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step into the action filled suspenseful world of the anomalies where some humans are gifted with extraordinary psychic powers time thieves mind raiders and soul stealers are in a battle of survival against the crime lords and secret government agencies hunting them for their abilities welcome to a world where these anomalies risk everything to survive and risk it all to fall in love includes four novellas time thief bay north wants revenge no she craves revenge hunted for her psychic ability to steal time and forced to watch her family die all she wants is to make the crime lord who s taken everything from her pay but now he s set the ultimate hunter on her trail and bay will need all her skills just to survive the gray eyed hard bodied man out to kill her mind raider mara ross takes crap from no one especially not the bastard crime boss who tortured her for her psychic ability to control minds now he s kidnapped another woman and mara will do anything to save her including joining forces with the most deadly powerful man she knows soul stealer schoolteacher cate hartmann was kidnapped and forced to use her psychic ability to kill now she s a killer with an addiction to stealing souls she fights to recover but only one man calms the storm inside a genius anomaly scientist with a sexy muscled body under his lab coat a man she s too afraid to touch salvation he was once a power hungry crime lord and john brown can never forget it he s lost most of his memories most of his soul but no one trusts him not even himself then his calm boring existence is shattered when he wakes up chained in a secret underground lab tortured experimented on his only hope is a feminine voice in the darkness

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on the morning following the feast of st giles 1 september 1966 the bishop of worcester the right reverend giles wyndham brookes is found slumped and lifeless in his study at hartlebury castle his official residence the doors and windows are securely locked from the inside and on his desk is a fifteenth century book in middle french and gothic script which he could not read he had seemingly tripped on an edge of carpet and hit his head on the fender but there is a distinct whiff of murder in the air the immediate suspects are the members of his household his wife the chaplain the secretary the housekeeper his almoner and the archdeacon of worcester others including a woman found casting spells in the castle grounds a young italian lurking at night in the bishop s chapel and a suggested unknown late night visitor appear in the course of the investigation inspector wickfield and his sergeant embark on a roller coaster tour of the anglican church in a search for motive and for a cunning killer there are forays into naples relics assassination locked room mysteries the cult of the saints wicca and blue moons follow the inspector if you dare but hold on to your hats in this latest offering from the pen of the adept julius falconer you will be instructed entertained and intrigued in equal measure book reviews online publishedbestsellers website

a riveting read a dark story of murder and deceit with verve and insight john woolf author of the wonders the life and death of a 19th century circus legend on 28 november 1911 a retired showman died violently at his home in north london known to the world as lord george sanger he was once the biggest name in show business and was venerated as a national institution the death of britain s wealthiest showman read like a popular crime thriller a merciless killer a famous victim sensational media headlines a desperate manhunt laced with police incompetencies and a dramatic denouement few could have anticipated but for over a century questions have persisted about the murder weaving in the story of george s rise to fame and the history of britain s entertainment industry the killing of lord george uses previously unpublished archive material to reconstruct the

events leading up to the death and reveal the true story behind the brutal crime that shocked edwardian england

this book contains a broad overview of time travel in science fiction along with a detailed examination of the philosophical implications of time travel the emphasis of this book is now on the philosophical and on science fiction rather than on physics as in the author s earlier books on the subject in that spirit there are for example no tech notes filled with algebra integrals and differential equations as there are in the first and second editions of time machines writing about time travel is today a respectable business it hasn t always been so after all time travel prima facie appears to violate a fundamental law of nature every effect has a cause with the cause occurring before the effect time travel to the past however seems to allow indeed to demand backwards causation with an effect the time traveler emerging into the past as he exits from his time machine occurring before its cause the time traveler pushing the start button on his machine s control panel to start his trip backward through time time machine tales includes new discussions of the advances by physicists and philosophers that have appeared since the publication of time machines in 1999 examples of which are the chapters on time travel paradoxes those chapters have been brought up to date with the latest philosophical thinking on the paradoxes

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british generals in blair s wars is based on a series of high profile seminars held in oxford in which senior british officers predominantly from the army reflect on their experience of campaigning the chapters embrace all the uk s major operations since the end of the cold war but they focus particularly on iraq and afghanistan as personal testimonies they capture the immediacy of the authors thoughts at the time and show how the ideas of a generation of senior british officers developed in a period of rapid change against a background of intense political controversy and some popular unease the armed forces were struggling to revise their cold war concepts

and doctrines and to find the best ways to meet the demands placed upon them by their political leaders in what was seen to be a new world order it was a time when relations between the government of the day and the armed services came under close scrutiny and when the affection of the british public for its forces seemed to grow with the difficulty of their operational tasks this is a truly unique and invaluable book for the first time we are offered first hand testimony about britain s involvement in recent campaigns by senior participants in addition to touching on themes like civilian military relations the operational direction of war and relationships with allies these eyewitness accounts give a real sense of how the character of a war changes even as it is being fought it will be essential reading for those in military academies and staff colleges not only in britain but throughout nato and especially in the usa it also has profound policy implications as both the uk and nato more generally reassess their strategies and the value of intervention operations it will also become a primary source for historians and students of the wars in iraq and afghanistan in particular
