los Éléments de la philosophie de newton de voltaire 1738 fue una exposición popular de la física newtoniana dirigida a lectores generales para entonces voltaire había abrazado completamente la ciencia de newton y con la ayuda de su compañera Émilie du châtelet la consumada traductora de los principios de newton explicó ideas complejas en prosa clara e ilustrada el libro detalla las teorías de newton sobre la luz y el color óptica y sobre la gravitación universal completo con diagramas y ejemplos a menudo

contrastándolos con la visión cartesiana más antigua, Voltaire tardó cinco años en dominar estos conceptos para poder ponerlos al alcance de todos. Como nota un historiador, discute los experimentos de Newton con prismas y la ley de la gravitación y enfatiza el enfoque empírico, uso experimental de la razón que Newton representa. La obra también acredita a otros pensadores ingleses como Locke y Boyle como influencias porque fue escrita para una audiencia laica. Voltaire omite matemáticas pesadas y en su lugar usa analogías e imágenes por ejemplo comparando el universo con un mecanismo de reloj gobernado por leyes matemáticas. El efecto general es una presentación entusiasta de la ciencia moderna. Voltaire declara que la nueva cosmovisión newtoniana reemplaza las antiguas explicaciones religiosas del cosmos y dio a los intelectuales armas ideológicas contra la superstición. Esta moderna edición crítica para lectores incluye un epílogo iluminador que rastrea las relaciones intelectuales de Voltaire con pensadores y filósofos de la Ilustración incluyendo a Locke, Diderot, Rousseau y Newton, conteniendo investigación única sobre sus influencias y apegos económicos, una cronología completa de su vida y obras, un glosario de terminología de la Ilustración y un índice detallado de todos los escritos de Voltaire. La edición de 1738 estaba ricamente ilustrada con grabados de prismas, telescopios y otros aparatos porque apareció bien después de las *Lettres philosophiques*. Las autoridades lo toleraron de hecho. Fue alabado por muchos. El salón científico en Cirey y la corte prusiana también ayudaron a difundir su reputación. En décadas posteriores fue traducido a otros idiomas. Sobre todo su aparición a finales de la década de 1730 significa un punto de inflexión en la carrera de Voltaire. Como nota una fuente consagrada con las *Lettres philosophiques* de 1733, un punto de inflexión de la escritura literaria a la científico-filosófica. El propio Voltaire reconoció más tarde el rol de *du châquet*. Minerva dictó y yo escribí subrayando el esfuerzo colaborativo. Detrás de este texto emblemático, los elementos de la filosofía de Newton tuvieron un impacto intelectual profundo.
