this book explores the rich history of voluntary action in the united kingdom over the past 100 years through the lens of the national council for voluntary organisations ncvo which celebrates its centenary in 2019 from its establishment at the end of the first world war through the creation of the welfare state in the middle of the twentieth century to new labour and the big society at the beginning of this century ncvo has been at the forefront of major developments within society and the voluntary movement the book examines its many successes including its role in establishing high profile charities such as age concern the youth hostels association and national association of citizens advice bureaux it charts the development of closer relations with the state resulting in growing awareness of the value of voluntary action increased funding and beneficial changes to public policy tax and charity law but it also explores the criticisms ncvo has faced in particular that by pursuing a partnership agenda and championing professionalisation it has contributed to an erosion of the movement s independence and distinctiveness

volunteering and voluntary organizations have become increasingly important in british social and political life but at a cost greater prominence has led to a narrow and distorted view of what voluntary action involves and how it is undertaken this book reasserts the case for a broader view of voluntarism as a unique set of autonomous activities

draws on a range of empirical studies of aspects of the history of voluntary action this title includes chapters that range across two centuries and a variety of fields of activity geographical areas and organisational forms

this volume explores the world of grassroots organizations and outlines their history while differentiating them from the more familiar paid staff nonprofit organizations david horton smith a leading scholar on the nonprofit and voluntary sector examines the available empirical research on the topic and analyzes the theoretical concepts that have come to define such associations he affords the reader a complete detailed description of the nature and characteristics of grassroots organizations their formation structure leadership life cycle effectiveness and their integral role in postmodern societies

there are great expectations of voluntary action in contemporary britain but limited in depth insight into the level distribution and understanding of what constitutes voluntary activity drawing on extensive survey data and written accounts of citizen engagement this book charts change and continuity in voluntary activity since 1981 how voluntary action has been defined and measured is considered alongside individuals accounts of their participation and engagement in volunteering over their lifecourses addressing fundamental questions such as whether the public are cynical about or receptive to calls for greater voluntary action the book considers

whether respective government expectations of volunteering can really be fulfilled is Britain really a shared society or a big society and what is the scope for expansion of voluntary effort this pioneering study combines rich qualitative material from the mass observation archive between 1981 and 2012 and data from many longitudinal and cross sectional social surveys part of the third sector research series this book is informed by research undertaken at the third sector research centre funded by the economic and social research council and Barrow Cadbury Trust

overview of the voluntary sector its history importance and current responsibilities practical guidance and analysis of issues facing voluntary sector including its legal framework in UK and EU fundraising management and accountability

Between Work and Leisure aims to debunk the prevailing myth that work and leisure are separate and mutually antagonistic spheres of life Stebbins shows that a close relationship between leisure and work is positive offering people the possibility of finding joy in work just as they do in leisure occupational devotion as Stebbins defines it is a strong and positive attachment to a form of self enhancing work where the sense of achievement is high and the core activity or set of tasks is endowed with such intense appeal that the line between work and leisure is virtually erased this volume examines conditions that attract people to their work in this profound way and the many exceptional values and intrinsic rewards they realize there Stebbins frames occupational devotion in four broad social contexts history religion work and leisure and then considers the further subdivisions of gender social class and social character the heart of the book uses research findings on leisure to develop a powerful critique of those who describe deeply felt commitment to work as workaholic behavior he also examines what happens when money becomes a dominant factor in work and the social implications of the compatibility of work and serious leisure using exploratory research to identify their shared motivational factors

this book is an in depth analysis of the educational development of tribals in india education as development deprivation poverty dispossession is a significant new addition for understanding educational and economic setbacks experienced by the marginalized in india the volume focuses on how the social economic and education systems have evolved over time in india and identifies the scope of development in these areas provides a rational structure for readers to understand how the adivasi in india can be made to fit in the modern designed education system highlights the problems of the marginalized such as income inequality education health housing governance civil society environment and infrastructure and others which hamper their overall growth this book will be of great interest to students researchers and policy makers in the fields of education minority studies indigenous studies sociology of education and south asian studies

this book unveils women s empowerment as mothers as a notion in the school system that reinforces patriarchy rather than weakening it it discusses how empowerment is a contested notion even though it is mostly praised in terms of women s emancipation this book explores the concept that although women are breastfeeding education as mothers in the neoliberal education system they are not necessarily doing so as a self sacrifice as one may generalize in the context of neoliberal economy instead this book argues that women are doing this as a means of investment for gaining a sense of individual power which ironically reinforces patriarchal values it presents demonstrative and descriptive practical incidences in the field

the idea that international development aid needs to be better managed and coordinated gained currency in the early 1990s the increasing emphasis on management has resulted in the present vogue of managing for development results as one of the central tenets in the discourse on international aid but how appropriate are these ideas tools and techniques for non governmental development organizations ngos and how much does geographic context matter examining the current debate on aid effectiveness and the role of ngos in contributing to it this book highlights the critical importance of understanding how the global and the local interact to increase aid efficacy and develop more culturally astute ways of managing ngos with a focus on ngos active in sub saharan africa as case studies author frederik claeys demonstrates that ngos are not mere passive recipients of management knowledge and practices emanating from the global governance structure of international aid but actively engage with these ideas and practices to translate and rework them through a local cultural lens this process results in the emergence of unique hybrid management systems that combine the pressure to become more business like with the mission to satisfy the demands of the communities they serve

analysing the potential and problems in establishing institutional framework the contributors present experiences of ngos providing details of their organisation objectives developmental activities number of villages covered and the number of groups formed they also discuss the strategies adopted in establishing interface and problems that ngos as well as the people encountered in the process

today it is impossible to separate discussion of poverty from the priorities of state welfare a hundred years ago most working class households avoided or coped with poverty without recourse to the state the poor law after 1834 offered little more than a safety net for the poorest and much welfare was organised through charitable societies self help institutions and mutual aid networks rather than look for the origins of modern provision the author casts a searching light on the practices ideology and outcomes of nineteenth century welfare this original and stimulating study based upon a wealth of scholarship is essential reading for all students of poverty and welfare it also contains much to interest a wider readership

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
