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durling s edition of petrarch s poems has become the standard readers have praised the translation of the authoritative text as graceful and accurate conveying a real understanding of what this difficult poet is saying the literalness of the prose translation makes this book especially useful to students who lack a full command of italian

some twentieth century american versions of them introduces readers to the rich variety of middle english poetry presents poems of mourning and of celebration poems dedicated to the blessed virgin and to christ poems inviting or disparaging love poems about sex and more reader friendly uses modernized letter forms punctuation and capitalization and side glosses explaining difficult words opens with a substantial introduction by the editor to the medieval lyric as a genre and features short introductions to each section and poem also includes an annotated bibliography glossary index of first lines and list of manuscripts cited

what was the medieval english lyric moving beyond the received understanding of the genre the voices of medieval english lyric explores through analysis discussion and demonstration what the term lyric most meaningfully implies in a middle english context a critical edition of 131 poems that illustrate the range and rich variety of lyric poetry from the mid twelfth century to the early sixteenth century the voices of medieval english lyric presents its texts freshly edited from the manuscripts in thirteen sections emphasizing contrasting and complementary voices and genres as well as a selection of religious poetry the collection includes a high proportion of secular lyrics many on love and sexuality both earnest and humorous in general major authors who have been covered thoroughly elsewhere are excluded from the edited texts but some especially chaucer are quoted or mentioned as illuminating comparisons charles d orléans and the scots poets robert henryson and william dunbar add an extra national dimension to a single language collection textual and thematic notes are provided as well as versions of the poems in latin or french when these exist adopting new perspectives the voices of medieval english lyric offers an up to date accessible and distinctive take on middle english poetry

in mythologist in microgroove a study of italian myths and cultural shifts with fabrizio de andré on lead vocals author julianne vanwagenen investigates the ways in which popular music as well as other popular genres engaged with and critiqued modern myth during years of cultural and political upheaval in italy from the late 1960s to the mid 1980s the italian singer songwriter fabrizio de andré is the productive lens of the book as it considers the myths of the hanged man and the scaffold the cowboy jesus of nazareth and edgar lee masters's fiddler jones across four chapters vanwagenen engages contemporary events and cultural contexts in italy as well as abroad and interprets them through the lens of popular cultural productions she weaves the voices of bob dylan francesco de gregori francesco guccini dario fo edgar lee masters among others with that of de andré to propose a new perspective on the countercultural years across the study de andré's music arises as singularly profound and persistent in its critique of elements of western culture that have guided its trajectory since the late medieval period

particular laid the groundwork for operas and musicals by marc blitzstein and leonard bernstein although both composers resisted or downplayed his aesthetic contribution to american tradition comparative analysis based on harold bloom s anxiety of influence and other modes of intertextuality reveals that the principles of weill s opera reform would catalyze an indigenous movement in sophisticated socially engaged music theatre weill blitzstein and bernstein a study of influence focuses on works that represent different phases of weill s mission to renew the genre of opera evolving from die dreigroschenoper to the musical play lady in the dark and the broadway opera street scene blitzstein and bernstein in turn defied formal boundaries with the cradle will rock regina trouble in tahiti candide and west side story part of a short lived movement in mid twentieth century america that coincided with a renaissance for weill s german period works following the premiere of blitzstein s translation the threepenny opera under bernstein s baton the unpublished a pray by blecht for which bernstein rejoined stephen sondheim and jerome robbins his collaborators on west side story deepens the connection of bernstein s aesthetic to weill

traditionally attributed to king solomon and called by rabbi akiva the holy of holies among sacred scriptures mishnah yadayim 3 5 the song of songs is one of the most fascinating and controversial biblical books and played an essential role in the shaping of european spirituality and culture combining in a unique way a sensual and deeply lyrical celebration of love with a well established tradition of christian allegorical interpretation this text crucial to both the middle ages and the early modern period held a particular appeal for poets devoted not only to religious verse but also to love poetry the song of songs and its tradition in renaissance love lyric is the first systematic and wide ranging investigation of the multifaceted use of the song of songs in renaissance love lyric poetry with specific attention to italian french and especially english poetic production at the same time this investigation is embedded into a narrative that comprising two initial chapters devoted to medieval poetry and to francesco petrarca represents an unprecedented attempt to trace the role of the song of songs in the rise and development of the european love lyric following its path or rather one of its paths from the medieval origins of this tradition to the end of the sixteenth century the picture of the general impact of the song of songs in the development of the european love lyric is combined with in depth analysis of key works by specific authors including dante alighieri francesco petrarca torquato tasso marguerite de navarre anne de marquets clément marot richard barnfield edmund spenser william shakespeare john donne elizabeth melville and aemilia lanyer promoting a contextualization of their significance within a new interpretative framework while the comparative standpoint characterizing this study fosters a deeper comprehension of the evolution of the european love lyric its multidisciplinary approach which considers the song of songs as the centre of a web of dynamics pertaining to the fields of literature philosophy theology and religious and cultural history contributes to the understanding of the thought and spirit of ages crucial to the shaping of european culture
