this book is the first comprehensive analysis of transport efficiency in china it presents a series of rigorous empirical analysis for the operation and environmental efficiencies of major transport sectors including highway railway civil aviation and waterway it also evaluates transport safety of china the book innovatively employs a dea model based on epsilon measures ebm to evaluate transport efficiency and an ebm dea model with undesirable outputs to calculate transport environmental efficiency the factors of transport efficiency are quantitatively studied including economic growth social transition and technology changes also china s policies aimed at improving transportation efficiency are evaluated the theoretical analyses and discussions would enhance our existing knowledge of the changes and determinants of transport system s efficiency in a context of rapid urbanization industrialization and marketization in china the findings of the existing policy evaluation would bring fresh evidences for transport policy performances to both scholars and politicians in particular it shows policymakers the experiences or lessons of how to create an efficient transport system in order to save energy use reduce ghgs emissions and improve social security this book is of great interest to scholars interested in sustainable transport regional planning and development environmental policy and is relevant to china and other developing countries

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the american economy faces two deep problems expanding innovation and raising the rate of quality job creation both have roots in a neglected problem the resistance of legacy economic sectors to innovation while the u s has focused its policies on breakthrough innovations to create new economic frontiers like information technology and biotechnology most of its economy is locked into legacy sectors defended by technological economic political social

paradigms that block competition from disruptive innovations that could challenge their models americans like to build technology covered wagons and take them out west to open new innovation frontiers we don't head our wagons back east to bring innovation to our legacy sectors by failing to do so the economy misses a major opportunity for innovation which is the bedrock of u s competitiveness and its standard of living technological innovation in legacy sectors uses a new unifying conceptual framework to identify the shared features underlying structural obstacles to innovation in major legacy sectors energy air and auto transport the electric power grid buildings manufacturing agriculture health care delivery and higher education and develops approaches to understand and transform them it finds both strengths and obstacles to innovation in the national innovation environments a new concept that combines the innovation system and the broader innovation context for a group of asian and european economies manufacturing is a major legacy sector that presents a particular challenge because it is a critical stage in the innovation process by increasingly offshoring production the u s is losing important parts of its innovation capacity innovate here produce here where the u s took all the gains of its strong innovation system at every stage is being replaced by innovate here produce there which threatens to lead to produce there innovate there to bring innovation to legacy sectors authors william bonvillian and charles weiss recommend that policymakers focus on all stages of innovation from research through implementation they should fill institutional gaps in the innovation system and take measures to address structural obstacles to needed disruptive innovations in the specific case of advanced manufacturing the production ecosystem can be recreated to reverse jobless innovation and add manufacturing led innovation to the u s s still strong research oriented innovation system

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russia's use of its vast energy resources for leverage against post soviet states such as ukraine is widely recognized as a threat yet we cannot understand this danger without also understanding the opportunity that russian energy represents from corruption related profits to transportation fee income to subsidized prices many within these states have benefited by participating in russian energy exports to understand russian energy power in the region it is necessary to look at the entire value chain including production processing transportation and marketing and at the full spectrum of domestic and external actors involved from gazprom to regional oligarchs to european union regulators this book follows russia's three largest fossil fuel exports natural gas oil and coal from production in

siberia through transportation via ukraine to final use in germany in order to understand the tension between energy as threat and as opportunity margarita m balmaceda reveals how this dynamic has been a key driver of political development in post soviet states in the period between independence in 1991 and russia s annexation of crimea in 2014 she analyzes how the physical characteristics of different types of energy by shaping how they can be transported distributed and even stolen affect how each is used not only technically but also politically both a geopolitical travelogue of the journey of three fossil fuels across continents and an incisive analysis of technology s role in fossil fuel politics and economics this book offers new ways of thinking about energy in eurasia and beyond

karl marx hypothesized that there is a long term tendency for the profit rate to fall in capitalist economies immanuel wallerstein hypothesized that capitalist development tends to drive up labor cost material cost and taxation cost this book evaluates marx s and wallerstein s hypotheses by studying the long term movement of the profit rate and contributing factors in major capitalist economies during the twentieth century leading capitalist economies largely succeeded in stabilizing the profit rate however the current decline of the profit rate in china may precipitate the global capitalist economy into a new major crisis as economic growth slows down in all major capitalist economies marx s original hypothesis may be verified by the global economic events in the twenty first century

in the quarter century since its emergence from military rule and integration into the global economy bangladesh s economy has achieved high growth reduced aid dependence and made remarkable improvement in social indicators while at the same time it continues to suffer from increasing inequality this book analyses these successes and failures

this publication examines the major policy challenges achievements and next steps for the creation of a more entrepreneurial population and a stronger sme sector in the russian federation

bangladesh has transformed its economy over the last 2 decades graduating to middle income status as average annual growth remained strong at 5.6 the country s goal to become an upper middle income country by 2021 will require even stronger annual growth of 7.5-8 this study finds that the most critical constraints to growth are i insufficient reliable energy supply ii policies that indirectly stunt development of economic activities unrelated to ready made garment exports and iii insufficient security about property and land rights due in part to inadequate

registry systems if policies are designed to urgently tackle these constraints bangladesh will be free to harness its potential for inclusive and sustainable growth

economic and social development is and will be the main task in the long run in china and development is the basis and key to solve the problems faced although people have been criticising its limitations for reasons of one sort or another no better alternative index has ever been put forward gdp is still commonly used all over the world not only as a fundamental and comprehensive indicator for economic analysis but also as an important basis for many rules and evaluations it is impossible to abolish gdp but it is now the time to bid farewell to its worship by saying goodbye to china's gdp worship the role of gdp may be downplayed and restored to its original position in modern china in order to adhere to the essential guideline that development is the absolute principle it is necessary to steadfastly undertake scientific development pay more attention to the people place more emphasis on comprehensive concerted and sustainable development give priority to the overall consideration of various aspects of development and make more efforts to protect and improve people's livelihood and promote social equality and justice in light of the spirit of scientific outlook on development it is imperative to establish new concepts an evaluation system and an assessment mechanism on economic and social development especially to accelerate the transformation of the mode of economic development it will be a profound change covering the entire process and various aspects of economic and social development it is a requirement of the times and also a choice to be made at such a new and historical starting point based on the outstanding research findings of many visionaries and the initial practices in some local areas in recent years this book proposes to switch the focus to multi dimensional and comprehensive indicators from gdp alone and establish a new economic and social evaluation system that is abandon the gdp centred evaluation system or gdp worship and adopt a comprehensive evaluation system for economic and social development embodying the scientific outlook on development the comprehensive development index cdi
