no legislature in the world has a greater influence over its nation s public affairs than the us congress the congress s centrality in the

the space occupied by international law in shaping political action is subject to continuing debate and controversy this book aims to answer the question of how and why international law impacts the behaviour of actors on the international stage in the absence of central authority and faced with asymmetric power at a time when the role of normative restraints in international relations and international law in particular has come under renewed questioning it advances an analytical framework for understanding the effect of norms on behaviour that is not contingent on material restraints or a given political constellation while being informed by the practical realities and practice of international organisation in doing so this book draws on an interdisciplinary range of sources including international law political theory cognitive psychology and behavioural economics to explore a communicative action based

approach of how norms and ideas persuade actors to engage in a course of action consonant with international law to achieve a particular outcome in probing the role of norms on questions such as the use of force and accountability and issues of equity and justice it examines the challenges international law faces and what the way forward may look like

why has the response to hiv aids been unique how did civil society organizations gain access to global decision making forums to demand exceptional attention and resources for hiv aids this book seeks to answer these questions among others through a critical international relations approach that enquires into the role of civil society in global health governance it documents how civil society forged the initial response to hiv aids within a rights based paradigm and built international networks it analyses why civil society was able to gain the right to participate in global health institutions and assesses what influence civil society representatives have within these institutions particularly focusing on outcomes related to institutional legitimacy and downward accountability it then discusses changes in the broader political economy of global health and how hiv aids organizations have or have not adapted to these shifts finally the book tells the story of the many struggles civil society organizations have engaged in to advance a rights based response to hiv aids the transformations achieved and the resistance experienced

foresight is an area within futures studies that focuses on critical thinking concerning long term developments whether within the public sector or in industry and management and is something of a sub section of complexity and network science this book examines developments in foresight methodologies and relates in its greater part to the work done in the context of the costa22 network of the eu on foresight methodologies foresight is a professional practice that supports significant decisions and as such it needs to be more assured of its claims to knowledge methodology foresight is practiced across many domains and is not the preserve of specialized futurists or indeed of foresight specialists however the disciplines of foresight are not well articulated or disseminated across domains leading to re inventions and practice that does not make best use of experience in other domains the methodological development of foresight is an important task that aims at strengthening the pool of the tools available for application thereby empowering the actors involved in foresight practice elaborating further on methodological issues such as those presented in the present book enables the actors involved in foresight to begin to critique current practice from this perspective and thirdly to begin to design foresight practice the present trends towards methodological concerns indicates a move from given expert predicted futures to one in which futures are nurtured through a dialogue among stakeholders the book has four parts each elaborating on a set of aspects of foresight methodologies after an introductory section part ii considers theorizing about foresight methodologies part iii covers system content issues and part iv presents foresight tools and approaches

resilience is currently infusing policy debates and public discourses widely promoted as a normative goal in fields as diverse as the economy national security personal development and well being resilience thinking provides a framework for understanding dynamics of complex inter connected social ecological and economic systems the book critically analyzes the multiple meanings and applications of resilience ideas in contemporary society and to suggests where how and why resilience might cause us to re think global change and development and how this new approach might be operationalized the book shows how current policy discourses on resilience promote business as usual rather than radical responses to change but it argues that resilience can help understand and respond to the challenges of the contemporary age these challenges are characterized by high uncertainty globalized and interconnected systems increasing disparities and limited choices resilience thinking can overturn orthodox approaches to international development dominated by modernization aid dependency and a focus on economic growth and to global environmental change characterized by technocratic approaches market environmentalism and commoditization of ecosystem services resilience development and global change presents a sophisticated theoretically informed synthesis of resilience thinking across disciplines it applies resilience ideas specifically to international development and relates resilience to core theories in development and shows how a radical resilience based approach to development might transform responses to climate change to the dilemmas of managing forests and ecosystems and to rural and urban poverty in the developing world the book provides fresh perspectives for scholars of international development environmental studies and geography and add new dimensions for those studying broader fields of ecology and society

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
