in the current day and age objective facts have less influence on opinions and decisions than personal emotions and beliefs many individuals rely on their social networks to gather information thanks to social media s ability to share information rapidly and over a much greater geographic range however this creates an overall false balance as people tend to seek out information that is compatible with their existing views and values they deliberately seek out facts and data that specifically support their conclusions and classify any information that contradicts their beliefs as false news navigating fake news alternative facts and misinformation in a post truth world is a collection of innovative research on human and automated methods to deter the spread of misinformation online such as legal or policy changes information literacy workshops and algorithms that can detect fake news dissemination patterns in social media while highlighting topics including

the increase in fake news the growing influence on elections increasing false reports and targeted disinformation campaigns are not least a consequence of advancing digitalisation information technology is needed to put a stop to these undesirable developments with intelligent algorithms and refined data analysis fakes must be detected more quickly in the future and their spread prevented however in order to meaningfully recognize and filter fakes by means of artificial intelligence it must be possible to distinguish fakes from facts facts from fictions and fictions from fakes this book therefore also asks questions about the distinctions of fake factual and fictional the underlying theories of truth are discussed and practical technical ways of differentiating truth from falsity are outlined by considering the fictional as well as the assumption that information technical further development can profit from humanities knowledge the authors hope that content related technical and methodological challenges of the present and future can be overcome

first published in 1943 and revised for this 1952 edition this book was intended for use by students of philosophy and as such traditional and modern developments in logic have been combined in a unified treatment the author envisaged this volume as filling a gap for a simple introductory text on formal logic written from a modern point of view unencumbered by traditional doctrine this title provides a thorough introduction and grounding in the philosophy of logic and was later revised after the author's death to correct a number of logical errors making this edition the most complete version of the work

the very idea of truth as a substantial and meaningful concept has been under attack recently from advocates of new age and postmodern theories in this book englebrechtsen defends the notions of truth and objectivity as key to the scientific view of the natural world and presents an original defence of the commonsense correspondence theory of truth englebrechtsen's approach overcomes the traditional difficulties of correspondence theories of truth with providing adequate and convincing accounts of truth bearers truth makers and the correspondence relation between them by taking truth bearers to be propositions and facts as constitutive properties of the world this accessibly written book surveys all of the major competing theories of truth coherence pragmatic redundancy semantic deflationary disquotational minimalist before formulating the new defence of the correspondence theory and then exploring the consequences of the theory for issues in epistemology and ontology the book concludes by showing how the idea of propositional depth can be used to dissolve the liar paradoxes

first published in 2000 this is volume iii of six in the international library of philosophy looking at the area of nineteenth and twentieth century anglo american philosophy written in 1952 it focuses on bertrand russell's construction of the external world which covers a wide variety of topics attempts to answer many of the problems traditionally associated with philosophy

truth is one of the central concepts in philosophy and has been a perennial subject of study michael glanzberg has brought together 36 leading experts from around the world to produce the definitive guide to philosophical issues to do with truth they consider how the concept of truth has been understood from antiquity to the present day surveying major debates about truth during the emergence of analytic philosophy they offer critical assessments of the standard theories of truth including the coherence correspondence identity and pragmatist theories they explore the role of truth in metaphysics with lively discussion of truthmakers proposition determinacy objectivity deflationism fictionalism relativism and pluralism finally the handbook explores broader applications of truth in philosophy including ethics science and mathematics and reviews formal work on truth

and its application to semantic paradox this oxford handbook will be an invaluable resource across all areas of philosophy

the book introduces the reader to western ethics as a subject along with its three standard subdivisions although the book is written with university students policymakers and professionals in mind the book is lucid enough to be accessible to most adult readers the book begins with introductions to the basics of ethics these chapters are meant to provide the reader with the background knowledge necessary for understanding the more technical chapters on metaethics normative ethics theories and applied ethics the three well known subdivisions within ethics the chapters that follow take up core ethical issues from each of these areas the sections focus on explanation and a critical understanding of the ethical issue the chapters also have examples cases and exercises to encourage critical thinking and to enable the reader to grasp the issue better the book has tried to bring contemporary issues such as ethics of human organ transplantation and contemporary theories such as amartya sen s concept of justice and martha nussbaum s capabilities approach to engage the readers with ethics in the real world the book concludes with applied ethics but with the example of ethics of artificial intelligence the aim is to keep ethics as a future driven activity and to emphasize the need to understand the real world ethical situations and dilemmas that will affect the stakeholders all around the world in the coming years as artificial intelligence and data driven technologies change our everyday life

this book traces the development of formal logic from its origins in ancient greece to the present day the authors first discuss the work of logicians from aristotle to frege showing how they were influenced by the philosophical or mathematical ideas of their time they then examine developments in the present century

the concepts of particular and universal have become so familiar that their significance has become difficult to discern like coins that have been passed back and forth too many times worn smooth so their values can no longer be read on the genealogy of universals seeks to overcome our sense of over familiarity with these concepts by providing a case study of their evolution during the late 19th century and early 20th century a study that shows how the history of these concepts is bound up with the origins and development of analytic philosophy itself understanding how these concepts were taken up transfigured and given up by the early analytic philosophers enables us to recover and reanimate the debate amongst them that otherwise remains delphic to interpret some of the early originating texts of analytic philosophy that have hitherto baffled commentators including moore s early papers to appreciate afresh the neglected contributions of philosophical figures that historians of analytic philosophy have mostly since forgot including stout and whitehead and to shed new light upon the relationships of moore to russell and russell to wittgenstein

first published in 1931 this volume represents the culmination of twenty years of the study on the principles of science noticing a widespread craving for philosophical light at a time of scant such offerings morris r cohen aimed to demonstrate here the fundamental and ancient connection between nature and science between hearts and minds in an attempt to salve the developing mutual hostility between the two in the 1920s the volume bears particular relation to george santayana s life of reason and bertrand russell s principles of mathematics and explores areas including the character of the insurgence against reason and reason in the contexts of the natural and social sciences
