this is a revised edition of walker s well known book in feminist ethics first published in 1997 walker s book proposes a view of morality and an approach to ethical theory which uses the critical insights of feminism and race theory to rethink the epistemological and moral position of the ethical theorist and how moral theory is inescapably shaped by culture and history the main gist of her book is that morality is embodied in practices of responsibility that express our identities values and connections to others in socially patterned ways thus ethical theory needs to be empirically informed and politically critical to avoid reiterating forms of socially entrenched bias responsible ethical theory should reveal and question the moral significance of social differences the book engages with and challenges the work of contemporary analytic philosophers in ethics moral understandings has been influential in reaching a global audience in ethics and feminist philosophy as well as in tangential fields like nursing ethics research ethics disability ethics environmental ethics and social and political theory this revised edition contains a new preface a substantive postscript to chapter 1 about the subject of moral philosophy the addition of a new chapter on the importance of emotion in practices of responsibility and the addition of an afterword which responds to critics of the book

this title was first published in 2001 ethical thinking about medical decision making has roots deep in history this collection of contemporary essays by leading international scholars traces the

ethical issues inherent in psychiatric research and clinical practice are invariably complex and multifaceted well reasoned ethical decision making is essential to deal effectively with patients and promote optimal patient care drawing on the positive reception of psychiatric ethics since its first publication in 1981 this highly anticipated 5th edition offers psychiatrists and other mental health professionals a coherent guide to dealing with the diverse ethical issues that challenge them this edition has been substantially updated to reflect the many changes that have occurred in the field during the past decade its 25 chapters are grouped into three sections which cover 1 clinical practice in child and adolescent psychiatry consultation liaison psychiatry psychogeriatrics community psychiatry and forensic psychiatry 2 relevant basic sciences such as neuroethics and genetics and 3 philosophical and social contexts including the history of ethics in psychiatry and the nature of professionalism principal aspects of clinical practice in general such as confidentiality boundary violations and involuntary treatment are covered comprehensively as is a new chapter on diagnosis given the contributors expertise in their respective fields psychiatric ethics will undoubtedly continue to serve as a significant resource for all mental health professionals whatever the role they play in psychiatry it will also benefit students of moral philosophy in their professional pursuits

this festschrift seeks to honor three highly distinguished scholars in the department of philosophy university of michigan william k frankena charles l stevenson and richard b brandt each has made significant contributions to the philosophic literature particularly in the field of ethics michigan has been fortunate in having three such original and productive moral philosophers serving on its faculty simultaneously yet they stand in a long tradition of excellence both within the department and in the university let us trace that tradition briefly the university of michigan opened in 1841 its department of literature science and the arts at first resembled a typical american college of that period with religious and ethical indoctrination playing a central role in course offerings but when henry tappan a presbyterian clergyman and professor of philosophy became president in 1852 he succeeded in shifting the emphasis from indoctrination to inquiry and scholarship though he was dismissed for his policies in 1863 tappan's efforts to establish a broad and liberal curriculum prevailed michigan was to take its place among the leading educational institutions in this country and to achieve an international reputation as a research center several past philosophers are worthy of mention here george sylvester morris an absolute idealist joined the department in 1881 having served from 1870 as chairman of the department of modern languages and literature he assumed the chairmanship of philosophy in 1884

lawrence's volume provides a detailed discussion and analyses of the moral awareness of major

characters in greek tragedy focusing particularly on the characters recognition of moral issues and crises their ability to reflect on them and their consciousness of doing so beginning with a definition of morality and examining the implications of analysing the moral performance of fictional characters lawrence considers concepts of the self and the problem of autonomy and personal responsibility in the context of divine intervention which is a crucial feature of the genre the volume then moves on to the individual plays aeschylus seven against thebes and oresteia sophocles ajax trachiniai oedipus tyrannus electra and philoctetes and euripides medea hecuba hippolytus heracles electra and bacchae focusing in each case on a crisis or crises faced by a major character and examining the background which led to it lawrence then considers the individual character s moral response and relates it to the critical issues formulated in the volume s opening discussions the book will be important to any student of classical studies and those in philosophy or literature interested in a theoretical discussion of the morality of literary characters

this is an introductory text for an ethics course that provides the theoretical background for discussion of ethical problems it could be supplemented with essays or anthologies on a range of particular problems or an instructor could focus on the problems that occupy the concluding chapters abortion whistle blowing and the relation between ethics and the law the first few chapters present ethical theory in straightforward fashion discussing alternatives and providing historical orientation the middle chapters develop what the author calls action guides with principles for applying them the last few chapters demonstrate the theory and action guides at work
