first published in 1998 this volume brings together the most part of the author s work on medieval polyphony the most significant advance in music during the period in the high gothic was the development of a system of rhythm and of its notation the modern understanding of which was to a considerable extent obscured by an undue emphasis on the so called rhythmic modes the investigation of this topic forms the centre of this book and a related essay deals with rhythmic latin poetry other pieces survey the accomplishments of europe s first great composer and the flourishing of the medieval motet whose rise he stimulated while several essays focus on english polyphony and on what remains of the motets of philippe de vitry a major figure in parisian intellectual circles of the 14th century

explores health and lifeways in monastic communities focusing on palaeopathological insights into well being disabilities and burial practices across various periods monasticism is a form of religious life in which participants renounce worldly activities to dedicate themselves primarily to spiritual matters living in small communities subject to a set of rules and isolated from the secular world christian monasticism which originated at the end of the 3rd century in egypt and

spread to different parts of Europe in the 6th century however it was not until the middle Ages that monastic communities became one of the most powerful institutions in Europe. Monasteries and convents played a very important role not only as centers of spirituality but also as focal points of economic, technological, and cultural activity. This multiplicity of activities carried out alongside their religious, social, and political roles makes monasteries spaces that can be studied from very different perspectives and that unfailingly provide essential information about our history.

This first of two titles originates from an international conference that took place in Barcelona in January 2024 which sought to examine different aspects related to monastic life in the past and to promote and disseminate the results obtained in the latest studies undertaken within the framework of monastic complexes and their environments. These include contributions and multidisciplinary studies from archaeological, bioanthropological, and/or documentary perspectives. Specialists from different disciplines present developments on the topic of monasticism from different fields of study such as zooarchaeology, bioanthropology, palaeopathology, archaeology, history, documentary disciplines, archives, cultural heritage, etc. Volume 1 concentrates on health and lifeways within monastic communities, focusing on palaeopathological information providing insights into physical well-being and in particular the presence and significance of disabled individuals and evidence for long-term health and dental issues. A variety of scientific methods of analysis are applied to cemetery populations from monasteries and nunneries of different periods to examine both causes of and contributions to the death of individuals, the composition of communities, and the treatment of the dead. Studies of assemblages of faunal remains from monastic complexes consider how faunal analysis can help interpret the role of domestic species.

The story of a rope, a symbol, and rough justice in America: the hangman's knot is a simple thing to tie just a rope carefully coiled around itself up to thirteen times, but in those thirteen turns lie a powerful symbol, one that is all too deeply connected to America's past and present. The last man to be hanged in the United States was Billy Bailey, who was executed in Delaware in 1996 for committing a double murder. Even today, hanging is still legal in certain situations in New Hampshire and Washington, and the noose remains a potent cultural symbol. An incident in Jena, Louisiana, in 2006, in which nooses were used to menace Black students, made national news, yet little has changed. According to author Jack Shuler, there have been nearly 100 noose incidents just in the last two years. The thirteenth turn unravels these stories from Judas Iscariot, perhaps the most infamous hanged man, to the killing of Perry Smith and Richard Hickock, the murderers at the heart of Truman Capote's *In Cold Blood*, and beyond. In his travels across America, Shuler traces the evolution of this dark practice as he investigates the death of John Brown or the 1930 lynching that inspired the song *Strange Fruit*. He finds that the very places that perpetrated these acts now seek to forget them. Shuler's account is a kind of shadow history of America, a reminder that vigilantes and hangmen play a crucial role in our national story. *The Thirteenth Turn* is a courageous and searching book that reminds us where we come from and what is lost if we forget.
