherence to and understanding of fidelity and responsibility the implications of these developments necessitate a proactive approach to

ethical practice inviting psychologists to engage in ongoing education and reflection furthermore the intersectionality of various aspects of identity such as race gender sexual orientation and socioeconomic status adds additional layers of complexity to the obligations of fidelity and responsibility psychologists must remain vigilant in recognizing how these dimensions impact their clients experiences and their own roles as practitioners this awareness is crucial not only for enhancing the therapeutic alliance but also for safeguarding against potential ethical violations that may arise from unexamined biases or assumptions

this book sheds an illuminating light into the psyche of people involved in macro level destructive intergroup conflicts it also describes the changes in the socio psychological repertoire that are necessary to ignite the peace process finally it elaborates on the nature and the processes of peace building including conflict resolution and reconciliation

due to its intensity and extensive effects both locally and globally the israeli palestinian conflict has drawn the attention of scholars from numerous disciplines who attempt to explain the causes of the conflict and the reasons for the difficulties in resolving it among these one can find historians geographers political scientists sociologists and others this volume explores the israeli palestinian conflict from a social psychology perspective at the core of the book is a theory of intractable conflicts as developed by daniel bar tal of tel aviv university applied to the israeli palestinian conflict opening with an introduction to the israeli palestinian conflict situation and a few chapters on the theoretical backgrounds of the creation of a societal ethos of conflict the volume then moves to an analysis of the psycho social underpinnings of the conflict while concluding with a discussion of the possibility of long standing peace in the region among the topics included in the coverage are identity formation during conflict the israeli and palestinian ethos of conflict the important role of palestinian and israeli education an analysis of the leadership in the israeli palestinian peace process the challenges and potential towards a road to peace in the region all contributors to the volume are pre eminent scholars of the israeli palestinian conflict and many of them have felt the influence of bar tal s

formulations in their own work a rich resource for those who are followers of dr bar tal s work for those who study intractable conflicts in all its forms and for those who have a particular interest in the israeli palestinian conflict a social psychology perspective of the israeli palestinian case offers a detailed exploration of the psychological underpinnings of the israeli palestinian conflict and the barriers to and opportunities of the peace process

despite the notable canadian presence in the field of psychology and law there is currently

handbook has been extensively revised in a number of ways throughout the book the text references and website addresses and have been updated to reflect important developments since the publication the first edition recent research findings on the epidemiology aetiology course outcome assessment and treatment of all psychological problems considered in this volume have been incorporated into the text account has been taken of changes in the diagnosis and classification of psychological problems reflected in the dsm 5 chapters on adhd in adults emotion focused therapy radically open dialectical behaviour therapy and schema therapy have been added the book is divided into 6 sections section 1 covers conceptual frameworks for practice lifespan development classification and epidemiology cbt psychodynamic emotion focused systemic and bio medical models and general assessment procedures section 2 deals with mood problems depression bipolar disorder suicide risk and anger management section 3 focuses on anxiety problems social phobia generalized anxiety disorder panic disorder obsessive compulsive disorder post traumatic stress disorder and depersonalization disorder section 4 deals with psychological problems linked to physical health health anxiety somatization chronic pain adjustment to cancer and eating disorders section 5 focuses on other significant psychological problems that come to the attention of clinical psychologist in adult mental health services adhd in adults alcohol and other drug problems psychosis and psychological problems in older adults section 6 contains chapters on therapeutic approaches to psychological distress related to complex childhood trauma dialectical behaviour therapy for borderline personality disorder racially open dialectical behaviour for over controlled presentations and schema therapy each of the chapters on clinical problems explains how to assess and treat the condition in an evidence based way with reference to case material interventions from cognitive behavioural psychodynamic interpersonal systemic and biomedical approaches are described where there is evidence that they are effective for the problem in question skill building exercises and further reading for psychologists and patients are included at the end of each chapter this book is one of a set of three volumes which cover the lion s share of the curriculum for clinical psychologists in training in the uk and ireland the other two volumes are the handbook of
