ghosts of glencoe is a riveting multi generational adventure of self discovery the novel spans a mere four months set at a unique junior boarding school and played out in the rugged adirondack mountains of new york this is a hero s journey for two flawed protagonists one fifteen the other sixty three both struggle to be accountable to themselves and to those who love them for their hubris betrayals for the shadows they created and still carry in their
