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established as one of the main sources for the study of the rome statute of the international criminal court this volume provides an article by article analysis of the statute the detailed analysis draws upon relevant case law from the court itself as well as from other international and national criminal tribunals academic commentary and related instruments such as the elements of crimes the rules of procedure and evidence and the relationship agreement with the united nations each of the 128 articles is accompanied by an overview of the drafting history as well as a bibliography of academic literature relevant to the provision written by a single author the commentary avoids duplication and inconsistency providing a comprehensive presentation to assist those who must understand interpret and apply the complex provisions of the rome statute this volume has been well received in the academic community and has become a

trusted reference for those who work at the court even judges the fully updated second edition of the international criminal court incorporates new developments in the law including discussions of recent judicial activity and the amendments to the rome statute adopted at the kampala conference

reculturing museums takes a unified sociocultural theoretical approach to analyze the many conflicts museums experience in the 21st century embracing conflict ash asks what can practitioners and researchers do to create the change they want to see when old systems remain stubbornly in place using a unified sociocultural cultural historical activity theoretical approach to analyzing historically bound conflicts that plague museums each chapter is organized around a central contradiction including finances who will pay for museums demographic shifts who will come to museums the roles of narratives whose story is it ownership of objects who owns the artifact and learning and teaching what is learning and how can we teach equitably the reculturing stance taken by ash promotes social justice and equity making change first within museums called inreach rather than outside the museum called outreach challenges existing norms is sensitive to neoliberal and deficit ideologies and pays attention to the structure agency dialectic reculturing museums will be essential reading for academics students museum practitioners educational researchers and others who care about museums and want to ensure that all people have equal access to the activities objects and ideas residing in them

we ve heard plenty from politicians and experts on affirmative action and higher education about how universities should intervene if at all to ensure a diverse but deserving student population but what about those for whom these issues matter the most in this book natasha k warikoo deeply explores how students themselves think about merit and race at a uniquely pivotal moment after they have just won the most competitive game of their lives and gained admittance to one of the world s top universities what warikoo uncovers talking with both white students and students of color at harvard brown and oxford is absolutely illuminating and some of it is positively shocking as she shows many elite white students understand the value of diversity abstractly but they ignore the real problems that racial inequality causes and that diversity programs are meant to solve they stand in fear of being labeled a racist but they are quick to call foul should a diversity program appear at all to hamper their own chances for advancement the most troubling result of this ambivalence is what she calls the diversity bargain in which white students reluctantly agree with affirmative action as long as it benefits them by providing a diverse learning environment racial diversity in this way is a commodity a selling point on a brochure and as warikoo shows universities play a big part in creating these situations the way they talk about race on campus and the kinds of diversity programs they offer have a huge impact on student attitudes shaping them either toward ambivalence or in better cases toward more productive and considerate understandings of racial difference ultimately this book demonstrates just how slippery the notions of race merit and privilege can be in doing so it asks important questions not just about college admissions but what the elite students who have succeeded at it who will be the world s future leaders will do with the social inequalities of the wider world

this book addresses questions in connection with the international legal regime on demands for secession which have arisen in various states more specifically it examines the unilateral declarations of independence by kosovo in 2008 and by crimea and its subsequent annexation by the russian federation in 2014 the work investigates the two cases so as to shed light on the international legal regime affecting entities that are smaller than a sovereign state it analyzes the relevant principles of international law the intention being to determine their scope and review them in light of the most recent practice and developments in international law in turn the book examines and explains the events of relevance for international law that occurred in the changing situations in kosovo and crimea on the basis of these legal considerations it explores how the international community can respond when faced with situations that may violate international law together with the effectiveness of various measures it also discusses whether certain situations might be legitimate as a concept could now be emerging that secession may be justified in specific circumstances such as serious and widespread violations of basic human rights

this study which brings together and consolidates the research work of the interdisciplinary emham group is focused on the relationship among human mobility healthcare and fairness in public healthcare and treatment the investigation of the information produced by the emergency departments of the rome metropolitan area has proved to be strategic in identifying the healthcare needs of foreign populations many of the dynamics concerning migrants can be traced back to the inappropriateness of visits and accesses to the emergency departments this information together with the result of dynamic evaluations and assessments is useful not only for healthcare issues but also for the demographic socio political and economic characterisation of the phenomenon of human mobility
