detailed information on real countries and companies as in parts ii to iv and across the board comparisons of major topics as in parts v and vi this book was first published in 1981 until this present edition the fourteenth the book was jointly written by christopher nobes and robert parker however bob parker died shortly after the thirteen edition was published in 2016 this edition is dedicated to his memory see obituaries in the 2016 volumes of accounting and business research and accounting history bob s last publication was a review of the development of the contents of this book and therefore of the world of international accounting over its thirteen editions from 1981 onwards readers can consult this in volume 21 issue 4 of accounting history

companies with mulitnational activities and funding are increasingly attached to the possibility of preparing financial statements in accordance to international accounting standards rather than national standards this text aims to provide support for accountants on preparing financial statements in accordance with international accounting standards by giving concise and practical advice it should assist readers in understanding the theory of international accounting standards and how to apply them

international accounting harmonization analyzes the differences between national accounting rules and international accounting methods showing that when firms adopt international accounting standards they achieve significantly higher positive coefficients compared with firms that only take on local accounting strategies

the authors present international accounting within the context of managing multinational enterprises the book focuses on how accounting applies to global strategies and identifies the key accounting issues that influence decision making
