in 1993 the u s department of defense declassified information dealing with frequent explosions in the upper atmosphere caused by meteoric impact it is estimated that impacts have occurred of a magnitude equivalent to the atomic bomb detonated at hiroshima not all such space voyagers meet their end in the atmosphere however huge craters attest to the bombardment of earth over millions of years and a major impact may have resulted in the extinction of dinosaurs an impact in siberia near the beginning of this century proves that such events are not confined to geologic time hazards due to comets and asteroids marks a significant step in the attempt to come to grips with the threats posed by such phenomena it brings together more than one hundred scientists from around the world who draw on observational and theoretical research to focus on the technical problems related to all aspects of dealing with these hazards searching for and identifying hazardous comets and asteroids describing their statistics and characteristics intercepting and altering the orbits of dangerous objects and applying existent technologies rocket boosters rendezvous and soft landing techniques instrumentation to such missions the book considers defensive options for diverting or disrupting an approaching body including solar sails kinetic energy impacts nuclear explosives robotic mass drivers and various propulsion systems a cataclysmic impact posing a threat to life on earth is a possibility that tomorrow s technology is capable of averting this book examines in depth the reality of the threat and proposes practical measures that can be initiated now should we ever need to deal with it

methods in astrodynamics and celestial mechanics is a collection of technical papers presented at the astrodynamics specialist conference held in monterey california on september 16 17 1965 under the auspices of the american institute of aeronautics and astronautics and institute of navigation the conference provided a forum for tackling some of the most interesting applications of the methods of celestial mechanics to problems of space engineering comprised of 19 chapters this volume first treats the promising area of motion around equilibrium configurations following a discussion on limiting orbits at the equilateral centers of libration the reader is introduced to the asymptotic expansion technique and its application to trajectories asymptotic representations for solutions to the differential equations of satellite theory are considered the last two sections deal with orbit determination and mission analysis and optimization in astrodynamics error equations of inertial navigation as applied to orbital determination and guidance are evaluated along with parameter hunting procedures and nonlinear optimal control problems with control appearing linearly this book will be useful to practitioners in the fields of aeronautics astronautics and astrophysics

july 29 2116 that s the day the vested interests back on earth the corporate heads the union bosses the political heavyweights woke up and smelled the methane mars is no longer a convenient and dependable revenue source a cost plus project funded by the taxpayers it s a competitor the alliance a partnership of convenience between the western nations is engaged in a planet wide struggle with the islamic republic of the mediterranean they re holding their own but it s a precarious alliance at best and the last thing they need is a brash young competitor like mars upsetting the complex web of obligations that keeps the member nations together better they quickly squish the martian upstarts like a bug so that they can get back to fighting each other mars doesn t see it that way well at least some people on mars don t and they re prepared to defend their interests by force somehow a simple commercial transaction threatens to precipitate a civil war on mars a shooting war between mars and earth and a world war back on earth possibly all at the same time can anyone unravel this find some way to get everyone to sit in the corner and think about what they have done and if not will anyone survive

the revisions of both dsm iv and icd 10 have again focused the interest of the field of psychiatry and clinical psychology on the issue of nosology this interest has been further heightened by a series of controversies associated with the development of dsm 5 including the fate of proposed revisions of the personality disorders bereavement and the autism spectrum major debate arose within the dsm process about the criteria for changing criteria leading to the creation of first the scientific review committee and then a series of other oversight committees which weighed in on the final debates on the most controversial proposed additions to dsm 5 providing important influences on the final decisions contained within these debates were a range of conceptual and philosophical issues some of these such as the definition of mental disorder or the problems of psychiatric epidemics have been with the field for a long time others the concept of epistemic iteration as a framework for the introduction of nosologic change are quite new this book reviews issues within psychiatric nosology from clinical historical and particularly philosophical perspectives the book brings together a range of distinguished authors including major psychiatric researchers clinicians historians and especially nosologists including several leaders of the dsm 5 effort and the dsm steering committee it also includes contributions from psychologists with a special interest in psychiatric nosology and philosophers with a wide range of orientations the book is organized into four major sections the first explores the nature of psychiatric illness and the way in which it is defined including clinical and psychometric perspectives the second section examines problems in the reification of psychiatric diagnostic criteria the problem of psychiatric epidemics and

the nature and definition of individual symptoms the third section explores the concept of epistemic iteration as a possible governing conceptual framework for the revision efforts for official psychiatric nosologies such as dsm and icd and the problems of validation of psychiatric diagnoses the book ends by exploring how we might move from the descriptive to the etiologic in psychiatric diagnoses the nature of progress in psychiatric research and the possible benefits of moving to a living document or continuous improvement model for psychiatric nosologic systems the result is a book that captures the dynamic cross disciplinary interactions that characterize the best work in the philosophy of psychiatry

climate change is real and extreme weather events are its physical manifestations these extreme events affect how we live and work in cities and subsequently the way we design plan and govern them taking action for the environment is not only a moral imperative instead it is activated by our everyday experience in the city based on the author s site visits and interviews in darwin australia tulsa oklahoma cleveland ohio and cape town south africa this book tells the story of how cities can lead a transformative pro environment politics national governments often fail to make binding agreements that bring about radical actions for the environment this book shows how cities as local sites of mobilizing a collective political agenda can be frontiers for activating the kind of environmental politics that appreciates the role of nature in the everyday functioning of our urban life

the book offers an in depth analysis of several important theories of social class and stratification both past and present this critique is underpinned by a single coherent analytic framework organised around the notion of ownership this original approach allows the book to offer alternative treatments of the issues dealt with by the thinkers discussed here the central argument here is that there are only two classical theories of social class namely those developed by marx and weber and this clear systematisation of the main attributes of approaches to class and stratification makes it possible to see that many theories traditionally considered as class ones refer in fact to social stratification

this book is a step by step guide for improving student learning in higher education the authors argue that a fundamental obstacle to improvement is that higher educators administrators and assessment professionals do not know how to improve student learning at scale by this they mean improvement efforts that span an entire program affecting all affiliated students the authors found that faculty and administrators particularly struggle to conceptualize and implement multi section multi course improvement efforts it is unsurprising that ambitious wide reaching improvement efforts like these would pose difficulty in their organization and implementation this is precisely the problem the authors address the book provides practical strategies for learning improvement enabling faculty to collaborate and integrating leadership social dynamics curriculum pedagogy assessment and faculty development in chapter 2 the authors tell a program level improvement story from the perspective of a faculty member chapter 3 inverts chapter 2 beginning from the re assess stage the authors work their way back to the individual faculty member first pondering whether she can do something to impact students skills they peel back each layer of the process and imagine how learning improvement efforts might be thwarted at each stage chapters 4 through 9 dig deeper into the learning improvement steps introduced in chapters 2 and 3 each chapter provides strategies to help higher educators climb each step successfully chapter 10 paints a picture of what higher education could look like in 2041 if learning improvement were embraced and finally chapter 11 describes what you can do to support the movement

an insider s look at the science of near earth comets and asteroids of all the natural disasters that could befall us only an earth impact by a large comet or asteroid has the potential to end civilization in a single blow yet these near earth objects also offer tantalizing clues to our solar system s origins and someday could even serve as stepping stones for space exploration in this book donald yeomans introduces readers to the science of near earth objects its history applications and ongoing quest to find near earth objects before they find us in its course around the sun the earth passes through a veritable shooting gallery of millions of nearby comets and asteroids one such asteroid is thought to have plunged into our planet sixty five million years ago triggering a global catastrophe that killed off the dinosaurs yeomans provides an up to date and accessible guide for understanding the threats posed by near earth objects and also explains how early collisions with them delivered the ingredients that made life on earth possible he shows how later impacts spurred evolution allowing only the most adaptable species to thrive in fact we humans may owe our very existence to objects that struck our planet yeomans takes readers behind the scenes of today s efforts to find track and study near earth objects he shows how the same comets and asteroids most likely to collide with us could also be mined for precious natural resources like water and oxygen and used as watering holes and fueling stations for expeditions to mars and the outermost reaches of our solar system

the idea of having a conference in padova describing the results obtained by the galileo spacecraft and the characteristics of the telescopio nazionale galileo began in 1995 when a number of colleagues from both sides of the atlantic began exchanging suggestions and ideas looking at the schedules of the two teams it was clear that the beginning of january 1997 would be a good time to hold the conference these dates also luckily coincided with the dates of the memorable discovery of the medicean moons of jupiter by galileo galilei in padova in 1610 to emphasize these three elements the name of the conference was then proposed and accepted by the involved parties nasa and jpl in the united states the german space agency dara the university of padova and the astronomical observatory in padova i wish to recall a few key dates in january 1610 galileo from his house in padova had the first hint of three and then four stars connected to jupiter in december 1995 the probe released from the spacecraft

entered the atmosphere of jupiter and the spacecraft entered orbit about jupiter these extraordinary events were followed at jpl by a number of representatives of many institutions and space agencies in june 1996 the telescopio nazionale galileo was inaugurated by the king of spain juan carlos i in the presence of prof luigi berlinguer minister of university and science these ceremonies occurred as the spacecraft started touring the moon europa
