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my story was written in an effort to capture my memories of the
vietnam war i arrived in vietnam on december 19 1967 as a naive

twenty year old private e 3 and left on december 9 1968 as a disillusioned staff sergeant e 6 with two bronze stars and a purple heart as a soldier assigned to alpha company third battalion twenty first infantry 196th light infantry brigade i fought the viet cong and north vietnamese regulars nva in the flatlands and the mountains west of tam ky and the nva on the dmz north of dong ha enemy fire malaria accidents and the scorching heat all took a heavy toll on alpha company the high casualty rate was a constant drain on the company s experience and the lack of experience produced yet more casualties on more than one occasion stupid mistakes cost young men their lives but at other times like when we turned back the nva on the dmz i can assure you that there wasn t a better outfit in vietnam on that night in may

by late 1971 vietnamization of the war was in full swing only two infantry brigades remained in country president nixon assured the american public that soldiers in vietnam were only performing guard duty the media portrayed u s forces in vietnam as undisciplined and mutinous plagued by drugs and seething with racial tension in twilight in the nam the author describes his experience as a rifle platoon leader in 1971 72 as a member of co c 1st battalion 46th infantry the same company that was overrun on firebase mary ann by the viet cong in march of 1971 while he does not flinch from describing the realities of drugs and racial tension he does paint a picture of young american infantrymen on continuous combat operations doing their best in a lost cause

this military history chronicles the combat operations of the blackhorse regiment which paved the way for armored cavalry tactics in the vietnam war south vietnam september 1966 when the 11th armored cavalry regiment came ashore at vung tau it faced a number of challenges in addition to the threat of the viet cong and the north vietnamese army the terrain and weather posed their own dangers adversely affecting the use of bulletproof vehicles and helicopters the dearth of doctrine and tactics for the employment of armored cavalry in a counterinsurgency was equally challenging especially during pre deployment training and initial combat operations but despite all this the leaders of blackhorse regiment found a way to accomplish their mission within a year of their arrival in vietnam blackhorse troopers overcame ambushes that featured anti tank weapons numerous landmines and coordinated assaults they not only defeated an enemy division twice their size but also demonstrated how to succeed while operating on and off the roads in the jungle and during both the wet and dry seasons by the spring of 1967 army leaders were beginning to realize the value of troops stationed in vietnam and with the blackhorse regiment leading the way armor came to be considered an essential part of the combat team written by a blackhorse veteran this regiment history features firsthand accounts from soldiers who served in vietnam and cambodia

vietnam was the first war america lost on the ground in this fascinating account historian nigel cawthorne traces the conflict from its inception to its traumatic end he looks at the political

events that led to the war and examines its impact upon both the Americans and the Vietnamese whose battle for the independence of their country was to leave lingering scars upon the American psyche. Vietnam: A War Lost and Won is an even handed assessment of a conflict whose wounds would take a generation to heal.

Engineers at War describes the role of military engineers especially the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in the Vietnam War. It is a story of the engineers' battle against an elusive and determined enemy in one of the harshest underdeveloped regions of the world. Despite these challenges, engineer soldiers successfully carried out their combat and construction missions. The building effort in South Vietnam allowed the United States to deploy and operate a modern 500,000 man force in a far off region. Although the engineers faced huge construction tasks, they were always ready to support the combat troops. They built ports and depots, carved airfields and airstrips out of jungle and mountain plateaus, repaired roads and bridges, and constructed bases. Because of these efforts, ground combat troops with their supporting engineers were able to fight the enemy from well established bases. Although most of the construction was temporary, more durable facilities such as airfields, port and depot complexes

In early 1965, the United States had about 23,000 troops in South Vietnam. Through that date, 140 Americans had been killed in action, 1,138 had been wounded, and 11 were listed as missing. On March 8, American combat troops, Battalion Landing Team 3, Ninth Marines of the 3d Marine Division, came ashore at 9:02 a.m. on Red Beach 2. By June 1, 1965, 50,000 troops were stationed in the country. The escalation had begun. This is a chronological listing of more than 600 Army and Marine combat operations from 1965 through 1973. Each entry includes the dates, name, location, type of action, units involved, events, individual activities within the area of operations, casualties, and resulting political or military activity. Information was derived in part from official documents interspersed chronologically are brief summaries of significant events that affected the conduct of the war such as major developments, ceasefires, political observations, and troop strength.

Book 3, the last of a three book series, continues from 1968 in Book 2 to cover the action of Marine Corps tankers and Ontos crewmen fighting the locally grown Viet Cong, the better armed, trained, organized, and equipped Viet Cong main forces, and the North Vietnamese Army regulars from 1969 through 1970 in I Corps, South Vietnam. As in Books 1 and 2, and continuing in Book 3, it features hundreds of personal stories and on the spot, real time interviews of Marines just returning from their fight, all of which are framed within the official unit command chronologies and after action reports, including documented lessons learned. The maps, personal pictures, organizational charts, and the citing of each Marine who gave his life are also linked to the Vietnam Wall and to the Foundation's website with volumes of additional information about the Marines and Ontos crewmen who left their sweat and blood in Vietnam, battling their communist enemy.

formed in 1916 the u s army 31st infantry regiment known as the polar bears has fought in virtually every war in modern american history this richly illustrated chronicle of the regiment s century of combat service covers their exploits on battlefields from manila to siberia including pork chop hill nui chom mountain and iraq s triangle of death along with their survival during the bataan death march and the years of brutal captivity that followed

the year 1968 was the year of the tet offensive including khe sanh and hue city these were momentous events in the course of the war and they occurred in the first three months of the year this book however documents that 1968 was more than just the tet offensive the bloodiest month of the war for the u s forces was not january nor february 1968 but may 1968 when the communists launched what was called their mini tet offensive this was followed by a second mini tet offensive during the late summer which also was repulsed at heavy cost to both sides by the end of the year the u s forces in south vietnam s i corps under the iii marine amphibious force iii maf had regained the offensive by december enemy initiated attacks had fallen to their lowest level in two years still there was no talk of victory the communist forces remained a formidable foe and a limit had been drawn on the level of american participation in the war although largely written from the perspective of iii maf and the ground war in i corps the volume also treats the activities of marines with the seventh fleet special landing force activities of marine advisors to south vietnamese forces and other marine involvement in the war separate chapters cover marine aviation and the single manager controversy artillery logistics manpower and pacification e h simmons brigadier general u s marine corps retired

for southeast asia the vietnam war altered forever the history topography people economy and politics of the democratic republic of vietnam drv the republic of vietnam rvn cambodia and laos that the war was controversial is an understatement as is the notion that the war can be understood from any one perspective one way of understanding the vietnam war is by marking its time with turning points both major and minor that involved events or decisions that helped to influence its course in the years to follow by examining a few of these turning points an organizational framework takes shape that makes understanding the war more possible historical dictionary of the war in vietnam emphasizes the international nature of the war as well as provide a greater understanding of the long scope of the conflict the major events associated with the war will serve as the foundation of the book while additional entries will explore the military diplomatic political social and cultural events that made the war unique while military subjects will be fully explored there will be greater attention to other aspects of the war all of this is done through a chronology an introductory essay an extensive bibliography and over 600 cross referenced dictionary entries this

book is an excellent access point for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about the vietnam war

the marines in vietnam 1954 1973 an anthology and annotated bibliography based on articles that appeared in the u s naval institute proceedings naval review and marine corp sgazette has served well for 14 years as an interim reference on the vietnam war it has both complemented and supplemented our official histories on marine operations in vietnam since its publication in 1974 however events in vietnam and the appearance of additional significant articles in the three periodicals have made both the anthology and bibliography somewhat dated this expanded edition extends the coverage of the anthology to 1975 and the entries in the bibliography to 1984

chemical warfare during the vietnam war documents the use of antipersonnel chemical weapons throughout the vietnam war and explores their effectiveness under the wide variety of circumstances in which they were employed the short readable account follows the us program as it progressed from a focus on the humanitarian aspects of non lethal chemicals to their use as a means of increasing and enhancing the destructiveness of traditional weapons it also presents the efforts of the north vietnamese to both counter us chemical operations and to develop a chemical capability of their own this largely overlooked facet of the vietnam war provides an opportunity for students and scholars to examine many of the potential issues surrounding the use of non lethal chemical agents in modern military operations and serves as a backdrop to discussion of broader issues associated with chemical warfare including the power of public perception chemical warfare during the vietnam war is a comprehensive and thoroughly fascinating examination of riot control agents during the vietnam war

includes sections on the air campaign conducted during the communists siege of the marine camp of khe sanh also contains several appendices a glossary and bibliographical notes

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
