tonight neverland is fleshed out with plenty of plant life certainly bettering 2011 s production of jack and the bean cactus so with no further ado please put your hands together for j m barrie s christmas classic peter pan the inept and accident prone cornley polytechnic drama society set out to present j m barrie s classic tale of peter pan their most audacious production to date flying pyrotechnics sharp hooks what ensues is two acts of hysterical disaster you ll laugh they ll cry something so wrong has never been so right from the mischievous minds of the west end and edinburgh hit the play that goes wrong comes this highly original chaos filled re telling of j m barrie s much loved classic peter pan goes wrong received its world premiere at the pleasance theatre london on 10 december 2013

love buddy love drinking games and beer bellies fasten your seat belts it s gonna be a mad one

it s not just the choice it s never just the choice choice is a fairytale tattoos are forever almost and at noodle soup tattoo there are strict rules no names unless they re dead nothing on the face nothing you might get sued for later when jodie a rough sleeper asks for a free tattoo from apprentice kit her request is well within the guidelines but kit is still unsure because they know only too well that getting inked isn t the only decision that stays with you for the rest of your life albatross is a small but sweeping story about the past refusing to stay in the past it was originally commissioned by plaines plough in collaboration with royal welsh college of music and drama and is published here to coincide with its production at the playground theatre london in october 2021

british theatre has a greater tradition than any other having started all the way back in 1311 and still going strong today but that is too much for one book to cover so this volume deals with early theatre and has a cut off date in 1899 still this is almost six centuries centuries during which british theatre not only developed but produced some of the greatest playwrights of all time and anywhere including obviously shakespeare but also marlowe and shaw and they wrote some of the finest plays ever which are known around the world so there is plenty for this book to cover just with the playwrights plays and actors but it also has information on stagecraft and theatres as well as the historical and political background this book has over 1 183 entries in the dictionary section these being mainly on playwrights and plays but others as well including managers and critics and also on specific theatres legislative acts and some technical jargon then there are entries on the different genres from comedy to tragedy and everything in between inevitably the chronology is quite long as it has a long period to cover and the introduction provides the necessary overview the historical dictionary of early british theatre concludes with a pretty massive bibliography that will be of use to particularly assiduous researchers but this book itself is a good place to start any research since it covers periods that are far less well known and documented and ordinary theatre goers will also find useful information

directing the decades is an examination of the development of theatre in the uk since the revolution of the 1950s until the present day viewed through the individual progress of a female director from a working class background in this book theatre history and lessons on directing are interwoven the history is presented decade by decade examining particular productions each historical theatre chapter is followed by a method chapter examining directorial influences and techniques predominant in each decade as well as examining the working experience of the author in that decade the book also includes practical advice on the directing process including exercises plans for rehearsals and camera plans sue dunderdale offers a unique perspective on the evolution of theatre directing in the uk and her work which served as the foundation of the creation of the theatre lab and directing program at rada continues to influence working directors today directing the decades will be of interest to students and practitioners of theatre directing acting and theatre history and to theatregoers with a consciousness of class and how it impacts on our lives the book also offers access to online transcripts of interviews with 16 practitioners including rufus norris michelle terry kwame kwei armah indhu rubasingham nadia latif and nadia fall
