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this book uses an interdisciplinary approach to chart how various forms of violence domestic military legal and political are not separate instances of violence but rather embedded in structural inequalities brought about by colonialism occupation and state violence the book explores both case studies of individuals and of groups to examine experiences of violence within the context of gender and structures of power in modern indonesian history and indonesia related diasporas it argues that gendered violence is particularly important to consider in this region because of its complex history of armed conflict and authoritarian rule the diversity of people that have been affected by violence as well as the complexity of the religious and cultural communities involved the book focuses in particular on textual narratives of violence visualisations of violence commemorations of violence and the politics of care

this book aims to begin an eco centered eco feminist informed discussion about the ways in which our relationship to nature is bound up with gender patriarchy and violence ecofeminist scholars study the interconnections between gendered relationships of domination among humans between humans and between humans nonhumans and the earth it is in this ideological and structural tangle between

humans and the environment that a deeper understanding of gender violence is possible ecofeminism offers analytical possibilities for understanding a logic of domination which sustain a whole host of problems including the interrelated oppressions of gender violence and exploitation of the more than human life world in this book gwen hunnicutt brings into dialog ecofeminism and gender violence ideological components such as speciesism and the belief that the earth and its nonhuman inhabitants are ours to exploit inform a host of other social practices including interpersonal violence a portion of this book is devoted to exploring the ways in which patriarchy is foregrounded by another hierarchy human domination over nature thus gender violence stems from a logic of domination that is built on the domination of nature and the domination of the other as nature as this blueprint of oppression repeats itself where there are vectors of difference the chapters ultimately connect these oppressions by showing the inextricable bind of violence against humans and the more than human life world this book will serve as a resource for scholars activists and students in sociology gender violence and interdisciplinary violence studies critical animal studies environmental studies and feminist and ecofeminist studies

this book investigates how the intersection between gendered violence and human rights is depicted and engaged with in african literature and films the rich and multifarious range of film and literature emanating from africa and the diaspora provides a fascinating lens through which we can understand the complex consequences of gendered violence on the lives of women children and minorities contributors to this volume examine the many ways in which gendered violence mirrors expresses projects and articulates the larger phenomenon of human rights violations in africa and the african diaspora and how in turn the discourse of human rights informs the ways in which we articulate interrogate conceptualise and interpret gendered violence in literature and film the book also shines a light on the linguistic contradictions and ambiguities in the articulation of gendered violence in private spaces and war this book will be essential reading for scholars critics feminists teachers and students seeking solid grounding in exploring gendered violence and human rights in theory and practice

examining the prevalent issue of domestic violence this book breaks down the reasons behind the ineffectiveness of existing human rights instruments and the gaps in current legal systems failing those in need through a variety of key case studies it

reveals significant gaps in the legal conceptualisation of domestic violence between human rights standards on the one hand and the national legal systems examined those of Ireland and Lithuania on the other the book reveals that contrary to gender based universal human rights approaches and despite recent legislative reforms the legal concept of domestic violence is gender blind it fails to capture gender based empirical realities on the ground rendering national legal systems devoid of an empirically informed theoretical basis for addressing the problem despite the differences in the contextual backgrounds of the two case study countries the legislation on domestic violence is underpinned by patriarchal beliefs in both this book employs a gender based examination of the issue that will be of key interest to scholars legal practitioners civil society actors and students of feminist legal theory gender equality gender in international law gender and human rights and conceptual democracy

feminist research on gender violence and abuse has been an area of academic study since the late 1970s and has increased exponentially over this time on a global scale although situated in a predominantly qualitative tradition research in the field has developed to include quantitative and mixed methodologies this book offers a compendium of research methods on gender and violence from the traditional to the innovative and showcases best practice in feminist research and international case studies researching gender violence and abuse covers the origins of feminist research ethical considerations relating to research on gender violence and abuse working in partnership with organisations such as the police or the voluntary sector a comprehensive range of research methods including interviews and focus groups surveys arts based research and ethnography the challenges and opportunities of working with existing data the influence of activism on research and the translation of research into policy and practice this book is perfect reading for students taking courses on violence against women domestic violence gender and crime as well as advanced students embarking on new research

domestic violence the various forms it takes and the theories that have been put forward to explain it it takes an historical approach to examine policy and legislative developments over the last forty years and how those developments make themselves manifest today the authors provide an authoritative and critical account of the different agencies and the work they carry out both independently and jointly they also consider the limits of a crime centred response to domestic violence the book provides a conceptual framework in which domestic violence and criminal justice might be better understood it covers all the current issues in this field and it will be a source book in directing readers to further reading it will be essential reading for both students and practitioners in the field

worldwide patterns of violence against women differ markedly from violence against men for example women are more likely than men to be sexually assaulted or killed by someone they know the united nations has defined violence against women as gender based violence to acknowledge that such violence is rooted in gender inequality and is often tolerated and condoned by laws institutions and community norms violence against women is not only a profound violation of human rights but also a costly impediment to a country s national development while gender based violence occurs in many forms throughout the life cycle this review focuses on two of the most common types physical intimate partner violence and sexual violence by any perpetrator unfortunately the knowledge base about effective initiatives to prevent and respond to gender based violence is relatively limited few approaches have been rigorously evaluated even in high income countries and such evaluations involve numerous methodological challenges nonetheless the authors review what is known about more and less effective or at least promising approaches to prevent and respond to gender based violence they present definitions recent statistics health consequences costs and risk factors of gender based violence the authors analyze good practice initiatives in the justice health and education sectors as well as multisectoral approaches for each of these sectors they examine initiatives that have addressed laws and policies institutional reforms community mobilization and individual behavior change strategies finally the authors identify priorities for future research and action including funding research on the health and socioeconomic costs of violence against women encouraging science based program evaluations disseminating evaluation results across countries promoting investment in effective prevention and treatment initiatives and encouraging public private partnerships

violence against women is a violation of women's human rights and a priority public health issue it is endemic worldwide while much has been written about it in industrialized societies there has been relatively little attention given to such violence in asian societies this book addresses the structural and interpersonal violences to which women are subject both under conditions of conflict and disruption and where civil society is relatively ordered it explores sexual violence and coercion domestic violence and violence within the broader community and the state avoiding sensationalised accounts of so called cultural practices in favour of nuanced explorations of violences as experienced in cambodia thailand burma indonesia malaysia the philippines bangladesh and india

while promoting access to resources and systems of support for those affected by gender based violence is absolutely crucial this new book focuses attention on the important question of how communities can take action to prevent violence and abuse using examples of current research and practice the book explores the actions that can be taken in individual sectors of society our schools faith communities campuses on our streets and using new popular technologies the contributors draw on global examples to highlight the importance of learning from the study of the interaction between socio political contexts and effective policies and strategies to address gender based violence chapters take up the challenge of exploring the construction of effective programmes that address cognitive affective and behavioural domains they discuss what people know how they feel and how they behave and include the important challenge of how to engage men in working towards the elimination of gender based violence offering positive messages which build on men's values and predisposition to act in a positive manner importantly such strategies place the responsibility for preventing gender based violence on the society as a whole rather than on vulnerable individuals this book is essential reading for anyone interested in gender studies women's studies social work sociology law and health studies its unique approach focuses on the achievement of prevention at the earliest possible stage and examines the issue through a society wide but community focused lens

using different disciplinary approaches this collection of thoughtful and timely selections focuses on integrating issues related to violence and gender violence and gender enables readers to learn about these complex issues so they can work to lessen the occurrence of violence in their personal and professional lives the introductory section presents a number of theories of violence that ground readers in different

theories and reasons for violent behavior the subsequent sections deal with the topics of gender youth violence domestic violence sexual assault child abuse violence and sports and media representation of violence because of its comprehensive coverage of many issues this book can serve as an excellent resource for sociologists criminologists justice administrators psychologists therapists and those involved in social work

drawing on research from a variety of disciplines this edited collection challenges conventional understandings of gendered interpersonal violence and identifies emerging sites and forms of resistance to it

this book addresses the issue of domestic violence against women drawing on research findings policy developments and current debates to contextualise its alarming prevalence and to propose informed ways of addressing through training and practice the needs of both victims and perpetrators in current social and related care provision

this book offers new perspectives on gender based violence in three regions where the subject has been taboo in everyday discourse often due to patriarchal cultural norms that limit women s autonomy the contributions to this book provide rare insight into not only the levels and the socio demographic determinants of domestic violence but topics ranging from men s attitudes toward wife beating domestic violence related adolescent deaths and women s health problems due to sexual and physical abuse with a comprehensive introduction that provides a comparative international research framework for discussing gender based violence in these three unique regions this volume provides a key basis for understanding gender based violence on a more global level part i on africa covers men s attitudes towards domestic violence the impact of poverty and fertility the association between adolescent deaths and domestic violence and the link between domestic abuse and hiv part ii on the middle east covers the importance of consanguinity on domestic violence in egypt and jordan the effects of physical abuse on reproductive health and the link between political unrests and women s experience and attitudes towards domestic violence part iii on india shows how sexual abuse puts women at risk of reproductive tract infections and sexually transmitted infections as well as the role of gender norms in wife abuse and the role of youth aggressive behavior in nonconsensual sex with such a deep and broad coverage of factors of intimate partner abuse this book serves as a reference document for researchers decision makers and organizations that are searching for ways to reduce



gender based domestic violence this book is of interest for researchers in criminology and criminal justice as well as sociology social work public health and human rights

gender violence and attitudes explores the history of gendered violence in europe particularly spousal violence and sexual violence in the early modern period this book analyses the history of attitudes and practices related to gender and is ideal for students who wish to understand the history of violence in early modern europe

gender based violence is a complex and multifaceted issue and many people even if they do not have direct experience as a victim or perpetrator still have difficulty understanding it initially it is important to recognize that gender based violence is not limited to physical violence it also includes emotional psychological and economic abuse as well as threats and control most cases of gender based violence do not occur due to force but rather due to the desire to control and suppress another person regarding the question of why men commit gender based violence and women remain in such relationships the answers can be multifaceted and depend on the specific situation for example men may use gender based violence to maintain power and control in relationships and women may remain in such relationships due to fear dependency economic vulnerability or cultural and social dynamics gender based violence is a broad and complex social problem that affects many aspects of human life it can manifest itself in various forms and contexts including the family environment social relationships work environment etc it is important to understand that gender based violence is not limited only to physical actions although they often act as one of its manifestations it also includes emotional abuse psychological abuse economic abuse and threats and behavioral control one of the main causes of gender based violence is the desire to control and suppress another person this may occur due to inequalities in power and status between partners as well as cultural and social attitudes that support and reinforce inequality between genders in addition stereotypes about masculinity and femininity can contribute to the emergence and maintenance of gender based violence by creating norms of behavior that justify or normalize such actions it is important to understand that gender based violence can affect all people regardless of their gender age race social status or other characteristics although women make up the majority of victims of gender based violence men can also be victims and this often goes unappreciated or underappreciated in society gender based violence can affect both women and men and people of any gender identity it is important to understand that gender based

violence is not limited to female victims although women and girls make up a significant proportion of victims however men boys and people with other gender identities can also be vulnerable to gender based violence research shows that men can also be victims of gender based violence but the frequency and forms of violence may vary depending on cultural social and other factors gender based violence is a complex and diverse issue that requires attention and support for all victims regardless of their gender identity combating gender based violence requires a systemic approach that includes education and public awareness of the problem strengthening legal and legal responses support for victims and working to change cultural norms and stereotypes about gender working to overcome gender based violence requires the participation of the entire society and efforts at all levels from the personal to the global gender based violence includes a wide range of forms including physical emotional sexual and economic violence as well as threats and controlling behavior it can manifest itself in various areas of life including the family environment social relationships work environment etc in our world where we strive for equality and justice the topic of gender based violence remains one of the most important and relevant gender based violence is not only a physical problem but also a complex socio cultural phenomenon that covers various aspects of human life in our book we will look at this problem in all its manifestations and aspects exploring the various types of violence its causes and consequences as well as ways to overcome and prevent it in the first part we dive into the world of types of gender based violence revealing its multifaceted nature from physical violence to emotional psychological and economic we will look at each type separately analyzing its causes mechanisms of action and consequences for victims in part 2 we delve deeper into the drivers and causes of gender based violence exploring the role of cultural stereotypes social expectations power and control we will conduct research into the personal and psychological factors that contribute to the emergence and maintenance of gender based violence in modern society the third part of our book is dedicated to support for victims of gender based violence we cover primary care safety mental health legal and social support offering readers practical advice and resources to support themselves and those around them in part four we will turn to preventing and combating gender based violence discussing the role of education programs and campaigns working with perpetrators and community engagement in solving this problem the final part of our book will review the main ideas proposed in it and call readers to action we hope that our work will become not only a source of knowledge but also a source of inspiration for those who strive to create a world free of gender based violence we invite you on a

journey through the complex paths of gender based violence where together we will try to understand its nature consequences and ways to overcome it

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
