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from autism and mutism to an enlivened self explores the importance of intimacy interaction with the environment and the mind body connection in early childhood development with specific reference to autism built around a detailed case study of a severely autistic

child the book offers an illuminating account of the development and successful treatment of autism both from the perspective of the clinician and from the family in part i diana thielst writing under a pseudonym gives a description of her experience with her daughter who was autistic at birth minimally verbal at age five and did not respond to her name she details the severe family stress and her ineffectual attempts to get professional help finally she hears of consultants who may be able to help in st petersburg russia guided by the consultants thielst and her daughter then embark on a uniquely innovative method for anna to both build a vocabulary and for the first time learn the value of coordinated and cooperative effort armed with a vocabulary and a long history of solo pursuits of organizing inanimate objects anna suddenly begins to explore human interaction as revealed in comics a turning on to an emotional life of relatedness and intimacy in part ii joseph d lichtenberg uses his knowledge of neonate and early infancy to offer the reader an understanding of autism its history and a unique comparison of the normal well adapted neonate and infant at one year with the disrupted development of the child with autism lichtenberg s theoretical construct of three major pathways to a healthy adapted development breaks new theoretical ground and gives enrichment to a contemporary portrayal of the autistic experience with unusually rich clinical material grounded in accessible theory the authors jointly offer a new perspective on understanding treating and living with autism from autism and mutism to an enlivened self will appeal to psychoanalysts psychoanalytic psychotherapists and clinicians working with autistic children

no holding back tells the story of john anderson s 1980 presidential campaign anderson gave up a safe seat in the house of representatives a position in the republican leadership and a likely nomination for a senate seat to run what every expert considered a hopeless race for the gop presidential nomination anderson did so because he was disturbed by many of the same trends in american politics that still exist today the proliferation of special interests gridlock on capitol hill and the unwillingness of his fellow politicians to speak honestly about the critical issues facing the nation more than anything anderson wanted to make a statement about how candidates ought to run for office by rejecting quick fix solutions being candid on where one stood on matters of policy and not sugarcoating the problems that faced voters anderson ran as a kind of anti candidate he had a unique campaigning style and offered proposals that differed greatly from the standard republican viewpoint people found him refreshingly direct and different as interest turned to the campaign he attracted widespread media attention he performed beyond expectations in the first round of primaries and soon switched to an independent candidacy by june he was running at 26 in a three way race against jimmy carter and ronald reagan against the backdrop of runaway inflation the iranian hostage situation a debilitating energy crisis and a discredited incumbent president pollsters found him winning unprecedented support but during the summer troubled by ballot access problems financial issues institutional obstacles and management difficulties anderson s polling totals began to fall once it became clear that he would not win his support collapsed and he limped to a 7 finish this final result has greatly undermined the importance of this campaign it has influenced numerous future candidates and changed the way many politicians would run for office his was the first candidacy to expose how
