to monitor and record us in our very own homes through our phones computers and everyday appliances plots designed to depopulate the human race through murderous viruses a careful plan to dumb down the population by limiting access to the media banning books spying on libraries and denying crucial information on world history politics and more big pharma pushing the use mind altering medicines such as anti depressants mood altering drugs anti anxiety meds and sleeping pills to encourage lethargy and gain control a ruse designed to take away our freedoms under the guise of a bogus alien attack and much much more

the history of germany and the german speaking peoples is as complex and multifaceted as any in europe it is also one of the most difficult to pinpoint conceptually and historically since every nation is a construct to some extent language is certainly important and the german language is a unifying factor for any notion of a unified germany yet even today many german speakers live outside the borders of modern germany shared customs and traditions gave germans a common sense of identity to some extent but these were often local in origin germans were also split between several versions of christianity nevertheless ideas of a german nation were present by the 19th century leading up to the official unification in 1871 neil macgregor a historian of modern germany has explained that the two defining events leading to the rise of german nationalism and the movement toward unification were the thirty years war and the napoleonic wars 1 during the thirty years war more than 200 german states were part of the holy roman empire s loose confederation and that war was predominantly fought in german states by foreign powers including france sweden denmark austria and the netherlands macgregor noted that horrors were experienced across all germany and were never forgotten to the extent that they were invoked during world war ii 2 the religious basis of the thirty years war saw the split between catholicism and protestantism which was at the heart of the reformation some foreign leaders even invoked defending german freedoms for their invasion 3 from the german point of view the thirty years war was proof of their vulnerability to foreign aggression atrocities such as the sacking of magdeburg in 1631 where more than 30 000 people were killed were embedded in the german consciousness 4 all told 8 million people died during the thirty years war likewise the napoleonic wars fought about 150 years later appeared to confirm these fears the french revolution had terrified similar royal regimes in other european empires and as the revolution took on ever bloodier connotations other countries were drawn into conflict with the new french republic with the holy roman empire on the front line of the revolutionary wars napoleon bonaparte earned his reputation with a number of victories on the battlefield and rose to the pinnacle of power in france as the french emperor his reign was characterized by a more aggressive military strategy and the rapid annexation of much of europe

this study investigates the distribution of linguistic and specifically structural diversity in northeast asia nea defined as the region north of the yellow river and east of the yenisei in particular it analyzes what is called the grammar of questions gq i e those aspects of any given language that are specialized for asking questions or regularly combine with these the bulk of the study is a bottom up description and comparison of gqs in the languages of nea the addition of the phrase and beyond to the title of this study serves two purposes first languages such as turkish and chuvash are included despite the fact that they are spoken outside of nea since they have ties to or even originated in the region second despite its focus on one area the typology is intended to be applicable to other languages as well therefore it makes extensive use of data from languages outside of nea the restriction to one category is necessary for reasons of space and clarity and the process of zooming in on one region allows a higher resolution and historical accuracy than is usually the case in linguistic typology the discussion mentions over 450 languages and dialects from nea and beyond and gives about 900 glossed examples the aim is to achieve both a cross linguistically plausible typology and a maximal resolution of the linguistic diversity of northeast asia

the first book to offer a complete story of the extraordinary proliferation of dutch clandestine literature under the nazi occupation clandestine literature was published in all countries under nazi occupation but nowhere else did it flourish as it did in the netherlands this raises important questions what was the content of this literature what were the risks of writing printing selling and buying it and why the netherlands traditionally the combative dutch spirit of resistance has been cited a reaction not only to german oppression but to german propaganda while the germans hoped to build bonds with their germanic dutch brothers clandestine literature insisted on their incompatibility however when reading clandestine literature one should not forget that this spirit of resistance came rather late and did not prevent the transportation of seventy three percent of the netherlands jewish population to nazi death camps the largest percentage in western europe the dutch case is complex while the country proved to be remarkably resistant to nazi propaganda little was done to prevent the actual execution of nazi policies the complete story of dutch clandestine literature therefore combines resistance and complicity victory and defeat pride and shame jeroen dewulf is queen beatrix professor of dutch studies in the department of german at the university of california berkeley
