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as the words flow is a collection of poems that speak to the human experience by sharing my own in a time where i thought no one was listening or would ever understand me i began to write i wrote to ease my mind soothe my broken heart and to show sides of me most don t get to see with hopes of inspiring the next person as a result this book was created these are my words and they have a way of lingering

the allegory as a literary device is too often dismissed as being artificial and contrived yet one scholar admits that an allegory arises spontaneously when a writer allows a symbolic traveller make one step towards a symbolic mountain therefore the resultant allegory cannot be subject to the writer s

full control and conscious powers of prediction and determination it has a life of its own

smiling vocally is a collection of spoken word unorthodox poetry from contemporary self proclaimed beatnik dwayne golson starting as a private journal topics range from traditional love poems to text messaging rants designed for the non poetry reader to the literary enthusiast

the poetry book is more than a collection of poems it is instructive as to poetic technique and convention as well as types of poetry in it there are no prose paragraphs that have been restructured into stanzas or mysteriously configured and presented as poems with diction and subject little more interesting than closed garage doors in a tract home subdivision there is free verse here and traditional rhythm and rhyme but it is all poetry and it is poetry not because the author wants it to be but because of the poetic techniques and conventions he has employed a stanza does not a poem make nor does bombastic delivery if the traditions rules of writing and conventions of literary history are of no value to poetry then there is no poetry
