the book contains 108 stories many of the stories were either heard or read by ramdas on various occasions the reader will find in the book also stories told by sri ramakrishna sri ramana maharshi and other saints of india and abroad the collection is by no means exhaustive but the stories presented here will no doubt prove to be a source of instruction and enlightenment to the spiritual aspirant

in quest of god is one of the world s great spiritual classics an autobiographical chronicle of swami ramdas s year of mendicant wandering through the great pilgrimage sites of 1920s india ramdas s third person prose is simple almost childlike yet crisp evocative and ultimately disarming it s the perfect way to tell this story of spiritual awakening and radical trust in god there is no other spiritual book quite like in quest of god long out of print in the west this 100th anniversary edition of in quest of god was produced with the gracious approval of anadashram trust and combines the unabridged text of anandashram s current edition with the forward and glossary from the edition published in the united states by blue dove press 1994 this special edition contains more than 30 black and white photographs set in 1920s india

meditation empowers us to transcend our material mind set and touch the infinite and eternal true meditation transforms the way we see reality it touches the place inside us where a spark of the eternal dwells meditation unites us with our true self from the introduction the life of meditation is much more than the act of sitting for half an hour or forty five minutes and looking inward it is a whole way of life through meditation we learn to live in a heightened awareness and walk at all times in the presence of god rabbi yoel glick brings wisdom from personal experience and eastern traditions to illuminate and vitalize familiar jewish rituals vocabulary and imagery he provides specific guidelines and practical techniques grounded in judaism for each stage of the life of meditation outlining the inner processes we encounter and the questions we face how does meditation help us connect with the collective jewish soul what happens in our mind body and soul when we meditate how do we resist the pull of a material mind set and live in expanded

consciousness what does it feel like to reach union with our spiritual source how do we remain aware of god s living presence in our everyday life

demon king ravana rama's battle with the forces of evil provides powerful examples of heroic strength and loyalty the dangers of spiritual delusion and false attachment and the power of love both human and divine capturing the mystical spirit and transcendental wisdom of this immortal story vanamali explains how the character of rama has captivated devotees through the millennia because his story depicts eternal truths that appeal to the best in human nature she reveals how even though rama is an avatar of vishnu he still possesses many human weaknesses such as attachments desires and anger his greatness lies in the fact that he rose above these traits put his spiritual duty above all personal considerations and perfected himself to become a super human capable of saving those he loved most rama's life shows that however weak we may be each of us is capable of amazing feats through devotion loyalty perseverance and love

while traveling the road on pilgrimage or following american baul master khepa lee lozowick 1943 2010 in his daunting travel schedule author mary angelon young crafted a collection of essays that explore and evoke the many moods of enlightened duality one of lozowick's core teachings in the path of western bauls this dynamic spiritual principle suggests that the spiritual seeker can combine an integrated awareness of the nondual all is one with a lively conscious relationship to the duality or play of opposites that is the constant fare of everyday life unlike those strictly nondual perspectives that relegate the human experience to an illusion of the mind lozowick asserted that while nondual unity is the foundation of what is simultaneously life is real these original essays cover such universal themes as impermanence beauty and transformation and comprise one wayfarer's reflections reveries and research some are flavored with academic spice but most are predominantly experiential presenting a kaleidoscopic journey that unfolds much like a large multifaceted jewel looked at from many different directions each essay has its own integrity and stands on its own authority yet taken as a whole they form a useful map of the tantric path charting its depths through daily events travel relationships creativity and work all continuous integrated aspects of the transformational path the teaching of enlightened duality can be found in many guises within the world's great traditions including sufi vajrayana buddhist and both bhakti and tantric hindu paths it is a universal theme and yet the treatment here runs true to the theistic underpinnings of the lineage from which it comes khepa lee lozowick sri yogi ramsuratkumar and swami ramdas from this view

the highest aim of spiritual practice is to integrate mystical experience and insights of nonduality into ordinary life this book provides a genuine feast of practical wisdom for the hungry seeker who yearns for a path through life that is both transformational and yet honoring of the innate dignity and potential of the human incarnation the author has travelled extensively in india and europe has studied the sanskrit hindu and buddhist traditions and has written published an extensive treatise on the baul path the baul tradition hohm press 2014

never before have all the various facets of the teachings of swami ramdas 1884 1963 been brought together in one comprehensive volume like a beautiful multicoloured garland of fragrant flowers servant of god is a collection of extracts from the writings of ramdas that are arranged under 101 chapter headings the very phrases of ramdas form the chapter headings which range from aboration of the lord to zoroaster taught the suzerainty of god

eknath easwaran taught spiritual living for nearly 40 years and drew deep ongoing inspiration from the sacred literature of all traditions the great river of wisdom that is always flowing throughout the world the 149 short extracts in this anthology come from the much loved saints sages and scriptures of the christian hindu sufi jewish native american buddhist and taoist traditions these passages can be read for daily inspiration for their insights into other spiritual traditions for the light they throw on how to live for the sustenance they offer when we feel sad or tired and for the deep transformation they can bring in easwaran s method of passage meditation rich supporting material includes stories from india detailed background notes suggestions for memorization and for studying the texts in practices such as lectio divina from the christian tradition and instruction in using these texts in passage meditation

at the age of sixteen dennis lingwood discovered that he was and always had been a buddhist this realization was to act as the motive force behind a life in which lingwood now better known as sangharakshita has played a major part in the introduction of buddhism to the west the rainbow road traces sangharakshita s development from a childhood

dominated by illness and books to homeless wandering and ordination as a buddhist monk the rainbow road is a remarkable and refreshingly candid record of a journey of spiritual exploration

this book traces the baul path a tantric spiritual tradition from its earliest roots in the subcontinent of india to its dissemination in the west in modern times baul meaning madcap or taken by the wind describes one who has a vision of reality so piercing clear that they are called to live in a way that goes against the common grain the safe plodding life of the mainstream in the east for centuries baul bards yogis wandered the dusty roads of bengal singing dancing with joy in praise of god their poetry songs uplifted ordinary people transporting all above the daily grind for survival into a direct experience of the sublime sahaja is the hallmark of the baul way referring to the naturally ecstatic essence of being according to the bauls sahaja nature is inborn underlies one's human personality habitual social conditioning it is a blueprint of love beauty bliss wisdom dignity from the baul view to rediscover sahaja is to love god the spirit of sahaja arises in individuals in all cultures in all times places the author asserts in this book however she details the unique vital approaches to life spirituality that the bauls both east west have demonstrated throughout their history in their philosophy teaching practice the baul sadhana or spiritual life rests on four pillars radical reliance on the guru wandering and begging as a way of life teachings encoded in song and dance yogas of the body including hatha sexuality breath each of these tenets is elaborated in depth as the author highlights the notable differences in their expression then now in east west the outstanding contribution of this book is its first hand account of the introduction of baul spirituality to the modern world through the life work of kḥā pa lee lozowick 1943 2010 an american teacher the spiritual heart son of yogi ramsuratkumar the revered beggar saint of tiruvannamalai south india in 2008 m young accompanied khepa lee to bengal where they met with eminent baul gurus practitioners many who had long awaited an exchange with their american brother on this trip his band of western bauls shared their american rock blues in a unique interplay between east west foreword is by parvathy baul internationally acclaimed musician and representative of the traditional baul path m young's work is a feast of scholarship rich in memoir practical wisdom

an illustrated a to z reference containing more than 700 entries providing information on the theology people historical events institutions and movements related to hinduism

contains essays on mysticism prayer sacred art the relationship between christianity and other religious

the pole maurice frydman 1894 or 1901 1976 was an important personality although not much is known about him he was a close disciple of ramana maharshi and nisargadatta maharaj it is to him that we owe the compilation of ramana s talks in maharshi s gospel as well as the well known book i am that the translation of nisargadatta maharaj s talks from marathi into english which made nisargadatta famous as an electrical engineer he came to india in the 1930s where he set up a transformer factory in bangalore and was a regular visitor to ramana s ashram at weekends as he wanted to lead the life of a sannyasin mendicant monk he went to swami ramdas who gave him the name swami bharatananda he had a close friendship with krishnamurti and worked in his organizations for a time his activities also extended to indian politics as he was significantly involved in the so called aundh experiment of the small princely state of aundh and helped it to democratize he also helped plan the dalai lama s escape to india in 1959 and ensured that the tibetans who had fled were given land to settle on

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
