

Failing Liberty 101

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introduction to critical legal theory provides an accessible introduction to the study of law and legal theory it covers all the seminal movements in classical modern and postmodern legal thought engaging the reader with the ideas of jurists as diverse as aristotle hobbes and kant marx foucault and dworkin at the same time it impresses the interdisciplinary nature of critical legal thought introducing the reader to the philosophy the economics and the politics of law this new edition focuses even more intently upon the narrative aspect of critical legal thinking and the re emergence of a distinctive legal humanism as well as the various related challenges posed by our new world order introduction to critical theory is a comprehensive text for both students and teachers of legal theory jurisprudence and related subjects

even though political philosophy has a long tradition it is much more than the study of old and great treatises contemporary philosophers continue to press new arguments on old and timeless questions but also to propose departures and innovations the field changes over time and new work inevitably responds both to events in the world and to the directions of thought itself this volume includes 22 new pieces by leaders in the field on both perennial and emerging topics of keen interest to contemporary political philosophers in addition to longstanding issues such as authority equality and freedom and democracy there are articles on less classical topics such as race historical injustice deliberation money and politics global justice and ideal and non ideal theory all of the pieces combine clarity and accessibility with a top scholar s critical and original point of view the introductory essay briefly situates this snapshot of the state of the art in a broader view of developments in political philosophy in the last 40 years and looks forward to future developments students and scholars alike will find the pieces to be valuable not only surveys but as provocations to think further about the questions puzzles and practical problems that animate recent work in political philosophy the issues will be of interest to many working in philosophy political science law economics and more

your american yardstick by hamilton abert long is a clear compelling guide to the core principles that have shaped the united states since its founding written in the tense decades of the mid 20th century when ideological conflicts challenged the nation s identity the book distills twelve fundamental american principles into a framework for understanding and preserving the republic long s yardstick serves both as a measure of the country s adherence to its ideals and as a practical tool for citizens seeking to align political action with constitutional values each chapter explores a key principle such as individual liberty equality before the law limited government and the rule of law anchored in historical context and illustrated with examples from america s founding documents jurisprudence and political history long s prose is direct yet thoughtful

aimed at empowering readers to recognize when these principles are upheld and when they are under threat he argues that an informed citizenry is the ultimate safeguard against erosion of freedoms and he offers the yardstick as a means of civic self defense more than a civics primer your american yardstick is a call to intellectual vigilance it urges readers to think critically about political rhetoric policy decisions and cultural trends measuring them against the enduring ideals that have guided the nation in a time when democracy was tested both abroad and at home long provided a reminder that america's greatness depends not on shifting passions but on unwavering adherence to its foundational truths

a man of impressive mental powers of extraordinary intellectual range and last but not least of exceptional integrity george frost kennan 1904 2005 was an adviser to presidents and secretaries of state with a decisive role in the history of this country and of the entire world for a few crucial years in the 1940s after which he was made to retire but then he became a scholar who wrote seventeen books scores of essays and articles and a pulitzer prize winning memoir he also wrote remarkable public lectures and many thousands of incisive letters laying down his pen only in the hundredth year of his life having risen within the american foreign service and been posted to various european capitals and twice to moscow kennan was called back to washington in 1946 where he helped to inspire the truman doctrine and draft the marshall plan among other things he wrote the x or containment article for which he became and still is world famous an article which he regarded as not very important and liable to

misreading john lukacs describes the development and the essence of kennan s thinking the perhaps unavoidable misinterpretations of his advocacies his self imposed task as a leading realist critic during the cold war and the importance of his work as a historian during the second half of his long life

america s founders thought the right to earn a living was so basic and obvious that it didn t need to be mentioned in the bill of rights the right to earn a living charts the history of this fundamental human right from the constitutional system that was designed to protect it by limiting government s powers to the civil war amendments that expanded protection to all americans regardless of race

colonial mississippi a borrowed land offers the first composite of histories from the entire colonial period in the land now called mississippi christian pinnen and charles weeks reveal stories spanning over three hundred years and featuring a diverse array of individuals and peoples from america europe and africa the authors focus on the encounters among these peoples good and bad and the lasting impacts on the region the eighteenth century receives much deserved attention from pinnen and weeks as they focus on the trials and tribulations of mississippi as a colony especially along the gulf coast and in the natchez country the authors tell the story of a land borrowed from its original inhabitants and never returned they make clear how a remarkable diversity characterized the state throughout its early history early encounters and initial contacts involved primarily native americans and spaniards in the first half of the

sixteenth century following the expeditions of columbus and others to the large region of the gulf of mexico more sustained interaction began with the arrival of the french to the region and the establishment of a french post on biloxi bay at the end of the seventeenth century such exchanges continued through the eighteenth century with the british and then again the spanish until the creation of the territory of mississippi in 1798 and then two states mississippi in 1817 and alabama in 1819 though readers may know the bare bones of this history the dates and names this is the first book to reveal the complexity of the story in full to dig deep into a varied and complicated tale

across the nineteenth century european history philology archaeology art and architecture turned from a common classical vocabulary and ideology to images of pasts and origins drawn primarily from the middle ages the result was a paradox as scholars and artists schooled in the same pan european vocabularies and methodologies nevertheless sought to discover through them unique and frequently oppositional national identities these essays edited by patrick j geary and gábor klaniczay focus on this all european phenomenon with a special focus on scandinavia and east central europe bearing witness to the inextricable links between cultural and scientific engagement the search for national identity and political agendas in the long nineteenth century that made the search for archaic origins an entangled history contributors include walter pohl ian wood sverre bagge maciej janowski sir david wilson anders andrén ern marosi carmen popescu ahmet ersoy michael werner joep leerssen r howard bloch pavlína rychterová tommaso di carpegna falconieri stefan detchev florin curta and péter langó

Zelensky demonstrates the central role played by music in shaping and maintaining the Russian émigré diaspora over multiple generations as well as the fundamental paradox underlying this process that music's sustaining power in this case rests on its proclivity to foster collective narratives of an idealized prerevolutionary Russia while often evolving stylistically to remain relevant to its makers listeners and dancers by combining archival research with fieldwork and interviews with Russian émigrés of various generations and emigration waves Zelensky presents a close historical and ethnographic examination of music's potential as an aesthetic discursive and social space through which diasporans can engage with an idea of a mythologized homeland and in turn the vital role played by music in the organization development and reception of Russia abroad
