this book investigates the grammar of spoken english and spoken italian and ways to translate spoken expressions it proposes italian equivalents of english spoken discourse markers and english versions of italian clitic expressions it firstly outlines the main features of spoken english grammar by providing insights from the literature and examples from british and american spoken language corpora it then outlines the characteristics of neo standard italian and what makes it peculiar especially in its spoken form building on literature findings and on corpus based evidence it investigates the frequencies and usages of the words and of the non words characterising the english spoken language and their italian equivalents it explores natural occurring dialogues in spoken language banks as well as in narratives film dubbing and film subtitles it proposes italian corpus sourced equivalents of english discourse markers and english versions of italian clitic constructions this book is innovative as no other academic work has focused thoroughly on the translation of spoken language its methodology is fully replicable thanks to its detailed comprehensive analyses

the past few years have witnessed a growing academic interest in italian studies and an increasing number of symposia and scholarly activities this volume originates from the society for italian studies postgraduate colloquia that took place at the university of leicester and cambridge in june 2004 and april 2005 respectively it gathers together articles by young researchers working on various aspects of italian studies it well illustrates current trends in both typical areas of research like literature and high culture and in those which have gained

momentum in recent years like translation and language studies the volume offers a taste of the dynamic outlook of current research in italian studies the interdisciplinary approach of the essays in translation and gender studies and the innovative methodological perspectives and findings offered by the new fields of italian l2 and ethnography the book is divided into three sections each grouping contributions by broad subject areas literature and culture translation and gender studies language and linguistics cross fertilizations and interdisciplinary research emerge from several essays and the coherent ensemble constitutes an example of the far reaching results achieved by current research

this volume assembles texts dedicated to the linguistic and educational aspects of missionary and colonial enterprises taking into account all continents and with an extended diachronic perspective 15th 20th centuries strictly speaking this linguistics is contemporary to the colonial era so it is primarily the work of missionaries of catholic orders and protestant societies it can also belong to a retrospective outlook following decolonization in the first category one mostly finds transcription translation and grammatization practices typically the production of dictionaries and grammar books in the second category one finds in addition descriptions of language use of situations of diglossia and of contact between languages within this framework the volume focuses on educational and linguistic policies language teaching and learning and the didactics that were associated with them

this book uncovers how fascism reshaped italian society according to its ideological and historical interpretation of the italian nation and people and identifies the strengths of this transformation but also the resistance encountered from for example women and minority groups to accept it in everyday life it analyzes the success achieved by some policies aimed at popular masses in order to integrate them into the nation and how fascism initiated an early welfare state project to address specific categories of society such as veterans families

mothers and children the book also questions the concept and practices of social citizenship reserved only for those who gave evidence of formal adherence to fascism
