text in italian the work of a tabucchi one of Italy's greatest contemporary writers is imbued with the topic of individual identity his texts query the self perception the relation with the other and the relation with the historical and cultural world while expressing at all these levels an experience of dissolution the self is fragmented and fragile the other is always absent and missed and instead of being engaged in the present world the subject lives in an intangible reality that does not make any sense this profound existential anxiety and the weakening of identity are emphasised by the very way of narrating of Tabucchi which is disconnected enigmatic and full of silences the book by Pia Schwarz Lausten describes various manifestations of the above mentioned experience through the textual analysis of a series of
