through archival work and storytelling musical migration and imperial new york revises many inherited narratives about experimental music and art in postwar new york from the urban street level of music clubs and arts institutions to the world making routes of global migration and exchange this book redraws the map of experimental art to reveal the imperial dynamics and citizenship struggles that continue to shape music in the united states beginning with the material conditions of power that structured the cityscape of new york in the early cold war years brigid cohen looks at a wide range of artistic practices concert music electronic music jazz performance art and actors edgard var[?] se charles mingus yoko ono and fluxus founder george maciunas as they experimented with new modes of creativity cohen links them with other migrant creators vital to the city s postwar culture boom creators whose stories have seldom been told halim el dabbh michiko toyama vladimir ussachevsky she also gives sustained and serious treatment to the work of yoko ono something long overdue in music scholarship musical migration and imperial new york is indispensable reading offering a new understanding of global avant gardes and american experimental music as well as the contrasting feelings of belonging and exclusion on which they were built

where did the major scale come from why does most traditional non western music not share western principles of harmony what does the inner structure of a canon have to do with religious belief why in historical terms is j s bach s music regarded as a perfect combination of melody and harmony why do clocks in church towers strike dominant tonic dominant tonic what do cathedrals have to do with monochords how can the harmonic series be demonstrated with a rope tied to a doorknob and how can it be heard by standing next to an electric fan why are the free ocean waves in debussy s la mer the turbulent river waves in smetana s moldau and the fountain ripples in ravel s jeux d eau pushed at times into four bar phrases why is the metric system inherently unsuitable for organizing music and poetry in what way does plato s timaeus resemble the prelude to wagner s das rheingold just how does beethoven s work perfectly illustrate fully functional tonality and why were long range works based on this type of tonality impossible before the introduction of equal temperament

in this new century what promising materials are available to composers in the wake of harmonic experimentation and some would argue exhaustion the answers to these seemingly complicated questions are not the sole province of music professors or orchestra conductors in fact as eugene helm demonstrates they can just as easily be explained to amateurs and their answers are important if we are to understand how western music works the full range of western music is explored through 21 concise chapters on such topics as melody harmony counterpoint texture melody types improvisation music notation free imitation canon and fugue vibration and its relation to harmony tonality and the place of music in architecture and astronomy intended for amateurs and professionals concert goers and conductors helm offers in down to earth language an explanation of the foundations of our western music heritage deepening our understanding and the listening experience of it for all

the non jazz improvisation series is a concept that germinated in dick weissman s mind while he was attending music school he wrote a 15 piece arrangement of the old square dance tune cripple creek and wanted the trombone to take a solo as part of the arrangement when the trombonist kept playing a bebop solo that was totally unsuitable for the chart dick realized that in addition to the many musicians who do not improvise there are even jazz musicians who don t know how to improvise outside the limits of their own stylistic backgrounds the non jazz improvisation series mostly includes new original tunes that are intended to show how to improvise in many musical styles including bluescountryamerican folklatin americanworld music including south american eastern european and asianodd meters playing in a variety of time signatures new ageclassicalfolk rockin short the books are an encyclopedia of virtually every musical style excluding jazz
