this book is the first major study of one of spain s most celebrated younger novelists belén gopegui whose work stands apart from other writers of her generation for its uncompromising focus on the social function of literature this book is the first major study of one of spain s most celebrated younger novelists belén gopegui whose work stands apart from other writers of her generation for its uncompromising focus on the social function of literature gopegui s social commitments find expression in her concern for solidarity and collective projects these become more radical over time in response to a disenchantment with the evolution of the left in spain and to the global impact of the capitalist economic system giving rise to increasingly interventionist narrative strategies the core theme of solidarity is explored in relation to the collective experience of spain s largely consensual democratic transition and to the apparent erosion of collective goals in post transition society gopegui s discourse of solidarity is examined through engagement with theorists of advanced modernity including ulrich beck s risk society model and various contemporary reflections on the concept of solidarity centred on gopegui s first four novels the study situates analysis of these within the perspective of her later works and illuminates her artistic and intellectual trajectory by drawing on an extensive array of her non fiction writings and personal interviews one of which is published here for the first time hayley rabanal is lecturer in hispanic studies at the university of sheffield

gang related violence has forced thousands of hondurans to flee their country leaving behind everything as refugees and undocumented migrants abroad to uncover how this happened jon carter looks back to the mid 2000s when neighborhood gangs were scrambling to survive state violence and mass incarceration locating there a critique of neoliberal globalization and state corruption that foreshadows honduras s current crises carter begins with the story of a thirteen year old gang member accused in the murder of an undercover dea agent asking how the nation s seductive criminal underworld has transformed the lives of young people he then widens the lens to describe a history of imperialism and corruption that shaped this underworld from cold war counterinsurgency to the war on drugs to the near impunity of white collar crime as he follows local gangs who embrace new trades in the illicit economy carter describes the gangs transformation from neighborhood groups to sprawling criminal societies even in the national penitentiary where they have become political as much as criminal communities gothic sovereignty reveals not only how the revolutionary potential of gangs was lost when they merged with powerful cartels but also how close analysis of criminal communities enables profound reflection on the economic legal and existential discontents of globalization in late liberal nation states

from our common destiny they are poems of passionate witness and confrontation responding to those who would state that politics has no place in poetry she would add her voice to that of neruda s we do not wish to please them she carries within her the ancient blood of the pipiles and laces her language with mesitizo richness

the book explores novels essays and poetry published by spanish writers in response to the global economic crisis that began in 2008 spain has been experiencing the crisis in a particularly painful way and the artistic response to these traumatic events has been powerful and abundant the literature of the crisis is pointing to the probability that the crisis is not a temporary problem that will be resolved once and for all if correct economic measures are taken to the contrary there is every reason to believe that the losses in long term employment the growing precariousness of work the increased economic insecurity the citizens disillusionment with the capacity of democratic governments to withstand the pressures of global capital the erosion of the welfare state and the explosive growth in inequality that we associate with the crisis are not likely to be reversed spanish artists are exploring the reasons behind spain s particularly painful experience of the crisis and at the same time are placing the suffering that the crisis is causing in spain within the context of global developments that are ensuring its durability essays by antonio mu oz molina and lucía etxebarria novels by rafael chirbes luis garcía montero benjamín prado and belén gopegui and poetry by the artists who contributed to the collections titled en legítima defensa poetas en tiempos de crisis and marca da espa a retrato poético de una sociedad en crisis point to the necessity of expanding our vision of the crisis from the purely financial to a broader definition that will include the changes the crisis augurs for the areas of human existence that
