this anthology challenges what is defined as travel writing as it is arranged as a journey but not chronologically it includes flaubert in egypt elizabeth david in the mediterranean and writers and discoverers such as chekhov darwin doris lessing tobias wolff and v s naipaul

at the turn of the century sigmund freud s investigation of the mind represented a particular journey into mental illness but it was not the only exploration of this territory in the austro hungarian empire sanatoriums were the new tourism destinations psychiatrists were collecting art works produced by patients and writers were developing innovative literary techniques to convey a character s interior life this collection of essays uses the framework of journeys in order to highlight the diverse artistic cultural and medical responses to a peculiarly viennese anxiety about the madness of modern times the travellers of these journeys vary from patients to doctors artists to writers architects to composers and royalty to tourists in engaging with their histories the contributors reveal the different ways in which madness was experienced and represented in vienna 1900

journeys is a collection of poems written between 1974 and 2019 the poems are personal in nature and take readers on an interesting journey through time journeys represent the past the present and the future this anthology is intended to captivate its readers by taking them on a journey that begins in the ghettos of bull bay jamaica and ends up for now miles away in the creative capital of the world providence rhode island journeys will captivate its readers by bringing the richness of one woman s desire to escape the ravages of poverty journeys delve deeply into love hope resilience wanting and everything in between it has a rich caribbean feel that lures readers to the exotic paradise island of jamaica with white sand beaches to the harsh realities that are not advertised race class and violence journeys highlight sheds light on issues of race gender and class among other social constructs the book glimpses into the black woman s experience and her constant struggle and fight to use her voice and to be heard amidst the noise every poem in journeys is sure to either soothe readers soul or prick their social conscience to activism for social justice journeys will not disappoint readers the poems are happy sad lonely and hopeful they draw from the poet s lived experiences as a young girl growing up on the island to that of a mother wife sister friend teacher and legislator journeys will inspire readers everywhere it will provide support affirmation guidance consolation and laughter journeys is a work of the heart and a timeless treasure that everyone should have in their collection

this collection which gathers fifteen stories by contemporary indian women representing the varied languages and regions of their subcontinent is now available to an american audience for the first time

in the beginning pedro s nightmares were not dreams they were his life in the fourteen stories that make up journeys the reader accompanies pedro through his sorrowful childhood aches and delights in dane s sensual infatuation with the young cecilia and discovers that reverend rex randall was not always a settled man why is a young man like derrick working in a small town church office what was it like for rowan and mateo when their idyllic childhood was shaken witness how victoria held olivia in her time of need and take a glimpse into the future for the pine junction friends the sanchez family and their friends of pine junction live through tumultuous times in the spring of 2005 as told in junctions but each of the characters has more story to tell in journeys the curtain lifts for one character and then another to step on center stage

hundreds of anthologies of women s short stories have appeared in the literary market between the 1970s and now this publishing and cultural phenomenon is considered for the first time in this book which argues that during this period anthologies have become a literary technology used not only to make visible female short story writers but also to think about and mould ideas of womanhood through creative and contextualised readings of the most important anthologies produced in this period this study shows that this literary form has contributed to and in some cases pioneered key developments in gender theory and feminist thought including questions of political combination among women which underlie contemporary global movements such as metoo in doing so the book also develops the first book length conceptualisation of the features and meaning making mechanisms of the short story anthology as a literary form this book will benefit academics and students working in the fields of short fiction publishing and women s studies as well as feminist scholars and a growing number of specialists interested in the anthology as a literary form worldwide

the journey to wisdom addresses a broad array of topics in education the natural world and medieval intellectual history the book

examines a philosophy of education that originated with the ancient greeks and that reached its culmination in the late medieval and early renaissance periods that philosophy of education promotes a journey to wisdom involving an escape from pure subjectivity and the seductions of rhetoric and leading to a profound awareness of the natural world and nature s god it grants us a renewed sense of education as a self directed transforming journey to knowledge and insight rather than as is so often the case now as an impersonal bureaucratized trek that reflects little sense of the ultimate aims of education the volume opens with a discussion of the quarrel in ancient greece between the sophists and the so called philosophers a quarrel paul a olson writes out of which the philosophers tradition centering education in reality as opposed to social convention develops subsequent chapters follow the development of this tradition in the writings of augustine boethius dante petrarch copernicus galileo kepler and others here olson refutes several recent theories that medieval intellectuals helped legitimize technological mastery and exploitation of the environment that medieval education involved no systematic progress toward recognizing the sanctity of creation and that all literary works medieval ones included are self referenced and therefore that they offer no guidance to a world beyond themselves the journey to wisdom will be essential reading for students of ancient medieval and renaissance intellectual history but in its unmistakably modern concerns about education the book also speaks to a far wider spectrum of readers olson s study falls into that rarest category of scholarly productions one that reflects both its author s profound knowledge of the past and his equally great commitment to the present that dual commitment accounts for the uncommon insights and pleasures offered by this book

this book explores the parallel and yet profoundly different ways of seeing the outside world and engaging with the foreign at two important moments of dislocation in chinese history namely the early medieval period commonly known as the northern and southern dynasties 317 589 ce and the nineteenth century xiaofei tian juxtaposes literary historical and religious materials from these two periods in comparative study bringing them together in their unprecedentedly large scale interactions and their intense fascination with foreign cultures by examining various cultural forms of representation from the two periods tian attempts to sort out modes of seeing the world that inform these writings these modes tian argues were established in early medieval times and

resurfaced in permutations and metamorphoses in nineteenth century writings on encountering the other this book is for readers who are interested not only in early medieval or nineteenth century china but also in issues of representation travel visualization and modernity

the art of wandering is a history of that curious hybrid the writer as walker from the ancient world to the modern day the role of the walker continues to evolve from philosopher and pilgrim vagrant and visionary to experimentalist and radical from rousseau and de quincey to virginia woolf and werner herzog this seemingly innocuous activity has inspired a literary tradition encompassing philosophy and poetry the novel and the manifesto today this figure has returned to the forefront of the public imagination as writers and walkers follow in the footsteps of earlier generations for the walker is once again on the march seeking out new territory and recording new impressions of the landscape newly revised and updated the art of wandering explores these adventures on foot every walk can be expressed as a story narrated by the walker it is these stories and the lives of those who walked them which are examined here

the first book to offer a cutting edge discussion of contemporary travel writing in german anxious journeys looks both at classical tropes of travel writing and its connection to current debates the rich contemporary literature of travel has been the focus of numerous recent publications in english that seek to understand how travel narratives with their distinctive representations of identities places and cultures respond to today s globalized high speed world characterized by the dual mass movements of tourism and migration yet a corresponding cutting edge discussion of twenty first century travel writing in german has until now been missing the fourteen essays in anxious journeys redress this situation they analyze texts by leading authors such as felicitas hoppe christoph ransmayr julie zeh navid kermani judith schalansky ilija trojanow and others as well as topics such as turkish german travelogues and the relationship of comics to travel writing the volume examines how writers engage with classic tropes of travel writing and how they react to the current sense of crisis and belatedness it also links travel to ongoing debates about the

geoffrey bownas widely known over the last half century for his writings translations broadcasts and commentaries relating to japan and an eminent japanese studies scholar who pioneered teaching in this field at oxford 1954 and sheffield 1966 has at last completed a memoir it is both a literary triumph and a compelling read not least for the many who have known him as well as a historical record of some significance tracking japan s post war history from abject poverty to unimaginable prosperity as the world s second largest economy and the lost post bubble years in particular the author includes a detailed account of his association with mishima yukio while preparing the penguin new writing in japan his early years in kyoto and his experience of living in tenri city he also offers a critical appraisal of the japanese aesthetic documents an extraordinary meeting with honda soichiro and takes a nostalgic journey back to the writing of his many books on japan including the penguin book of japanese verse with anthony thwaite japanese rainmaking and other folk practices and japan and the new europe equally his involvement and input at some of japan s key turning points over the last fifty years make fascinating reading such as the 1964 tokyo olympics when he was the bbc

s interpreter and more recently the new kansai international airport in the early 1990s as consultant to watson steel a member of the amec group

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
