the legendary achievements of babe ruth and lou gehrig are undeniable hallmarks of baseball history much has been written about the two men as teammates but ruth and gehrig s relationship away from the field is rarely if ever explored in gehrig and the babe tony castro portrays ruth and gehrig for what they were american icons who were remarkably different men for the first time readers will learn about a friendship driven apart an enduring feud which wove its way in and out of their yankees glory years and chilled their interactions until july 4 1939 lou gehrig day at yankee stadium when gehrig s famous farewell address thawed out their stone silence

recounts the life of the hall of fame ballplayer whose career was cut short by the disease now commonly called after him in a portrait that shares details about his rivalry with babe ruth the onset of his illness and the final years of his life

when lou gehrig stepped to the plate on independence day 1939 he was not there to deliver a home run for the first time in seventeen years gehrig was there to deliver his heart in recent weeks he had lost his job as the yankees first baseman as well as the good health that had made him the team s respected iron horse and was facing a death sentence nervous and fidgety as he walked through a forest of microphones gehrig collected himself and delivered thirteen words that will live forever today i consider myself the luckiest man on the face of the earth bronx epitaph the first comprehensive look at the slugger s epic speech is the story of lou gehrig s finest hour a homily of so little consequence when first delivered that few newspapers published more than a sentence or two the following day over time however gehrig s luckiest man speech has settled into a sphere so timeless and essential that it seems he delivered it only yesterday it was to be sure his bronx epitaph

the history of the united states has been characterized by fervent idealism intense struggle and radical change and for every critical defining moment in american history there were those whose impassioned voices rang out clear and true and whose words compelled the minds and hearts of all who heard them when patrick henry declared give me liberty or give me death when martin luther king jr said i have a dream americans listened and were profoundly affected these speeches stand today as testaments to this great nation made up of individuals with bold ideas and unshakeable convictions the american heritage book of great american speeches for young people includes over 100 speeches by founding fathers patriots native american and african american leaders abolitionists women s suffrage and labor activists writers athletes and

others from all walks of life featuring inspiring and unforgettable speeches by such notable speakers as Patrick Henry, Thomas Jefferson, Tecumseh, Frederick Douglass, Sojourner Truth, Abraham Lincoln, Susan B. Kennedy, Martin Luther King Jr. These are the voices that shaped our history; they are powerful, moving, and above all else uniquely American.

In *Game of My Life*, 20 stories of Yankees baseball everyone from stars to supersubs offers personal stories revealing the obstacles they had to overcome in order to succeed on sports' biggest stage. Some of the biggest names to ever don the pinstripes are captured in personal portraits here, from Derek Jeter and Mariano Rivera to Don Mattingly, Reggie Jackson, Ron Guidry, and all the way back to Yogi Berra and Tommy Henrich. The first Yankee to grow up dreaming of the big ballpark in the Bronx, along with taking readers behind the scenes of the greatest moments in Yankees history from Bucky Dent's home run to David Wells's perfect game, the book offers a glimpse of what helped the stars reach their peak. Jorge Posada made up for the dream his father lost as a political prisoner in Cuba; Ron Guidry hunted from the time he was a boy to help his hard-working father put food on the table; Mel Stottlemyre, who lost a son to leukemia, picked a seemingly meaningless regular season game because his boys didn't think he could do it; Joe Torre first started organizing games in the park as he took refuge from his bully of a father. Don Mattingly recounts the thrill of proving he could perform on the October stage and the decision to walk away from the game without a World Series ring so he could spend time with his family. Reggie Jackson details his difficulty in adjusting to the Yankees from his battles with Billy Martin to his eventual triumph in making World Series history. Award-winning writer Dave Buscema, who covers the Yankees on a regular basis, paints a personal picture of the Yankees' biggest stars and captures the joy of those who rose from obscurity to history. The game accounts spark memories of the most exciting moments in Yankees history; the players' personal stories show that for many of them, the game of my life was often about more than just a game.

Written in a personal, moving, and humorous style, *The Last Days of Shea* chronicles the New York Mets from October 2006, when the team lost the National League Championship Series, to October 2008, when the team began to dismantle its antiquated, inadequate, and dearly loved Shea Stadium. The book is about following a baseball team with one's heart, mind, and soul; it represents the experience of being in a crowd at a ballpark, following a pennant race, enduring an off-season, experiencing streaks, slumps, triumph, and heartbreak. All of this is represented against the imminent destruction of a stadium that is not likely to be replaced as well as the perfect and profitable Little Park that will replace it.

there is a long standing relationship between broadcasting and sports and nowhere is this more evident than in the marriage of baseball and radio a slow sport perfectly suited to the word painting of broadcasters this work covers the development of the baseball broadcasting industry from the first telegraph reports of games in progress the influence of early pioneers at pittsburgh s kdka and chicago s wgn including the first world series broadcast the launch of the telstar satellite the carlton fisk homerun in the 1975 world series which changed how baseball is broadcast through the latest computer graphics hd television and the internet

oftentimes people look at famous individuals and think that such people are exempt from the physical limitations that bind us all as humans unfortunately many times celebrities themselves think this is true a stark reminder of this is the effects of substance misuse that have claimed the lives of too many young otherwise healthy luminaries in the prime of their lives this book provides a background on each disorder or disease and in so doing shows the real humanity of the individual such is the case with baseball icon lou gehrig who was newly diagnosed with als but truthfully believed that he was still the luckiest man on the face of the earth little known facts are provided which enables the reader to feel like the subject has come alive as a real fleshandblood person from the pages of a history book a never before seen letter from general george patton is presented in this letter general patton describes the author s uncle as brave why did patton have a near obsession with bravery both that of his soldiers and himself was it because of the fear and humiliation which patton himself spent a lifetime overcoming as a result of his dyslexia

rich marazzi has experienced yankee history and its culture first hand as a fan a writer for yankees magazine a radio talk show host umpire in the old timer s day game for 16 years a writer for mel allen the long time voice of the yankees and currently as a baseball rules consultant who was hired by general manager brian cashman in 2004 he was also trained by bob sheppard as a back up to the legendary yankee stadium public address announcer in this book marazzi takes the reader inside yankee baseball by covering life in the press box the dugout the clubhouse the umpire s room and more he compiles untold yankee stories culled from interviews of many of the yankee greats over the last seven decades including mickey mantle yogi berra phil rizzuto don mattingly derek jeter and more

featuring every relevant team record statistic and award winner from the new york yankees incredible past this book includes a comprehensive collection of all time leaders in every conceivable category from hits to strikeouts from the team s 27 world series titles and roger maris s 61 home runs to joe dimaggio s 56 game hitting streak and eyewitness accounts of when babe ruth famously called his shot this reference captures

the legends and lore of the yankees more than a collection of statistics this guide provides profiles of the men behind the records and explores the context in which they were set while featuring stories which in many cases are even more fascinating than the actual records historical game details and evocative photographs blend with compelling statistics and the great players responsible for them to capture the rich history of this storied and celebrated franchise

i consider myself the luckiest man on the face of the earth on july 4 1939 baseball great lou gehrig delivered what has been called baseball s gettysburg address at yankee stadium and gave a speech that included the phrase that would become legendary he died two years later and his fiery widow eleanor wanted nothing more than to keep his memory alive with her forceful will she and the irascible producer samuel goldwyn quickly agreed to make a film based on gehrig s life the pride of the yankees goldwyn didn t understand or care about baseball for him this film was the emotional story of a quiet modest hero who married a spirited woman who was the love of his life and after a storied career gave a short speech that transformed his legacy with the world at war and soldiers dying on foreign soil it was the kind of movie america needed using original scrips letters memos and other rare documents richard sandomir tells the behind the scenes story of how a classic was born there was the so called scarlett o hara like search to find the actor to play gehrig the stunning revelations elanor made to the scriptwriter paul gallico about her life with lou the intensive training cooper underwent to learn how to catch throw and hit a baseball for the first time and the story of two now legendary hollywood actors in gary cooper and teresa wright whose nuanced performances endowed the gehrigs with upstanding dignity and cemented the baseball icon s legend sandomir writes with great insight and aplomb painting a fascinating portrait of a bygone hollywood era a mourning widow with a dream and the shadow a legend cast on one of the greatest sports films of all time
