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this book is designed to meet the requirements of a wide range of students keeping in view the varied applications of mathematical techniques in different areas of economics commerce finance and management at the undergraduate and post graduate levels the subject matter has been presented in a very simple and lucid manner a large number of questions from various university examination papers have been included to provide a range of questions on different topics of the subjects exercises given at the end

of each topic will provide a source of practice to the students and make them more confident assuring better performance in the examination teachers in the subject may also find it absorbing and different from other books in respect of approach style and lucidity in explanation supported by appropriate diagrams

mathematics is the language of science as such it is a basic tool for gaining knowledge in any scientific discipline students often wonder why mathematics subjects are also included in economics and business studies any economist should be fluent in mathematical language and capable of applying mathematics in the analysis modelling and solving of economic problems this book covers a broad range of mathematics topics all of which are essential to gaining the skills required in economics and business professions along with theoretical explanations essential for correctly understanding the concepts involved it includes a large number of numerical examples each chapter is concluded by a collection of exercises with solutions and a self assessment test which are key components of the learning process for each topic

in recent years economics has been the subject of increasingly severe criticism it has failed both to predict and to counteract the economic crisis now afflicting nearly the whole western world economic life is more disrupted than ever the rate of inflation has risen alarmingly unemployment has not been as high since the 1930s economic growth is stagnating there is increasing opposition to the inequality in the

distribution of income and wealth on a national scale as well as in the world at large the process of economic integration eec gatt unct ad is being thwarted programmes of economic development in the third world have not produced the desired effects etcetera obviously it would not be fair to put the blame for the crisis on economic science but the present predicament does call for serious consideration of the limitations of economic explanation among the social sciences economics is unquestionably the most advanced discipline its very sophistication however leads it to abstract from social phenomena such as norms institutions power conflict and social change thus the manifest influence of sociological variables on the course of economic processes remains hidden dominating this book as a drumbeat is the conviction held by the several authors that a clearer grasp of the current problems may be obtained if economists and sociologists are prepared to co operate more closely an interdisciplinary approach is warranted the distinction between the social sciences should be less sharply drawn

upon hearing that ronald coase had been awarded the nobel prize a fellow economist s first response was to ask with whom coase had shared the prize whether this response was idiosyncratic or not i do not know i expect not part of this type of reaction can no doubt be explained by the fact that coase has often been characterized as an economist who wrote only two significant or influential papers the nature of the firm 1937 and the problem of social cost 1960 and by typical professional standards of significant and influential i e widely read and cited this perception embodies a great deal of truth even subsequent to coase s receipt of the prize this is not to say that there have not been other important works the marginal cost controversy 1946 and the lighthouse in economics 1974 come immediately to mind here only that in a random sample of say one hundred economists one would likely find few who could list a coase bibliography beyond the two classic pieces noted above in spite of coase s significant publication record

the purpose of this collection is to assess the development of tensions within and prospects for coasean economics those aspects of economic analysis that have evolved out of coase's path breaking work two major strands of research can be identified here law and economics and the new institutional economics

in the summer of 1991 bob carling who was then life sciences editor of chapman hall approached me over the possibility of producing an edited volume of works on economics and ecology as we discussed the matter further what became clear is that there is a growing literature on the frontiers of both disciplines that has involved economists borrowing from ecology and ecologists borrowing from economics we decided that this volume should try to provide a small cross section of that literature i was very much interested in editing this volume for several reasons first one of my principal interests in economics has been how the economic analysis of natural resource and environmental problems can benefit from the concepts and lessons learned from other disciplines in particular ecology i was grateful at having the opportunity to pull together a selection of readings that illustrate how the integration of the two disciplines can lead to fruitful analysis second i was also aware that as director of the london environmental economics centre and as a senior researcher at the international institute of environment and development i was fortunate to have worked with or to have known a number of economists and ecologists whose work would be ideal for this volume i was delighted that so many of my friends and colleagues were as enthusiastic about this project as i and agreed to participate
