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this book studies the ways traditional polarized images of women have been used and challenged in the hispanic world especially during the 20th century and the beginning of the 21st century by writers and the media but also in earlier time periods the chapters analyze the image of women in specific political periods such as francoism or the kirchners administration stereotypes of women in films in mexico and chile and the representation of women in textbooks among other topics contributions also show how two women writers in the 17th and the 19th centuries viewed the role of women in their society

this proceedings volume contains selected papers presented at the workshop on the conservation of the subterranean cultural heritage held 25-27 march 2014 in seville spain the workshop was organized by the spanish network of science and technology for the conservation of cultural heritage technoheritage

this collection of stephen clucas's articles addresses the complex interactions between religion natural philosophy and magic in sixteenth and seventeenth century europe the essays on the elizabethan mathematician and magus john dee show that the angelic conversations of john dee owed a significant debt to medieval magical traditions and how dee's attempts to communicate with spirits were used to serve specific religious agendas in the mid seventeenth century the essays devoted to giordano bruno offer a reappraisal of the magical orientation of the italian philosopher's mnemotechnical and lullist writings of the 1580s and 90s and show his influence on early seventeenth century english understandings of memory and intellection next come three studies on the atomistic or corpuscularian natural philosophy of the northumberland and cavendish circles arguing that there was a distinct english corpuscularian tradition prior to the gassendian influence in the 1640s and 50s finally two essays on the seventeenth century intelligencer samuel hartlib and his correspondents shows how religion alchemy and natural philosophy interacted during the puritan revolution

a wonderfully lucid accessible and wide ranging account of the boundary between justified and unjustified belief sam harris new york times bestselling author of the moral landscape and the end of faith in this work synthesizing thirty years of research psychologist historian of science and the world's best known skeptic michael shermer upends the traditional thinking about how humans form beliefs about the world simply put beliefs come first and explanations for beliefs follow the brain shermer argues is a belief engine from sensory data flowing in through the senses the brain naturally begins to look for and find patterns and then infuses those patterns with meaning our brains connect the dots of our world into meaningful patterns that explain why things happen and these patterns become beliefs once beliefs are formed the brain begins to look for and find confirmatory evidence in support of those beliefs which accelerates the process of reinforcing them and round and round the process goes in a positive feedback loop of belief confirmation shermer outlines the numerous cognitive tools our brains engage to reinforce our beliefs as truths interlaced with his theory of belief shermer provides countless real world examples of how this process operates from politics economics and religion to conspiracy theories the supernatural and the paranormal ultimately he demonstrates why science is the best tool ever devised to determine whether or not a belief matches reality a must read for everyone who wonders why religious and political beliefs are so rigid and polarized or why the other side is always wrong but somehow doesn't see it dr leonard mlodinow physicist and author of the drunkard's walk and the grand design with stephen hawking

centuries to establish the presence of self identity creation in many new contexts beyond that explored in greenblatt s renaissance self fashioning greatly expanding the understanding of self fashioning on diverse aspects of identity creation in late medieval and early modern iberia

this work fills a gap in recent studies on the history of race and science focusing on both the classification systems of human variety and the development of science as the arbiter of truth brown looks at the rise of the emerging sciences of life and society biology and sociology as well as the debate surrounding slavery and abolition

new from bradt is northern spain the most detailed guidebook available to a unique compelling part of iberia a deep dive into a hitherto under rated region incisive context covers modern history and environmental social and economic issues enabling the reader to take well informed decisions about how best to experience a region extending from galicia in spain s far northwest east through the basque country to navarra northern spain offers enormous variety in a single trip you could explore celtic heritage in asturias feast on atlantic octopus in galicia enjoy pintxos snacks before a traditional asador barbeque in the basque country surf breakers in the bay of biscay walk and watch wildlife in the mountainous picos de europa national park travel along the winding feve narrow gauge railway or the luxurious transcantabrica gran lujo train and enjoy a gentle bike ride along a via verde a disused railway line converted into walking and cycling routes and northern spain s delights do not stop there hikers and pilgrims alike tread along three ancient trails that comprise the camino de santiago with the shrines of santiago de compostela as their ultimate destination la rioja is spain s most renowned wine region where wineries include the mind bending marques de riscall designed by frank gehry who designed bilbao s guggenheim museum northern spain is also a genuinely surprising region bagpipes are just as important a part of musical culture in some parts as they are in scotland in summer homes in the wine making region around pontevedra are transformed into pop up restaurants with visitors invited to dine in garages living rooms and homely kitchens a traditional way of selling excess wine some medieval churches defy expectations being decorated with sexy scenes that would be at home in the kama sutra and if you re up for a challenge why not try to speak euskera the unique basque language with no known linguistic relatives with heatwaves increasingly characterising spain s popular mediterranean coast in summer the country s north known as green spain offers more clement conditions for a rewarding holiday and what better travelling companion can you have than bradt s northern spain

this study of the comentarios is original both in adopting the perspective of discourse analysis and in its interdisciplinary approach

a tale blazed through heaven examines developments in the representation of the classical tale of mars venus and vulcan in the literature and painting of the golden age of spain c 1526 1681 anchored in close analysis of individual primary texts the five chapters that comprise this study assess how poets and painters breathed new life into the tale inherited from homer ovid and others examining some of the ways

in which the story of mars venus and vulcan was disguised developed expanded mocked combined with or played off against different subjects or otherwise modified in order to pique the interest of successive generations of readers and viewers each chapter discusses what particular changes and shifts in emphasis reveal about the tale itself specific renderings the aims and intentions of individual poets and painters and the wider context of the literary and visual culture of early modern spain discussing a range of poems by both canonical garcilaso de la vega luis de g ngora lope de vega etc and less well known writers juan de la cueva alonso de castillo sol rzano salvador jacinto polo de medina etc and culminating in detailed examination of select mythological works by philip iv s court painter diego vel zquez this book sheds light on questions relating to aspects of classical reception in the renaissance the rise of specific poetic styles epic mock epic burlesque etc the interplay between the sister arts of poetry and painting and the continual process of imitation and invention that was one of the defining features of the spanish golden age
