story time at the public library is the first exposure to books outside the home for many preschool children for the librarian it is an exciting opportunity to instill in youngsters a love of reading and books but coming up with new ideas that hold the children's attention can be trying until now here are 55 tried and true story hour programs with a thematic approach all are highly flexible and adaptable across the full preschool age range most of the ideas are arranged under one of eight specific themes that include four to eight one hour programs barnyard animals the caldecott medal colors families a storytelling feast the five senses reptiles and amphibians and around the world there are also 18 individual holiday and seasonal programs all story hours provide ideas for name tags suggested audiovisual materials recommended story poetry and song selections additional titles and a full description of the activity

this collection of essays pays tribute to acclaimed Australian poet Rosemary Dobson whose papers are held in the National Library of Australia the book features essays by Elizabeth Lawson Paul Hetherington and David McCooey a selection of Dobson's poems highlight her diversity and artistry

warning this book contains top secret information about flowers prepare to be shocked and weirded out by this hilarious and totally true picture book introduction to some of nature's strangest plants flowers are beautiful they have bright colors soft petals and sweet nectar yum but that's not the whole truth flowers can be weird and one bee is here to let everyone know talking directly to the reader a bee reveals how flowers are so much stranger than what we think did you know that there are some flowers that only bloom in the nighttime some flowers are spooky and look like ghosts or bats or a monster's mouth and while most flowers smell good there are some that smell like dead meat or even horse poop this hilarious and refreshing book with silly and sweet illustrations explores the science of flowers and shows that these plants are not always stereotypically pretty

and harmless as we often think they are they are fascinating disgusting complicated and amazing

wallis simpson is known as the woman who stole the king s heart and rocked the monarchy but she was not edward viii s first or only love this book is about the women he adored before wallis dominated his life there was rosemary leveson gower the girl he wanted to marry and who would have been the perfect match for a future king and the prince s long term mistress freda dudley ward who exerted a pull almost equal to wallis over her lover but abided by the rules of the game and never expected to marry him then there was thelma furness his twice married american lover who enjoyed a domestic life with him but realised it could not last forever and demanded nothing more than to be his mistress and fatefully introduced him to wallis in each love affair edward behaved like a cross between a little boy lost and a spoilt child craving affection resorting to emotional blackmail to keep his lovers with him each of the three women in this book could have changed the course of history by examining their lives and impact on the heir to the throne we question whether he ever really wanted to be king

this captivating retrospective explores the social context of fashion with informative text and over 70 striking images profiles include flappers glamour girls flower children and the modern obsession with celebrity styles

this book constitutes a timely and necessary intervention in the academic study of satanism at the same time the book also constitutes a vital addition to the field of gothic and horror studies although recent years have witnessed a revival of interest in figures such as the witch the zombie and the vampire satan and his acolytes have been largely ignored aside from where they overlap with the witch this volume seeks to address this lacuna in gothic studies by examining how satanism particularly as it relates to issues of gender and sexuality has shaped both the aesthetic and thematic content of horror media over the past half century

rosemary murray 1913 2004 was the eldest of six children in a happy talented and energetic family whose deeply engrained attitude of service to the community she inherited she studied chemistry at oxford becoming one of the first women at lmh to achieve a dphil in science and began an academic career as a lecturer at royal holloway college the charmed world of rosemary s childhood and student days vanished abruptly with the outbreak of war enlisting in the wrns as a rating she served from 1942 46

attaining the rank of chief officer post war she was head hunted by cambridge university as demonstrator in chemistry combined with a lectureship at girton college here she became interested in women s education witnessing the success of the long battle to allow women to take degrees and becoming a committee member of the third foundation association a movement to set up a third women s college eventually when new hall was started she became its first tutor in charge and later president she went on to become the first woman vice chancellor of cambridge university

this book challenges eurocentric interpretations of the so called turkish german cinema from a transnational perspective advocating for a comprehensive reevaluation to encourage enriched dialogues the first part critically assesses dominant media discourses on guest workers and migrants in the historiography of turkish german cinema arguing for a shift from traditional identity focused narratives to a broader exploration of shared emotions the second part explores arabesk which while originating as a hybrid musical genre has evolved into a significant cultural force encompassing a range of emotional phenomena arabesk embodies the visceral often painful expressions of migration and dislocation characterized by a profound emotional intensity it articulates a painful passion and longing for the homeland left behind providing an invaluable method for understanding aesthetic nuances of turkish german films arabesk serves as an analytical tool for deconstructing cinematic expressions revealing complex emotional ties and cultivating a feeling of familiarity through the dynamic circulation and exchange of cultural media thus arabesk s poetics significantly shape transnational cinema practices and contribute to global cinema discourse
